### PROGRESS REPORTS

#### 1. *Federal Aid for Classical Studies*

As pointed out in our November 1965 issue, p. 80, the Federal Government is dramatically expanding its financial contributions to higher education and the humanities. Obviously here is an opportunity for our readers to participate in what seems to be an ever increasing number of federal programs, and we strongly urge that those who can will take advantage of them. The last session of Congress appropriated several billion dollars to fund the new educational program; for fiscal 1966 in the U.S. Office of Education alone some \$3.2 billion in Federal funds authorized under twenty statutes dating from 1890 will flow to the nation's schools, colleges, teachers, and students.

This money is channeled through a large number of governmental departments, agencies, and bureaus—at least 42 of them are involved in education to some degree. Some of these programs would be of little interest to our readers, e.g. the NASA program to develop space science and technology. Others ought to be acted upon by college and university administration, e.g. the Housing and Urban Development Program for the extension of college housing or the Student Assistance Opportunity Grants of \$200 to \$1000 to exceptionally needy students. Some of these programs should ultimately benefit classicists. Some, however, may be of more immediate usefulness to classicists, e.g. Title VI of the Higher Education Act for which \$15,000,000 has been appropriated to help colleges buy laboratory and

other special undergraduate equipment including audiovisual equipment.

The most exciting piece of legislation (as far as classicists are concerned) passed last year was Public Law 89-209 which set up a National Foundation on the Arts and Humanities. The purpose of this Foundation is to do for the Arts and Humanities what The National Science Foundation is already doing for the Sciences or for that matter what the Canada Council is doing for our colleagues in Canada. The National Foundation on the Arts and Humanities is a dual structure, a National Endowment for the Humanities with its National Council on the Humanities of 26 members headed by a Chairman and a parallel organization for the Arts. Each council is to advise and be consulted on grant applications and to assist in shaping policy. A federal Council on the Arts and the Humanities composed of seven members (the two chairmen, the Director of NSF, the U.S. Commissioner of Education, the Librarian of Congress, the Secretary of the Smithsonian and a designate of the Secretary of State) is to ensure coordination between the two foundations.

Leaving aside the Arts Endowment, we find that the Humanities are defined rather broadly to include "modern and classical languages, linguistics, literature, history, jurisprudence, philosophy, archaeology, these aspects of the social sciences which have humanistic content and employ humanistic methods, and the history, theory, and practice of the arts." The Endowment has been authorized \$5,000,000 per year for the

next three fiscal years for the purpose of awarding training grants and fellowships, nonmatching grants for research, for supporting the publishing of scholarly works, and for fostering wider understanding of the humanities. An additional \$5,000,000 is authorized per year to match gifts, donations, and bequests to the Humanities for a total authorization per year of \$10,000,000. Also the U.S. Office of Education has been authorized \$500,000 per year for the next three years for payments to support state and local educational agencies and for loans to private elementary and secondary schools and for the acquisition of equipment and minor remodeling related to the arts and humanities; and \$500,000 to establish teacher training institutes in order to strengthen the teaching of humanities and the arts in elementary and secondary schools.

As a result of this Federal aid for the Humanities has been assured. Nevertheless there will be all sorts of problems involved in implementing it. Now we must all demonstrate how effective the implementation will be.<sup>1</sup>

## 2. CAUSA

Pending the immediately forthcoming appearance of the first issue of the eagerly awaited ACL Newsletter, *Classical Action*, we may confine ourselves at this time to a brief review of the more important developments of the CAUSA movement, culminating in the epochal Airlie Conference of April 1965 (cf. *CW* 58 [1964-65] 271-277), the official publication of its proceedings (cf. *CW* 59 [1965-66] 134f.), the generous provision of summer scholarships for 1966 by ACL (*ibid.*), and the activation of at least one further ACL project, the Master Teacher and Program Award (*CW* 59 [1965-66] 101f.) (Attention is called to the important correction [Jan., p. 143] confirming that the Award is open to *all* schools — and to the swiftly approaching deadline of April 2!)

As currently organized, then, the work of

1. Chairman of the National Council on the Humanities (and of the National Endowment for the Humanities) will be Dr. Henry Allen Moe, President of the American Philosophical Society. Dr. Moe will be succeeded in July 1966 by Dr. Barnaby Kereny, retiring President of Brown University. Among other classmates or friends of the classics on the Humanities Council, we note Professor Else, as remarked in our February issue (p. 208), and Prof. Robert Goheen, President of Princeton. — Ed.

CAUSA/Airlie/ACL will proceed, under the general supervision (cf. Jan., p. 172) of Professor Latimer as Executive Secretary, with the cooperation of four "Group Committees": I. Role (Prof. Edith Kovach, University of Detroit, Chairman); II. Curriculum (Prof. Austin Lashbrook, University of Kansas, Chairman); III. Methods (Joan Maissen, Oak Park [Ill.] High School, Chairman); IV. Teacher (June Stillwell, Clarence [N.Y.] High School, Chairman); and an Editorial Committee consisting of Prof. Charles Henderson, Jr., Smith College; Professor Latimer; and Prof. William M. Seaman, Michigan State University.

*CW*, with the cordial cooperation of CAAS, has been honored and happy to place its every resource behind the new movement. We look forward with the highest expectations to the first number of *Classical Action*. — E.A.R.

The following includes Greek and Latin works, listed separately, as follows: I. Texts (chiefly of individual authors); II.a. Beginner's Books (incl. graded series); II.b. Grammar; Metric; III. Readers; Anthologies; IV. Composition; V. Dictionaries; VI. New Testament Greek (a. Beginner's Books and Grammars; b. Dictionaries) and Later Latin.

Texts of authors are, in general, annotated editions. Bilinguals (e.g., the Loeb Classical Library), interlinears, and series of plain texts (e.g., the Oxford Classical Texts), have been omitted. The few annotated editions which include a translation are identified by "(w. tr.)", while the presence of

a vocabulary is indicated by "(v)", except where this may be assumed from the nature of the work (Beginner's Books, Composition) or the nature of the series (see below, Publishers, under O and SM). The list is confined to works published in the United States and Canada, with auxiliary material in English, except where otherwise noted.

Within the above limits, completeness has been aimed at, in the listing as such, and in the descriptive data. We have spared no effort to obtain correct information, but, naturally, prices and availability are subject to change without notice.

Users of this list are requested to mention it in their contacts with publishers, and they are advised to inquire about teachers' discounts. Some
