A BRIEF DESCRIPTION IS GIVEN OF THE FEDERAL ADULT BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM, UNDER THE ADULT EDUCATION ACT OF 1966, AT THE NATIONAL AND STATE LEVELS (INCLUDING PUERTO RICO, GUAM, AMERICAN SAMOA, AND THE VIRGIN ISLANDS) AS PROVIDED BY STATE EDUCATION AGENCIES. STATISTICS FOR FISCAL YEARS 1965 AND 1966, AND ESTIMATES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1967, INDICATE ANNUAL PARTICIPATION AND PROGRAM FUNDING. ESTIMATES ARE ALSO MADE OF FUNCTIONALLY INADEQUATE AND EDUCATIONALLY DISADVANTAGED ADULTS (PERSONS AGED 18-64), NUMBERS OF ADULTS IN VARIOUS AGE GROUPS WITH SEVEN YEARS' SCHOOLING OR LESS, FROM 1950 TO THE PRESENT (INCLUDING PROJECTIONS FOR 1968 AND 1970), ADULTS IN EACH AGE GROUP WHO HAVE ONE TO FOUR YEARS, OR NO MORE THAN SEVEN YEARS, OF COMPLETED SCHOOLING, AND ADULT WHITES AND NONWHITES IN EACH AGE GROUP WITH SEVEN YEARS OR LESS OF FORMAL EDUCATION. A Brief Description Of The Adult Basic Education Program

This is a state grant-in-aid program administered by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare through the Office of Education. The Adult Basic Education (ABE) program objective is the education of illiterate and under-educated adults over 18 years of age. At present, it is primarily limited to the elementary school level. After approval of state plans by the Office of Education, the states through the local school systems operate the program, which is funded on a 90% federal - 10% state basis. All 50 states, District of Columbia, and four territories are now receiving ABE funds.

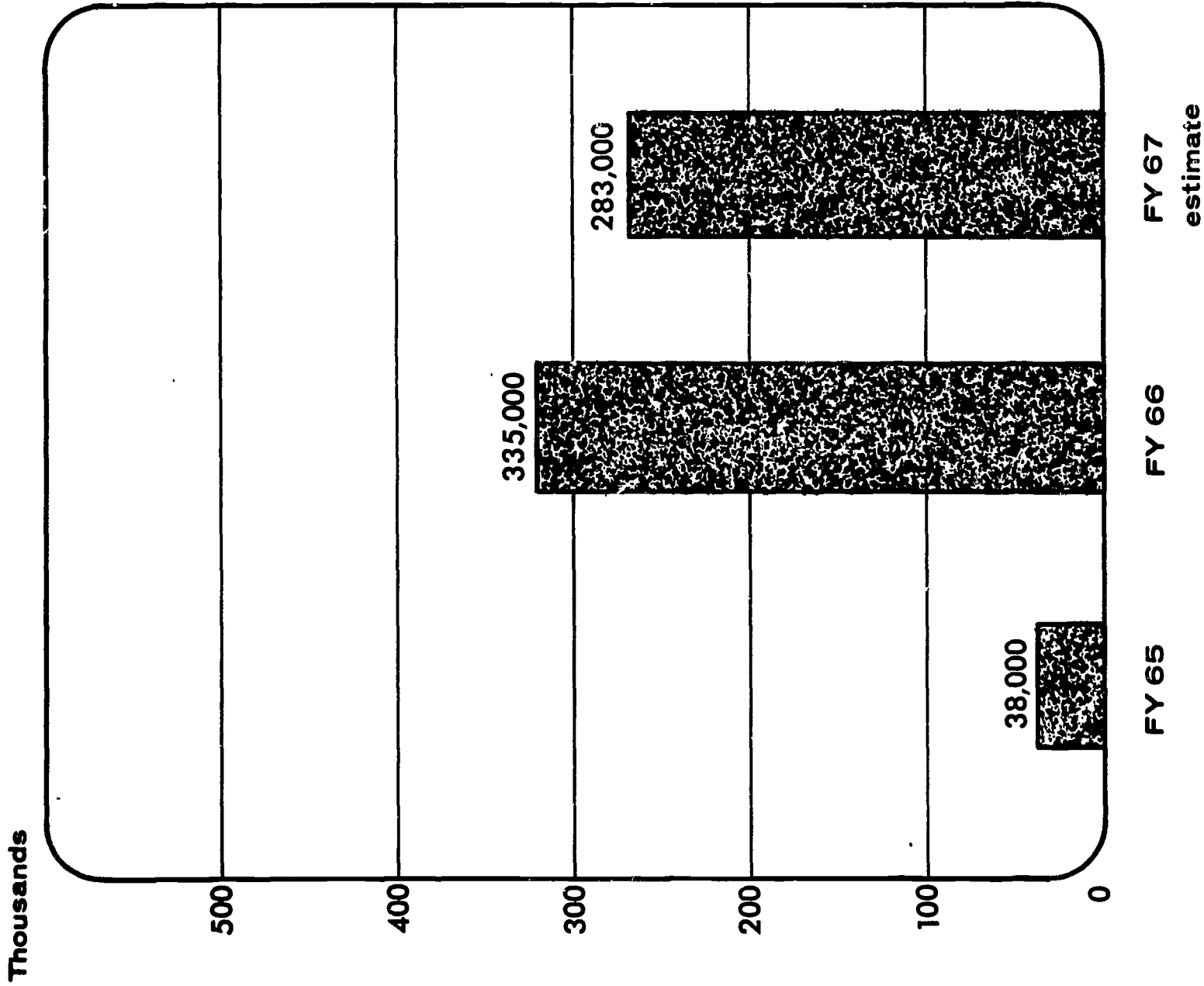
The program is authorized by the Adult Education Act of 1966, Title III of PL-89-750, whose purpose is to encourage and expand basic educational programs for adults to enable them to overcome English language limitations, to improve their basic education in preparation for occupational training and more profitable employment, and to become more productive and responsible citizens.

