

In most cases the date is obtained from the document. In a few cases, when no date of publication is on the document, the date is estimated based on the best information available in the document.

Field ten identifies the number of pages in the document. This document contains four pages. Use of this field will provide information concerning the length of the document.

(11) *BIOLOGY, *CHEMISTRY, *SCIENCE HISTORY, *PHYSICS, *SCIENCE CASE HISTORIES, *SECONDARY SCHOOL SCIENCE, *TEACHING TECHNIQUES, PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

This field provides an indication of the ideas included in the document. Each term, such as *BIOLOGY, has been selected by an information analyst because the term is important for the identification of the document. Terms marked with an asterisk represent primary ideas in the document; the other terms represent ideas of lesser importance. You can use this information to narrow the number of documents you want to review.
