ABSTRACT

Institutions of higher education were asked to report inventory information as of September 30, 1968, concerning floor space on their main campus and at any branch or extension center. The inventory was to be based on the "Higher Education Facilities and Inventory Procedures Manual." Of institutions enrolling 90% of the total student body, 82% responded. The gross area for all institutions was estimated to be nearly 1.5 billion square feet. Public institutions, with 71% of the full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment, had 60% of the gross area; private institutions, with 29% of the FTE enrollment, had 40%. Of the reported assignable space, 63% was in public institutions and 37% in private ones. When facilities were classified by room type, the largest amount of assignable square feet--31% of the total--was reported to be residential facilities. Classrooms constituted less than 9% of the total. Public universities used less than 6% of their assignable space for classrooms, while public two year colleges used 19%. The survey form and a list of nonresponding institutions are included. (AF)

HIGHLIGHTS

From inventory data reported as of September 30, 1968, the gross area of physical facilities for all colleges and universities was estimated to be nearly 1.5 billion square feet.

Public institutions, with 71 percent of the full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment, had 60 percent of the gross area; private institutions, with 29 percent of the FTE enrollment, had 40 percent.

More than 1.0 billion square feet were estimated to be net assignable square feet.

Of the reported assignable space (925 million square feet), 63 percent was in publicly controlled institutions and 37 percent in privately controlled institutions.

When facilities were classified by room type, the largest amount of assignable square feet--31 percent of the total--was reported to be residential facilities. Privately controlled institutions devoted 34 percent of their space to residential facilities; publicly controlled colleges and universities, 28 percent.

Classrooms constituted less than 9 percent of the total. Publicly controlled universities used less than 6 percent of their assignable space for classrooms, whereas publicly controlled 2-year colleges used 19 percent.

FOREWORD

The data in this publication were obtained by the U.S. Office of Education through OE form 2300-7, part of the Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS III), reported as of September 30, 1968. Although the responding institutions accounted for only 82 percent of the number of institutions surveyed, they represented over 90 percent of the total enrollment.

The last comprehensive publication by the Office of Education on physical facilities in higher education was College and University Facilities Survey, Part 3: Inventory of College and University Physical Facilities, December 31, 1957, OE-51007. The 1957 study, which was a building-by-building analysis, is now being updated for a separate report to provide a detailed analysis of the changes that have taken place since 1957, and to include information on the investment in and value of the facilities.

We wish to thank the State Coordinating Commissions, State Facilities Commissions, and the more than 2,000 college administrators who supplied the data for this study. Special appreciation goes to Professors Duane Jordan and James Lawrence, of Texas Technological College, who provided consultation during the editing of the national survey forms.

SUMMARY

Institutions of higher education were asked to report inventory information as of September 30, 1968, concerning floor space on their main campus and at any branch or extension center, based on the Higher Education Facilities Classification and Inventory Procedures Manual.^{1/}

ESTIMATED TOTALS

Gross area of physical facilities of all colleges and universities was estimated from the survey data to be nearly 1.5 billion square feet.^{2/} Of this total, more than 1.0 billion square feet (69 percent) were estimated to be net assignable square feet. "Gross area" has been defined as "the sum of the floor areas included within the outside faces of exterior walls for all stories, or areas, which have floor surfaces."^{3/} "Net assignable area" (also referred to as "assignable square feet" or "assignable area") has been construed to mean "the sum of all areas on all floors of a building assigned to, or available for assignment to, an occupant, including every type of space functionally usable by an occupant," except for custodial, circulation, mechanical, and construction areas.^{3/}

Table 1A indicates that in terms of "room type" the largest amount of assignable floor space--31 percent of the total--was devoted to combined residential facilities. The second-largest area--14 percent--was classified as laboratory space. Classrooms, which are often the object of detailed utilization studies, constituted less than 9 percent of the total.

Of the estimated net assignable floor space, 617 million square feet, or about 60 percent, were located in publicly controlled institutions; and 410 million, or about 40 percent, were in privately controlled institutions. Classrooms comprised about the same percentage of floor space in the privately controlled institutions as they did in the publicly controlled--9 percent.

In the publicly controlled institutions, greater percentages of floor space for laboratories, offices, special-use, and supporting facilities were reported than in the privately controlled. The figures for publicly and privately controlled institutions are shown in tables 2A and 3A.

Table 2A indicates that 888 million square feet of gross area were located in publicly controlled institutions, while table 3A shows that 598 million were in privately controlled institutions. Thus the publicly controlled institutions, with 71 percent of the FTE enrollment,^{4/} had 60 percent of the gross area; privately controlled institutions, with 29 percent of the FTE enrollment, had 40 percent.

