Dear Dr. Tabor:

The attached report, which is forwarded to you for information and evaluation, was prepared by the College Student Body Office to show the various financial operations of the Associated Students during the 1967-68 year.

This has been a successful year with financial activities more than keeping pace with increasing enrollments. Gross receipts from all sources climbed past \$577,000 and the A.S. budget of \$120,275 ended the year with a balance of \$14,662.12. The June 30 current value of all student body controlled accounts was \$193,139.27. Adding the payment of \$115,000 toward indebtedness on the new bookstore building places the year's financial activities about 20% above prior year.

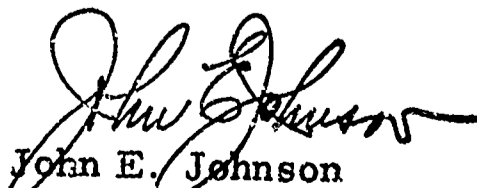
Student Body Card sales and Bookstore profit continue as the major sources of income. Respectively, these total \$67,136.73 and \$55,461.32 and provide more than 80% of the net income. While athletic admissions increased slightly, the net receipts from these events (\$7,564.42) provided for only 17¢ of each dollar spent (\$44,970.70) for intercollegiate athletics.

The food service operations---Cafeteria and Snack Bar---continue the policy of "wholesome food at minimum cost." Pleasingly, both endeavors operated in the black in spite of rising costs. The drop in cafeteria gross sales from prior year high was due largely to the delayed opening last September.

Certainly the new Don Bookstore and cafeteria expansion add much to the campus and now ably provide quality service to students in these critical areas.

Ron Sabo is to be commended for his close supervision of details connected with completion and moving the bookstore. Being well organized this proceeded with minimum confusion and necessitated only one-half day "out of service." He and his competent staff under the direction of Dean Trawick handled the full gamut of student body finance in a most businesslike manner. The cooperation of Dr. Miller and the Central Business Office is much appreciated.
