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Score Distributions, General Examinations, College-Level Examination Program; Candidates Tested Through the United States Armed Forces Institute, July 1965-December 1966.

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Score distributions were obtained for 43,877 candidates tested through the United States Armed Forces Institute (USAFI) on all five College-Level Entrance Program (CLEP) General Examinations. Findings included the following: (1) the majority of candidates were between ages 19 and 22; (2) 69.37 had completed high school but only 20.77 had attended college; (3) in general, four years of college added 100 points to individual scores; (4) overall average scores increased from age 17 to a peak around ages 22-24; (5) the oldest group (over 40) was not the lowest on any of the examinations; (6) observed differences between highest and lowest scoring age groups were smallest for English Composition (20 points) and largest for Social Sciences-History (50); (7) average scores on the five examinations were consistently related to each other for ages 17-24, but by age 30 the relationships had shifted. In a summary memorandum to college admissions officers concerning USAFI candidates and CLEP scores, the College Entrance Examination Board stressed the importance of obtaining veterans' CLEP and equivalent scores and reporting them to the USAFI. MEMORANDUM TO: College Admissions Officers

SUBJECT: USAFI Candidates and CLEP Scores

Under special arrangements between the College-Level Examination Program and the United States Armed Forces Institute, the General Examinations of CLEP are available for administration to members of the Armed Forces. Through the cooperation of USAFI, the College Board has been furnished with score distributions of all USAFI candidates who took the complete battery of five General Examinations during the period July 1965 - December 1966. A total of 43,877 candidates were tested. We have here, perhaps for the first time, some indication of the college-level achievement of a substantial number of American adults most of whom have not formally attended college.

We are sharing with you some of the first systematic data about these candidates and the CLEP examinations. We feel sure the information will be of great interest to you. Appended to this memorandum are three tables that indicate some of the data that are now available. Table I shows percentile ranks for the total group of USAFI candidates. Table II shows percentile ranks for those USAFI candidates whose highest level of formal education completed was high school twelfth grade. Table III shows percentile ranks for those USAFI candidates who had had one year of college.

Here are some of the observations based not only on the tables attached but all of the data obtained from USAFI.

- a. Among candidates tested by USAFI there is evidence of thousands of people whose achievement would qualify them for consideration for college credit on the basis of recommendations made by the Commission on Accreditation of Service Experiences* (CASE) of the American Council on Education. CASE recommends that credit and advanced standing be awarded to adults, both military and civilian, for scores at or above the 25th percentile of the national college norming groups.
- b. The average USAFI candidate exceeded the score levels recommended by CASE for consideration for college credit in three of the five tests, and in the other two, for all practical purposes, equalled the level recommended.

- c. Although the total USAFI candidate group had average scores on each of the examinations lower than regularly matriculated students tested at the end of their sophomore year in college, it should be emphasized that only 20 out of 100 USAFI candidates have attended college at all.
- d. The data reveal that there were thousands of adults who had not attended college whose scores exceeded those of the average college-taught sophomores.
- e. The USAFI data substantiates the CLEP premise that educational achievement among American adults is substantial and beyond that which might be indicated solely on the basis of records of formal college attendance. For instance, among the approximately 44,000 candidates tested, only 4200 claimed completion of formal college work beyond the freshman year. As measured by the General Examinations and following standards recommended by CASE, the number of individuals whose achievement was beyond freshman year varies from test to test but ranges from 18 to 24 thousand.
- f. The USAFI data, of course, also show that thousands of candidates were not able to demonstrate achievement at the college-level. The Program points to this aspect of the results only to indicate that the examinations are rigorous and do discriminate among candidates and that all who take them do not necessarily succeed.
- g. The USAFI data adds to the store of validity information for the General Examinations. All other things being equal, one would expect General Examinations scores to increase with the amount of formal education completed. This was observed with the USAFI data. There is a steady progression of scores on all tests when mean scores are tabulated according to formal education completed from high school twelfth grade to four years of college. In fact, the data suggest, as a rough rule, that for the USAFI group four years of college added approximately 100 points to General Examinations scores.
- h. USAFI also furnished score data by age of candidate tested. These data offer no encouragement to the idea that CLEP General Examinations are biased against the older candidate. For two examinations the oldest candidate group (those over 40 years of age) had the highest mean scores. For the remaining examinations, the lowest mean scores were attained by candidates of ages somewhere between the youngest and the oldest groups tested.