The ratio of assignable area to gross area was not substantially different in publicly and privately controlled institutions: .70 and .69, respectively.

Both publicly and privately controlled institutions reported more of their assignable square footage devoted to residential facilities than to any other single type. Privately controlled colleges and universities reported the higher proportion--34 percent--as residential; publicly controlled institutions, 28 percent. These and other proportions are shown in the following tabulation:

By organizational unit, both publicly and privately controlled institutions assigned slightly more than three-fourths of their space to a combination of (a) auxiliary services and (b) departments of instruction and research. However, publicly controlled institutions divided the two almost equally--

38 percent for auxiliary services and 39 percent for departments of instruction and research--while privately controlled institutions assigned 46 percent to auxiliary services and only 33 percent to departments of instruction and research.

For institutions of both types, the third highest percentage of space reported was for general administration and institutional services--8 percent--followed by library--7 percent.

REPORTED TOTALS

The data in tables 1B, 2B, 3B, and 4-13 comprise the unadjusted totals for the 2,050 institutions that responded to the questionnaire--in contrast with the adjusted national totals of tables 1A, 2A, and 3A. The responding institutions reported a total of 925 million assignable square feet, or 90 percent of the estimated total for the United States.

Table 4 presents data for responding institutions, by level and control, for the several room-type categories.

The total reported assignable square feet was distributed among groups of institutions as follows:

The highest percentage of space for any type of room for any single category of institution fell within the single-person residential space. Publicly controlled universities and privately controlled other 4-year colleges each reported 7 percent of the 925 million assignable square feet to this type of room.

Within the institutional types classified by level and control, certain differences are apparent. Publicly controlled universities, for example, used less than 6 percent of their plant for classrooms, while publicly controlled 2-year colleges allocated nearly 19 percent to that category. The remaining institutions classified between 7 and 12 percent of their space as classrooms.

In other room categories (as a proportion of total assignable space)--

- . Laboratory space ranged from nearly 24 percent in publicly controlled 2-year colleges to 7 percent in privately controlled 2-year colleges.
- . Office space comprised nearly 14 percent in both publicly and privately controlled universities, but less than 7 percent in privately controlled 2-year colleges.
- . Study facilities were allocated almost equally among the various types of institutions, at 6 to 7 percent.
- . Special-use space was highest in publicly controlled 2-year institutions, at nearly 12 percent, and lowest in privately controlled universities, at 7 percent.
- . General-use facilities ranged from 12 percent of total assignable space in privately controlled universities to 18 percent in privately controlled 2-year institutions.
- . Supporting facilities varied slightly, between 5 and 7 percent, at the different types of institutions.

Table 5 presents data for selected organizational units in responding institutions, by institutional control and level. Columns 2 through 8 add up to the 904 million assignable square feet in use by the responding institutions. In the discussion of table 5 which follows, percentages are based on this total, which excludes noninstitutional agency facilities (column 9) and unassigned space (column 10).

The data in columns 2 and 6 correspond approximately to the instruction and departmental research, and library classifications used in Higher Education Facilities Grants. Of the total 904 million square feet of space in use by reporting institutions, these two categories (departments of instruction and research, and library) occupied 44 percent. Other academic space amounted to 14 percent, making a total of 58 percent for all academic space. The remaining 42 percent consisted of residential (31 percent) and other auxiliary services (11 percent).

Of the 904 million square feet in use by these reporting institutions, more square feet--13 percent--were classified in the category of departments of instruction and research in public universities than in any other single category or organizational unit and institution. The second highest percentage--10 percent--occurred in residential space in public universities.

Percentage distributions of organizational units' space within the institutions varied considerably, as shown in the following examples:

From 32 to 37 percent of assignable space was allocated to departments of instruction and research in all institutions except publicly controlled 2-year colleges, where the figure was 63 percent.

Library space ranged from 5 to 8 percent of the totals for various institutional categories.

Total academic space was proportionately lowest--50 percent--in privately controlled 2-year and nonuniversity 4-year institutions; it was highest--83 percent--in publicly controlled 2-year colleges.

General administration and institutional services facilities followed a fairly consistent pattern--from 8 percent in publicly controlled 4-year colleges to 11 percent in publicly controlled 2-year institutions.

Assignable square feet of floor space in the physical facilities of responding colleges and universities, by type of room (exclusive of residential areas) and by region and State or other area, are shown in tables 6, 7, and 8. Table 6 reports these data for all responding colleges and universities; table 7, for responding publicly controlled colleges and universities; and table 8, for responding privately controlled colleges and universities.

