Items are arranged by subject matter into categories as defined by Kreitlow's "Taxonomy of Needed Research"; these consist basically of characteristics of adults as individuals and as learners, response of adults to instructional methods, and the adult education enterprise. Following each of the 20 subsections of the taxonomy are numbers referring to thesis titles (numbers for Ph.D. dissertations are underlined). This document is a classified bibliography of research of interest to adult educators which has been completed at the University of Wisconsin from September 1966 to June 1968. The titles listed are theses completed by graduate students in the departments of Agricultural and Extension Education, Curriculum and Instruction, Agricultural Journalism, Rural Sociology, Educational Administration, Educational Psychology, Behavioral Disabilities, Educational Policy Studies and Art Education.

The bibliography has been classified by subject matter into categories as defined by Kreitlow's Taxonomy of Needed Research¹. This taxonomy consists basically of three broad areas of research:

- A. Characteristics of adults as individuals and learners.
- B. Response of adults to methods, independent study, program planning, evaluation, etc.
- C. The adult education enterprise.

Following each subsection of this taxonomy are numbers which refer to the theses titles. These titles are listed alphabetically by author on the pages succeeding the classification scheme. Underlined numbers signify titles which are Ph.D. dissertations.

The original publications are available at the Memorial Library at the University of Wisconsin in Madison or through the major faculty member whose name is indicated following the academic department under whose jurisdiction the research was conducted.
