Information supplied by research directors of 48 large public school systems in 24 States was tabulated to indicate usage of various achievement, aptitude, and interest tests. Tabulations include instrument usage of 43 achievement tests at the elementary level (grades K-6), 43 at the middle level (grades 7-9), and 42 at the secondary level (grades 10-12); 22, 16, and 13 aptitude tests at the same three levels, respectively; three interest tests at the middle level; and two interest tests at the secondary level. PURPOSES OF SURVEY

The development of a Program Planning-Budgeting-Evaluating System in a large school system will engender the need for widespread instructional program evaluation. While the county-wide testing program of Dade County Public Schools has been carefully developed over a period of years, the special needs of program evaluation for many different types of instructional programs do require that one looks beyond the existing testing program. As a first step in this process, the staff felt that an identification of a pool of educational assessment instruments used throughout most of the large school systems could be useful. While this pool of instruments is not intended to constrict the search of school faculties in determining appropriate evaluations of their programs, it will provide at least a direction in which to focus.

PROCEDURES

The Dade County PPBES staff sent a letter (see Appendix A) to the Research Directors of each of the sixty-four largest school systems requesting a description of their testing programs. Seventy-seven percent of the systems responded. A listing of the responding systems is included also in Appendix A.

The data was compiled by summating the number of times a particular test was used at each grade level. While this procedure does describe the relative usage of an instrument at a particular grade level, it does not of course reflect cumulatively the relative usage of the tests on an intra-system basis. Tests, which were developed locally and not identifiable in <u>Tests in Print</u>, were excluded.



RESULTS

The results, which are included in tables immediately following, have been broken into two classifications: (1) type of test (achievement, aptitude and personality/interest) and (2) grade level (Elementary K-2, Elementary 3-6, Middle, and Secondary). Each group is arranged with the most frequently used test first and other frequently used tests appearing in descending order. All tests reported as being used are listed alphabetically in Appendix B.