Assignable square feet of floor space in residence halls of responding institutions are presented in tables 9, 10, 11, and 12, under four headings: total, single persons, family units, and food service. Table 9 summarizes these data by institutional control and level for all responding institutions. Tables 10, 11, and 12 present the same data by region and State or other area; table 10, for all responding public and private institutions; table 11, for responding publicly controlled colleges and universities; and 12, for responding privately controlled institutions.

The assignable area of floor space in responding institutions is shown by room type, control, and enrollment size in table 13. Enrollment is classified into seven size categories, from 500 and under to 25,000 and over.

Table 13 shows generally an inverse relationship between percentages of space devoted to classrooms and enrollment levels; that is, the smaller institutions tended to have larger proportions of space assigned to classroom use. The most marked exception occurred in privately controlled institutions in the enrollment range of 2,500-4,999, which had the highest percentage.

For all institutions, laboratory space occupied a progressively larger proportion of the total space reported as the enrollment of the institution increased. This was also true of office space. Other types of space ratios generally remained constant with differences in enrollment size.

Generally, publicly controlled institutions devoted relatively more of their space to laboratory facilities than did privately controlled institutions. Only in the enrollment category of 5,000-9,999 students were the percentages approximately equal in the publicly and privately controlled institutions.

Office space in both publicly and privately controlled colleges and universities tended to increase proportionately as the size of the institution increased. The percentage values roughly doubled from the smallest to the largest groups of institutions.

Within the publicly controlled group, study facilities ranged from 5 percent to 7 percent in the enrollment sizes shown; in private institutions, from 6 percent to 8 percent.

Special-use facilities tended to average 2 to 3 percentage points more in publicly controlled than in privately controlled institutions.

Residential space for single persons exhibited some interesting variations among institutions of different enrollment-size categories. It ranged from a high of 31 percent of the space in privately controlled institutions with enrollments of 1,000 to 2,499, to a low of 10 percent in publicly controlled colleges of less than 500 students.

APPENDIX A

METHODOLOGY

The survey form, "Inventory of College and University Physical Facilities," OE-2300-7, was sent out as part of the Higher Education General Information Survey package for 1968. The population of inquiry was the 2,491 institutions that responded to the Opening Fall Enrollment Survey for the fall of 1968. The basic assumption was that if an institution reported enrollment data to the Office of Education for the fall of 1968, its students would be expected to occupy some physical facilities for that same period. These facilities did not have to be owned by the institution but could have been leased or rented. This universe may not match some State records because the Office of Education receives fall enrollment data from certain institutions that are not recognized by the State in which they reside; e.g., the rabbinical schools in the State of New York.

Completed questionnaires were received from 2,050 institutions, a response rate of 82.3 percent of the total number of institutions in the statistical universe. The response rate by control and level of institution appears in table A. The responding institutions accounted for 90.2 percent of the total fall enrollment for 1968, and 90.5 percent of all full-time-equivalent (FTE) enrollment for the fall of 1968. The FTE was derived by taking the full-time enrollment plus one-third of the part-time enrollment. See appendix B for detailed enrollment by control and level of institution.

To obtain national estimates of total physical facilities the following ratio was applied by control and level of the physical facilities data for those reporting:

INVENTORY OF COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY PHYSICAL FACILITIES

The increasing demands for education, and the rapid growth of institutions of higher education emphasize the needs for long-range planning at all levels of responsibility. Current decisions affect an institution far into the future, and it is believed that most colleges are now utilizing long-term projections as a management tool or guide in planning for the future. An inventory of physical facilities is an interrelated part of an institution's long-range plans.

In view of the needs of the Office of Education and the above considerations, this report on physical facilities in higher education is now being requested of all institutions. The data, by institution, will be of use to the Office of Education in evaluation of application for grants and loans. It will also be used as an aid in overall projections regularly prepared by the Office of Education. Other uses may include totals aggregated by State, type, and control, etc., without identification of institutions, for the information of State authorities and other interested organizations. Publication of some data by institution may also be of considerable interest.

The inventory request is for the entire institution by main campus, branches, extension centers, etc. The items and definitions used in this report on physical facilities are consistent with the basic "Facilities Classification and Inventory Procedures Manual," (general parts of which are included as the definitions).

It is requested that the report on physical facilities be completed and returned to the U.S. Office of Education by November 30, 1968.

NOTE: DISREGARD ALL SHADING. ENTER DATE AS AVAILABLE. THE VALUES IN COLUMN 2 MUST EQUAL THE SUM OF COLUMNS 3 THROUGH 16 ON EACH LINE. THE SUM OF LINES 1, 20, 21, AND 40 THROUGH 45 MUST EQUAL LINE 46 IN EACH COLUMN.

