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This bibliography lists 117 journal articles, 10 books, and 14 dissertations published in 1966 and 1967. Particular subjects treated include negotiation research, grievance procedures, teacher strikes, teacher associations, and the roles of the various participants--school superintendents, principals, teachers, and board members--in the collective negotiation process. 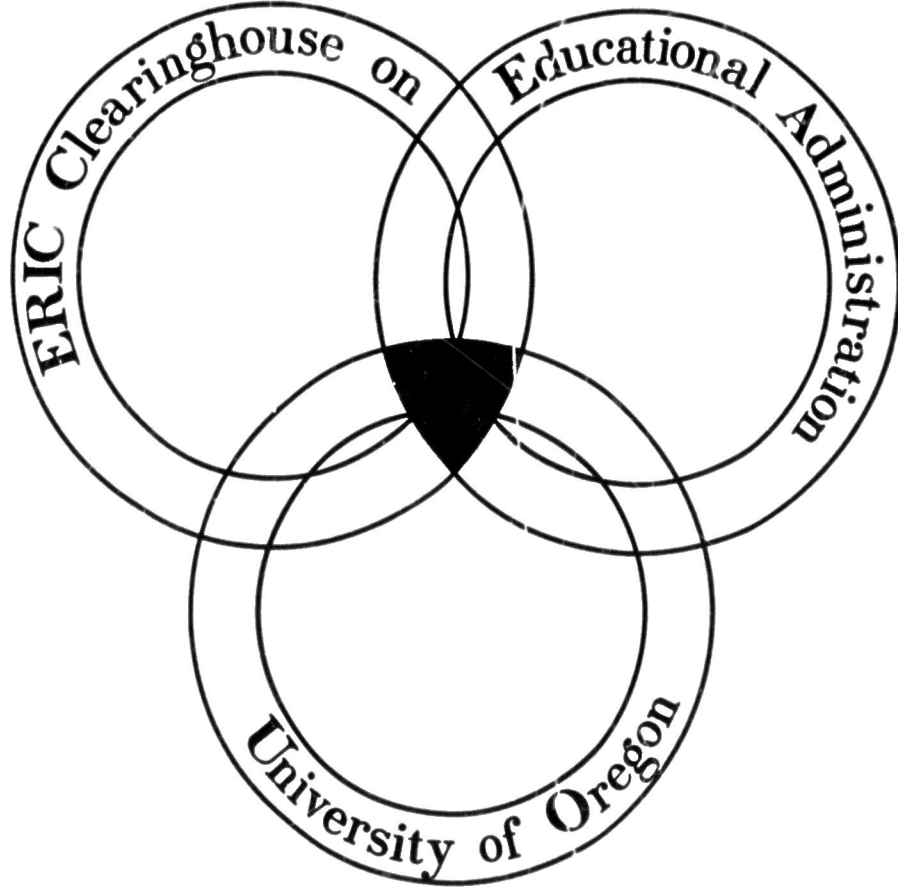

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Introduction

With teacher militancy on the rise across the nation, the literature about its causes, consequences, and cures is growing rapidly. Although the rapid pace of events outdates most of the literature before its publication, the books, dissertations, and journal articles included in this bibliography will provide the user with the basic information necessary for understanding the current status of collective negotiations and for anticipating the pattern of future events..

The bulk of the citations included in this bibliography are from current journal articles; however, fourteen dissertations and ten books published in 1966 and 1967 are included. None of the documents in this bibliography are available from this Clearinghouse or from the ERIC Document Reproduction Service.

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
