This directory of occupational programs in public and private junior and community colleges in Illinois attempts to identify and locate the occupational programs being offered in the Fall Term of 1967. The directory also includes new programs in the planning stage along with implementation dates where that information was available.

The programs are arranged in five large groupings to conform with the patterns that appear to be emerging in community college occupational education.

The five are:

- Industrial and Engineering Technology
- Business, Secretarial, and Data Processing
- Health Occupations
- Public and Social Service
- Other Programs

The information in the directory was supplied by administrative personnel, in most cases by occupation education directors, of the 42 public and 8 private members of the Illinois Association of Junior and Community Colleges. Four public junior college districts, Kishwaukee, Lincoln Land, McHenry County, and Southwest Cook County have been organized quite recently and have no programs to list at this time although the college names do appear in the directory. Three other public junior college districts, Egyptian, Lake, and Shawnee are so recent they do not appear at all in this year's directory. All Association member colleges are listed, however, so that corrections or additions may be made later since several colleges did not reply to the initial questionnaire and the follow-up.

The titles used for occupation programs are generally those common to community colleges. However some direct contact with the appropriate institution may be necessary to get information on the exact nature of the offerings since in some cases programs which are moderately different have been lumped together under a common title. Similarly, different lengths and levels of programs may occasionally be grouped together. In addition, no distinction is made between work experience programs and conventional ones.

Finally, the listing of operational programs and planned programs does not necessarily indicate approval by the State Board of Vocational Education, the Illinois Junior College Board, or any other public agency. The concept of this directory was developed from a section meeting of junior college occupational directors held at the I.A.C.J.C. Peoria Conference, November 16-18, 1967.

Since this is the first attempt to put together a directory to serve many needs—vocational counselors, community college staffs, state supervisory personnel, employment services—there are undoubtedly many things that could have been done differently. Please do not hesitate to communicate your comments so that subsequent editions of this directory may be more useful.