The College Board will publish these data and make them available. In the meanwhile, it seemed important to share this information with you. The scores of some USAFI candidates have been reported to colleges but this has not happened as frequently as it should. Therefore, the College Board recommends that Admissions Officers ask returning servicemen if they have taken CLEP (or CCT)* General Examinations, and further, that the veteran release his scores through USAFI. Should any veteran be uncertain as to how to arrange to have USAFI report his General Examinations scores he should be instructed to write to Department

of Defense, United States Armed Forces Institute, Madison, Wisconsin 53703.* USAFI has indicated it is important that the veteran provide all Military Service numbers as well as his Social Security number to assist in correctly identifying his records. USAFI will report scores without charge.

Moreover, veterans in increasing numbers are seeking college admission, and because more and more adults, who have acquired their learning through non-traditional ways, are seeking recognition for their work, it seems advisable that institutions participating in CLEP should publish a definitive policy statement in their catalog and elsewhere to encourage all candidates to submit their CLEP scores. For veterans, the opportunity to obtain credit through CLEP means their government educational benefits can be used more effectively. For any educationally ambitious individual the opportunity to move forward and to obtain recognition for previous learning provides incentive and encouragement.

For those institutions not familiar with the Program and its purposes, the College Board will provide informational materials and assistance in developing effective local programs. The College Board also offers free trial administrations of the examinations to enable colleges to obtain first hand experience with the examinations and to develop score interpretive material which has local relevance.

The Source of the Data

A contractual arrangement exists between Educational Testing Service (acting on behalf of the College Board) and the United States Armed Forces Institute (USAFI) for the use of the General Examinations of the College-Level Examination Program (CLEP). Under this arrangement, ETS furnishes copies of the examinations to USAFI. USAFI, in turn, arranges for the administration of the examinations, under secure conditions, to members of the armed forces who wish to take them. USAFI also scores the examinations and reports scores at the candidates' requests to colleges and universities.

Through the cooperation of USAFI, score distributions were obtained for all candidates who took the complete battery of five General Examinations during the period July 1965 through December 1966. Using these data, ETS prepared the tables in this report.

A total of 43,877 candidates were tested. Percentile ranks for the total group of candidates are shown in Table I.

Formal Education Completed:

Percentile ranks tables for USAFI candidates grouped on the basis of formal education completed are shown in Tables II through VII.

Age Distribution of the Group Tested:

USAFI prepared score distributions for each age where the total number of candidates was at least 100. Distributions for ages 17 through 40 were prepared. In addition a single distribution for all candidates over age 40 was prepared which presents data for 567 individuals. For only 259 candidates was it impossible to determine age at the time of testing. Percentile ranks tables by age are presented in Tables VIII through XXXIII.

Readers will observe that the number of candidates varies by test in these tables. This is due to the fact that the candidates were not required to take the full battery of five examinations in a single sitting. For a few candidates there was a minor change in age between the time they took the first test in the battery and when they completed the full battery.

The above facts complicate the task of making generalized statements about the age composition of the total group of candidates. It is not possible, for example, to compute a mean age for the group. However, the modal age is 20 years and the median age is 21 years. A further indication that the USAFI candidate group consists of young adults is the fact that the majority of the candidates were between 19 and 22 years of age.

Candidate Achievement

Achievement Related to Previous Formal Education:

The total USAFI candidate group had mean scores on each of the examinations which were significantly lower than those for groups for which CLEP has previously compiled data*. However, the Program normative data, heretofore, has been confined to scores earned by students enrolled in formal college educational programs at various levels, such as college freshmen, college sophomores, and college seniors. Given the distribution of formal education completed (see Table A on page 3) which shows that only 29% have attended college, it is not surprising that the USAFI candidate group did less well than the CLEP college student normative groups.

