ABSTRACT

Developed from selected studies made by State Employment Services, this directory provides current local occupational information for use in designing training programs, for counseling in public employment offices and schools, and for individual jobseekers and vocational counselors. Three sections are devoted to occupational guides listed by occupational group broken down by occupation within each group, by job title and by states. These guides are cross-indexed by occupation and area and provide a summary of the job duties, training and experience requirements, training facilities, and employment aspects for a single occupation or group of occupations. A listing of occupational guidance publications dated from 1954-1969 provides information on occupations in a particular industry or job field that could not be listed under specific job titles. Finally, a listing of 286 area occupational projection surveys provides information on current employment and future labor requirements, generally 2 to 5 years ahead, in individual labor areas. DICTIONARY OF OCCUPATIONAL TITLES, Volume I, \$5.00. Lists 35,000 job titles in alphabetical order with definitions for almost 22,000 individual occupations. Volume II, \$4.25. Presents occupational classification structure of USTES.

TRAINING AND REFERENCE MANUAL FOR JOB ANALYSIS, May 1965, \$.60. Basic guide for occupational analysts and other personnel workers concerned with the techniques and procedures for collecting source data essential to development of occupational information materials.

HEALTH CAREERS GUIDEBOOK, \$1.75. Provides background facts, educational requirements, and descriptive profiles for approximately 200 occupations in health.

JOB GUIDE FOR YOUNG WORKERS, revision due for publication in fall of 1969. Contains information on job opportunities open to persons leaving high school, as well as an orientation to the process of jobseeking.

OCCUPATIONS IN THE FIELD OF LIBRARY SCIENCE, \$.30. Presents occupational descriptions, special worker characteristics, and working conditions for 22 occupations in Library Science. Also included is staffing pattern of typical library.

OCCUPATIONS IN ELECTRONIC COMPUTING SYSTEMS, \$.30. Provides information on 23 key occupations in the electronic data processing and computing field.

OCCUPATIONS IN THE CARE AND REHABILITATION OF THE MENTALLY RETARDED, \$.35. Discusses problems peculiar to the care and rehabilitation of those afflicted with mental retardation; also describes 27 occupations involved in such care and rehabilitation.

SELECTED OCCUPATIONS CONCERNED WITH ATOMIC ENERGY, \$.25. Information on 14 jobs in the peaceful application of atomic energy, including worker trait requirements.

TECHNICAL REPORT ON OCCUPATIONS IN NUMERICALLY CONTROLLED METAL-CUTTING MACHINING, \$.45. Discusses the changes in these machining occupations due to introduction and use of automatically controlled machine tools, implications for future, and descriptions of 14 new and changed jobs.

HANDBOOK ON EMPLOYMENT SECURITY JOB MARKET RESEARCH METHODS--AREA SKILL SURVEY. Provides State employment service agencies with a methodology for estimating current and future labor supply and demand by occupation and industry in a specific labor area or large geographical unit. (Available upon request from the Manpower Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, Washington, D.C. 20210.)

MANPOWER AND OPERATIONS RESEARCH STUDIES OF THE U.S. EMPLOYMENT SERVICE AND STATE EMPLOYMENT SERVICES, 1958-67. Covers research in job market conditions and developments, occupational analysis techniques, job opportunity information services to employers and workers, and counseling and testing. PREFACE

This publication is a directory of selected State employment services' studies intended to provide current local occupational information for use in designing training programs, for counseling in local public employment offices and schools, and to offer individual jobseekers and vocational counselors concrete information on job opportunities in specific occupations or groups of occupations. Under the Job Opportunities Information Program which was initiated in 1956, two principal types of local occupational information have been promoted: Guides; and area occupational projection surveys (formerly titled area skill surveys). Of particular importance to the interested user of this guide is the inclusion of occupational guides published recently by various State agencies in conjunction with U.S. Training and Employment Service and manpower programs such as HRD, Opportunity Line, CEP, JOBS, WIN, and other programs directed toward upgrading the underemployed and promoting employment opportunities for the unemployed. These guides have been included in various parts of the directory and are identified by an asterisk and footnoted in the Guide as "Guide for the disadvantaged."

This Guide to Local Occupational Information is divided into five sections:

Part I lists occupational guides by occupational group and by occupation within that group as they appear in the Dictionary of Occupational Titles, Volume II.

Part II lists occupational guides by Job Title.

Part III lists occupational guides by State.

Part IV lists occupational guidance publications covering selected industries, occupational fields, or special worker groups by State.

Part V lists area occupational projection surveys by State.

Occupational Guides (parts I-III), cross-indexed by occupation and area in this publication, are prepared by State employment services and provide a concise summary of the job duties and employment prospects for a single occupation or group of occupations in a particular area or State. These Job Guides also contain information on the characteristics of the occupation, training and experience requirements, local training facilities, methods of entry, promotional opportunities, and information on wages and working conditions for the job. Of special interest to those concerned with job market and general occupational information on entry jobs for the underemployed and unemployed are the guides prepared for the disadvantaged by States concerned with this target group.

Occupational Guidance Publications (part IV) are those that cover several occupations in a particular industry or job field and could not be listed under specific job titles in parts I-III.

Area Occupational Projection Surveys (part V), formerly titled Area Skill Surveys, are designed to provide comprehensive information of current employment and future labor requirements in individual labor areas. These studies relate community manpower resources to anticipated long-term occupational requirements, generally two to five years ahead. Such reports--completed in more than 40 States--generally include information on supply and demand in significant local occupational groups.

Reviewing the occupational guides listed herein can provide valuable assistance to States seeking to develop and/or improve local occupational information publications. Studying published guides can eliminate duplication of effort in (a) research and development of occupational information for selected occupations, (b) selection of desired format as to style, presentation, and art design, and (c) determining content most suitable for selected target groups.