INSTRUCTIONS

A separate report should be prepared for the main campus, and each branch campus, extension center, etc. in operation as of Sept. 30, 1968.

Identifying information should be placed in the spaces provided at the top of the form, always including the name of the parent institution.

Entries of figures in each column will be in square feet.

The grand total assignable square feet should be the sum of each organizational unit total plus the unassignable.

The nonassignable area added to the grand total of assignable area should equal the gross area.

Refer to the "Facilities Classification & Inventory Procedures Manual" for Room Definitions, Descriptions, Limitations, and specifics.

DEFINITIONS

CAMPUS—The land areas and facilities used by an institution in its program of instruction, research, or service.

BRANCH CAMPUS—Means a campus of an institution of higher education which is organized on a relatively permanent basis (i.e., has a relatively permanent administration), which offers an organized program or programs of work of at least two years (as opposed to courses), and which is located in a community different from that in which its parent institution is located. To be considered in a community different from that of the parent institution, a branch shall be located beyond a reasonable commuting distance from the main campus of the parent institution.

GROSS AREA should be construed to mean the sum of the floor areas included within the outside faces of exterior walls for all stories, or areas, which have floor surfaces.

NET ASSIGNABLE AREA should be construed to mean the sum of all areas on all floors of a building assigned to, or available for assignment to, an occupant, including every type of space functionally usable by an occupant.

CUSTODIAL AREA should be construed to mean the sum of all areas on all floors of a building used for building protection, care, maintenance, and operation.

DEFINITIONS (Continued)

CIRCULATION AREA should be construed to mean that portion of the gross area—whether or not enclosed by partitions—which is required for physical access to some subdivision of space.

MECHANICAL AREA should be construed to mean that portion of the gross area designed to house mechanical equipment, utility services, and non-private toilet facilities.

CONSTRUCTION AREA should be construed to mean that portion of the gross area which cannot be put to use because of the presence of structural features of the building.

DEPARTMENTS OF INSTRUCTION AND RESEARCH. Includes separately budgeted research which is organizationally part of an instruction-and-research department, irrespective of the sources of funds or other budgetary distinctions.

ORGANIZED ACTIVITY UNITS (RELATED TO INSTRUCTION AND RESEARCH). Demonstration and practice schools for education departments; demonstration and practice homes for home-economics departments; teaching hospitals for medical schools; and other organizationally separate and physically identifiable institutional units which are functionally related to departments of instruction and research, and/or organized research units.

ORGANIZED RESEARCH UNITS. Research institutes, laboratories, museums, etc., which are organizationally separate and physically identifiable, irrespective of the sources of funds. This category does not include research projects which are organizationally part of, and physically indistinguishable from, the other research activities in a department of instruction and research.

PUBLIC SERVICE UNITS. Extension, i.e., adult or continuing education, including agricultural extension, engineering extension, etc.; also any other organizationally separate public-service unit with the primary objective of making available to the general public the benefits of the instructional and/or research activities of an institution of higher education, including activities of a cultural nature, e.g., dramatic and/or musical performances.

LIBRARY. Main library and branches thereof, or equivalent, including subject-field libraries administered by the main library or otherwise professionally staffed, including law libraries and medical libraries, but not informal "departmental libraries" which are organizationally part of any units in the 1000-, 2000-, 3000-, or 4000-series above.

GENERAL ADMINISTRATION AND INSTITUTIONAL SERVICES. Any institutional unit the primary objective of which is the orderly planning and operation of the instructional, research, and/or public-service activities of the institution in terms of academic affairs, fiscal affairs, personnel student affairs, public relations, development, etc. (*NOTE: This category is intended to include the institutional units ordinarily represented by the budget categories of General Administration, General Services, and Physical Plant.*)

AUXILIARY SERVICES. Institutional units which are characteristically represented by the types of physical facilities classified as General-Use Facilities (*room-type codes in the 600-series*) and/or Residential Facilities (*room-type codes in the 900-series*), except to the extent that those units support specific instructional, research, and/or public-service units. Includes intercollegiate athletics if organizationally separate and physically distinguishable from physical education, irrespective of budgetary classification in the institution's own records.

NONINSTITUTIONAL AGENCIES. Public or private agencies which are not under the direct supervision or control of the institutional administration, irrespective of the degree of association with, or relationship to, any institutional units.

UNASSIGNED. Facilities which are not assigned to, or are not available to, any institutional unit (*or noninstitutional agency*) at the time of the facilities inventory. The overall code 9000 is intended only for captions and subtotals in tabulated reports; itemized data should be coded in terms of the most appropriate categories.