Obviously, the use of General Examinations by USAFI candidates is not intended to demonstrate that anyone regardless of formal educational background can achieve at levels attained by regular college students. Instead a major purpose of CLEP is to assist colleges to identify those individuals who have achieved beyond their formal education and to measure the extent of such achievement. The tables of this report suggest that substantial numbers of such people can be found by colleges among USAFI tested individuals. How many will be found depends, of course, upon the achievement levels colleges set up or are willing to recognize. However, roughly one out of two USAFI candidates achieved at levels equal to or higher than those which have been commended to colleges for consideration by the Commission on Accreditation of Service Experiences (CASE) of the American Council on Education**.

The USAFI data add to the store of validity information for the General Examinations. All other things being equal, one would expect General Examinations scores to increase with the amount of formal education completed. The following table shows how the data gathered support that expectation:

It is not known what factors of selection, if any, operated within the USAFI candidate group. Yet these data do show a steady progression of scores on all tests when mean scores are tabulated according to the amount of formal education completed from high school twelfth grade through four years of college. As a rough rule for the USAFI group, four years of college added approximately 100 points to General Examinations scores.

Achievement Related to Age:

Since data on college level achievement of American adults, in terms other than attendance in formal education programs, has been largely non-existent, the General Examinations score distributions by age groups provide some fascinating information. Admittedly only limited or tentative conclusions can be drawn from the data because the considerations influencing USAFI candidates to take the examinations are not known. For example, it is not known whether those tested at age 17 were typical servicemen or whether they were among the most able servicemen of this age. Moreover, it is not known whether there was any differential selection of those tested, say, at age 17 vs. those at age 40. Obviously few, if any, college graduates were among the USAFI candidates who were 17 years old. It is not known how many, if any, college graduates were in the USAFI 40 year old group. However, it is possible that the 40 year old group contained more people who had some formal college education than the 17 year old group.

The following observations are based on the USAFI score distributions by age:

1. The oldest age group had the highest mean scores on two of the five examinations. For Social Sciences-History and for Humanities the over 40-age group mean was higher than that for any other age group. One would expect that of the five tests in the General Examinations battery, Social Sciences-History and Humanities would be more responsive to the accumulated value of "life experience". (Those age groups that had the least life experience--including formal education--namely, 17 and 18 year olds, had the lowest mean scores on these two tests.) Conversely the three tests (English Composition, Mathematics, and Natural Sciences) where the oldest candidates did not have the highest mean scores are examinations where the recency, nature and kind of formal educational experience a candidate had had might weigh more heavily.
2. The oldest age group was not the lowest scoring group on any of the examinations. Observations 1 and 2 offer no encouragement to the idea that CLEP General Examinations are biased against the older candidate.
3. The observed differences in means between the highest scoring age group and the lowest scoring age group varied from test to test. These differences were smallest in English Composition (20 points) and largest in Social Sciences-History (50 points).
4. Average scores on the five examinations in the battery had consistent relationships to each other from age 17 through 24. That is, at each age the highest mean was in Natural Sciences; next highest, Mathematics; then followed Social Sciences-History, Humanities and English Composition in that order. After age 24 the relationships between the

examinations began to shift so that by age 30 the examinations had established a different relationship to each other. By age 30 and thereafter the highest mean was in Social Sciences-History; next highest, in the Natural Sciences; then followed Humanities, Mathematics and English Composition in that order.

5. The distributions in Tables VIII through XXXIII report on achievement throughout a substantial portion of the young adult years--for ages 17 to over 40--a range of ages spanning more than 23 years. Average scores on all five examinations increase from age 17 to a peak around ages 22-24. For three examinations--English Composition, Mathematics, and Natural Sciences--there then follows a decline so that the first peak is, indeed, the highest average achievement level attained. For Social Sciences-History, average scores move upward after age 24--(albeit with some fluctuations) until the highest level of all is reached by the over-40 group. Humanities average score declines for age 25 through age 28--followed by a recovery so that by age 36 and beyond the earlier high score levels are equaled or exceeded.