The specific mission of this program is to educate adults whose inability to speak, read, or write English constitutes a substantial impairment of their ability to get or retain employment based on their real abilities...with the view of making them less likely to become dependent on others.

ABE program officials in the U. S. Office of Education are Dr. Grant Venn, Associate Commissioner for Adult and Vocational Education; Mr. Jules Pagano, Director, Division of Adult Education Programs; and Dr. Derek Nunney, Chief, ABE Branch.

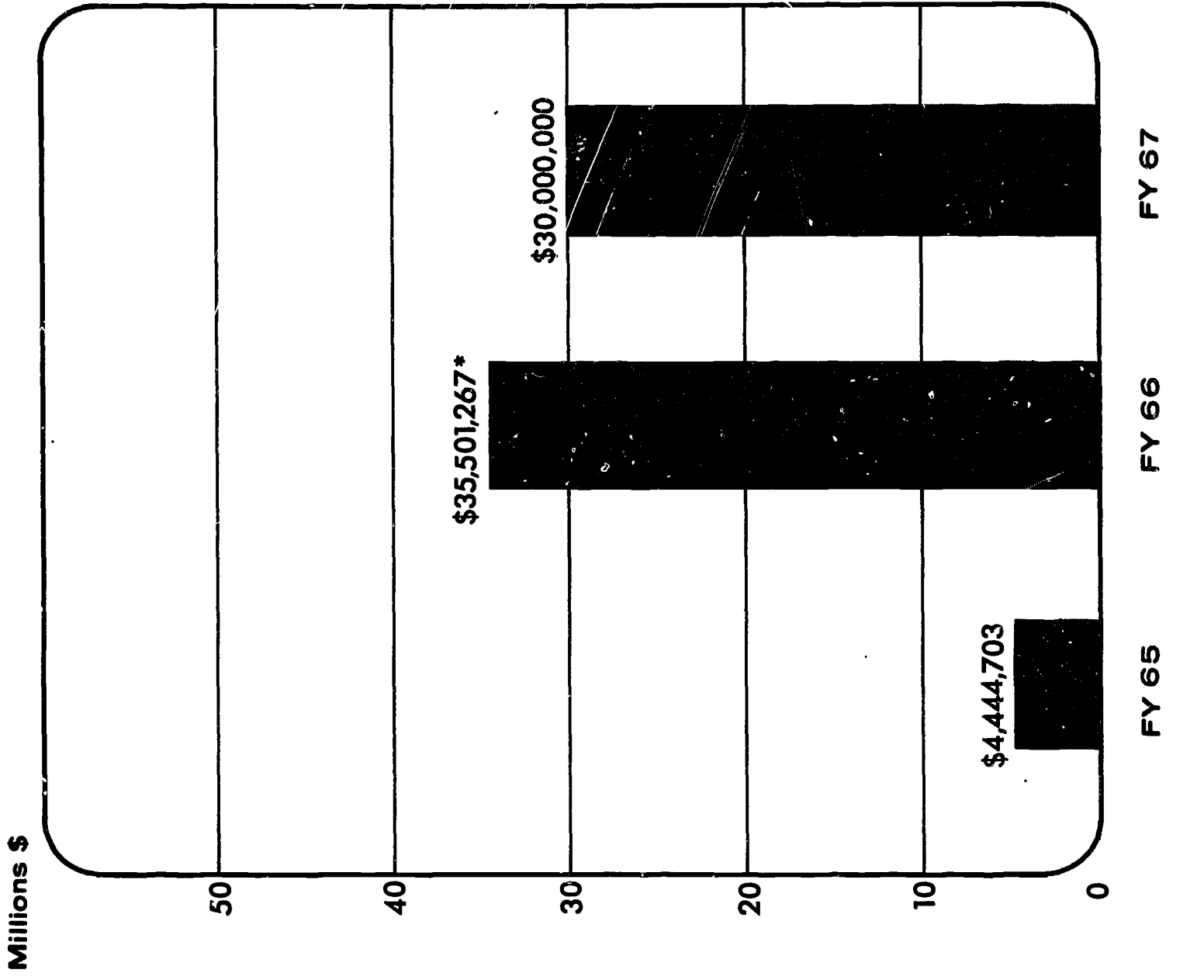
Adult Basic Education CHART I

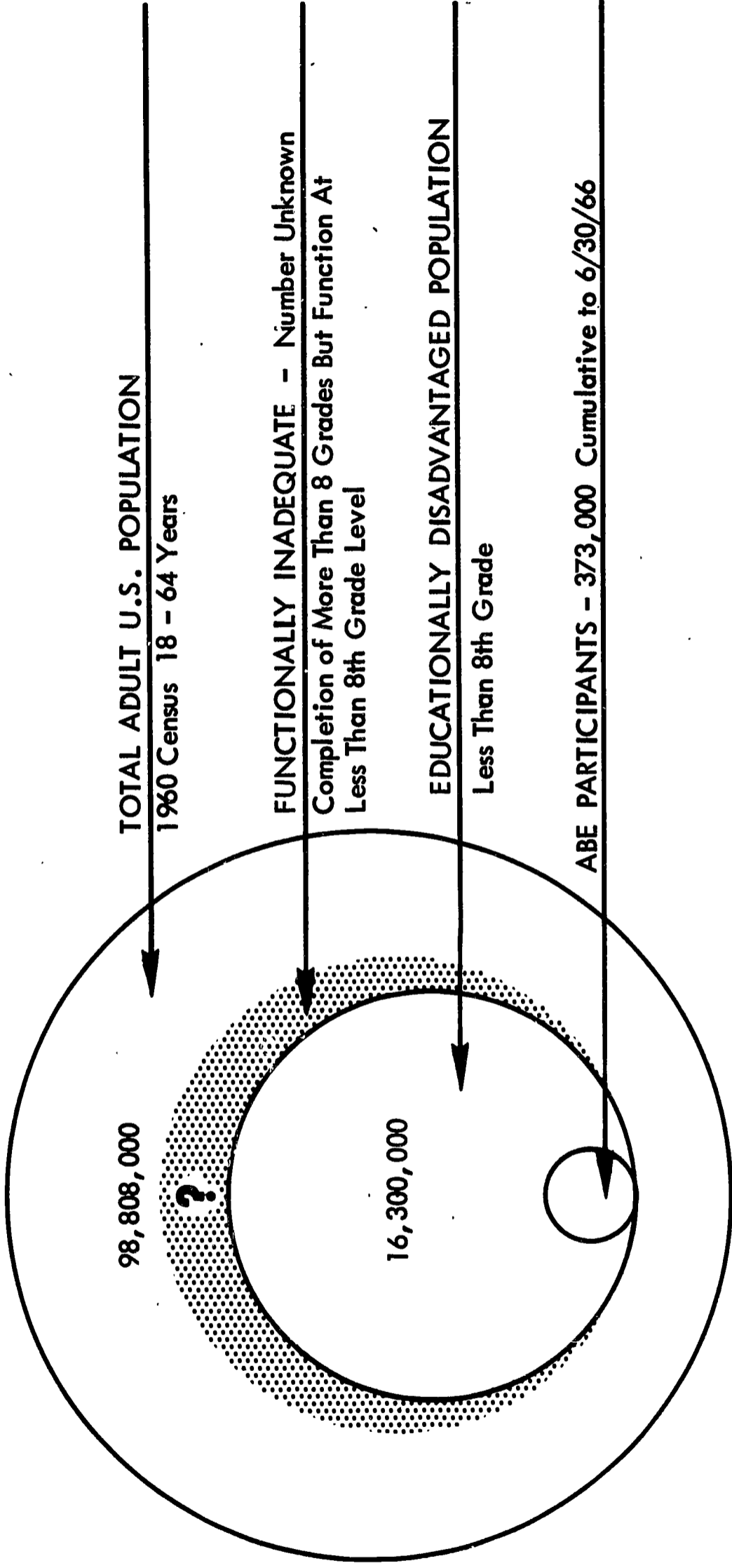

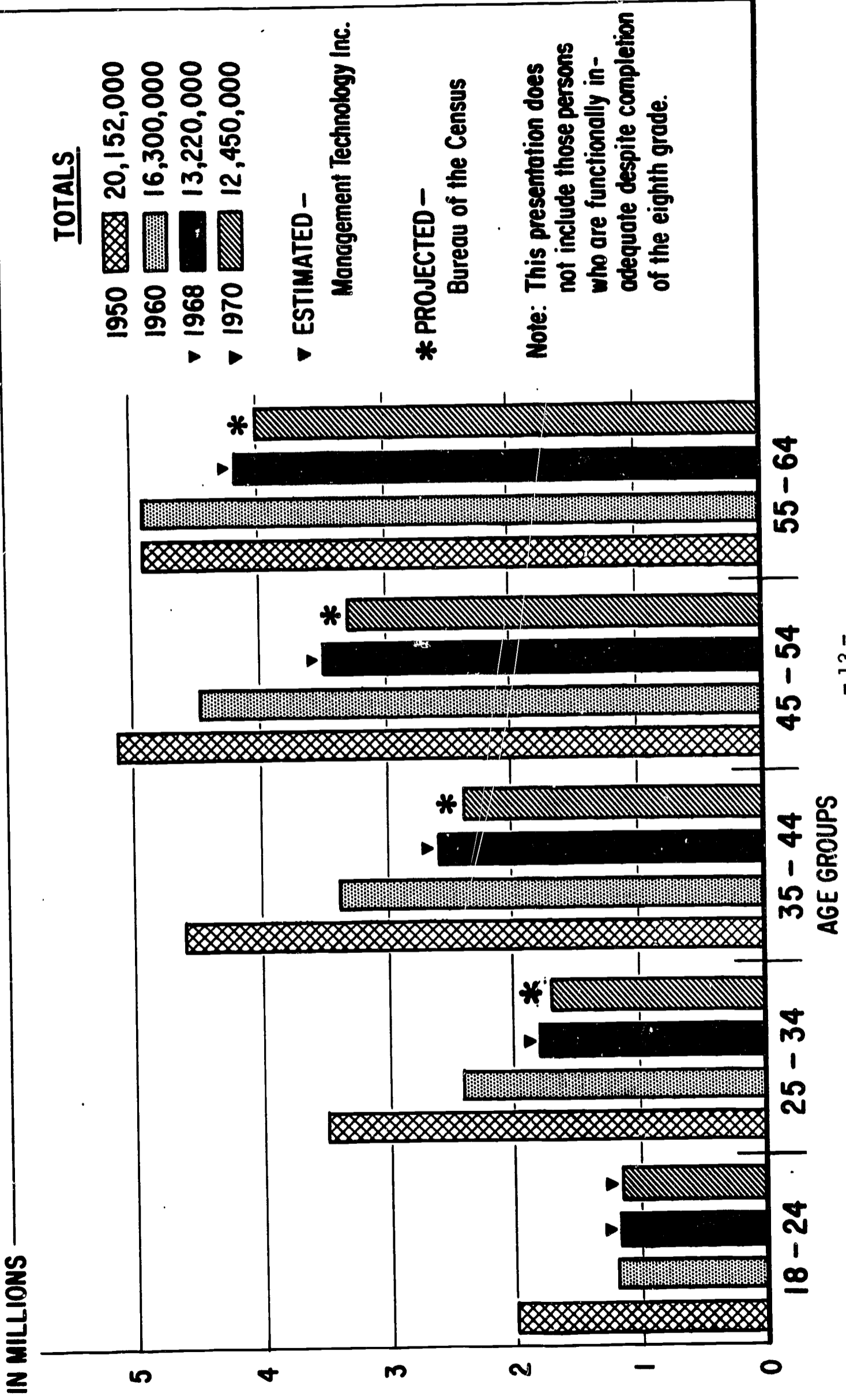
RELATIONSHIP OF POPULATIONS

U. S. ADULTS

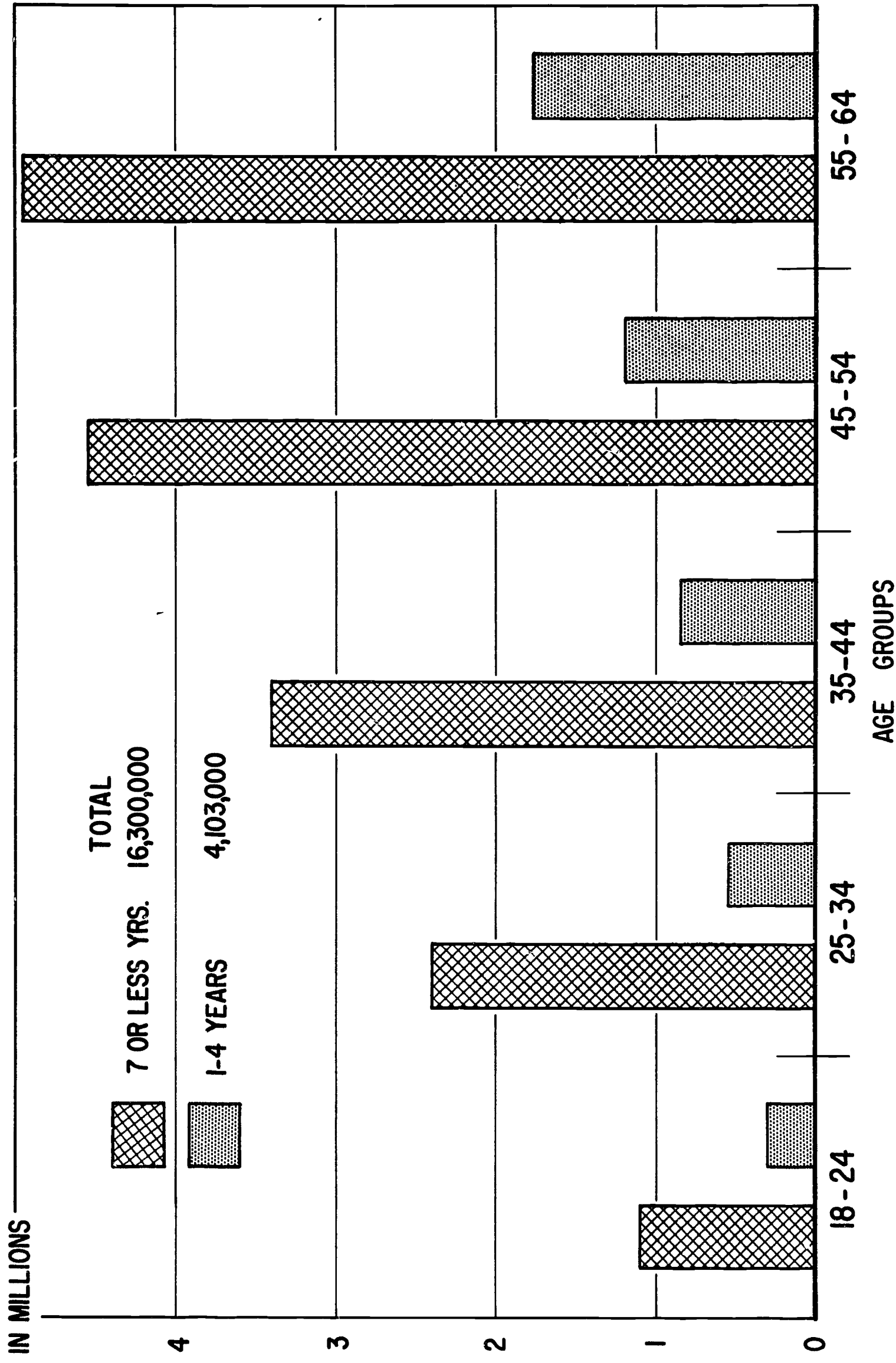
Ages 18 - 64
