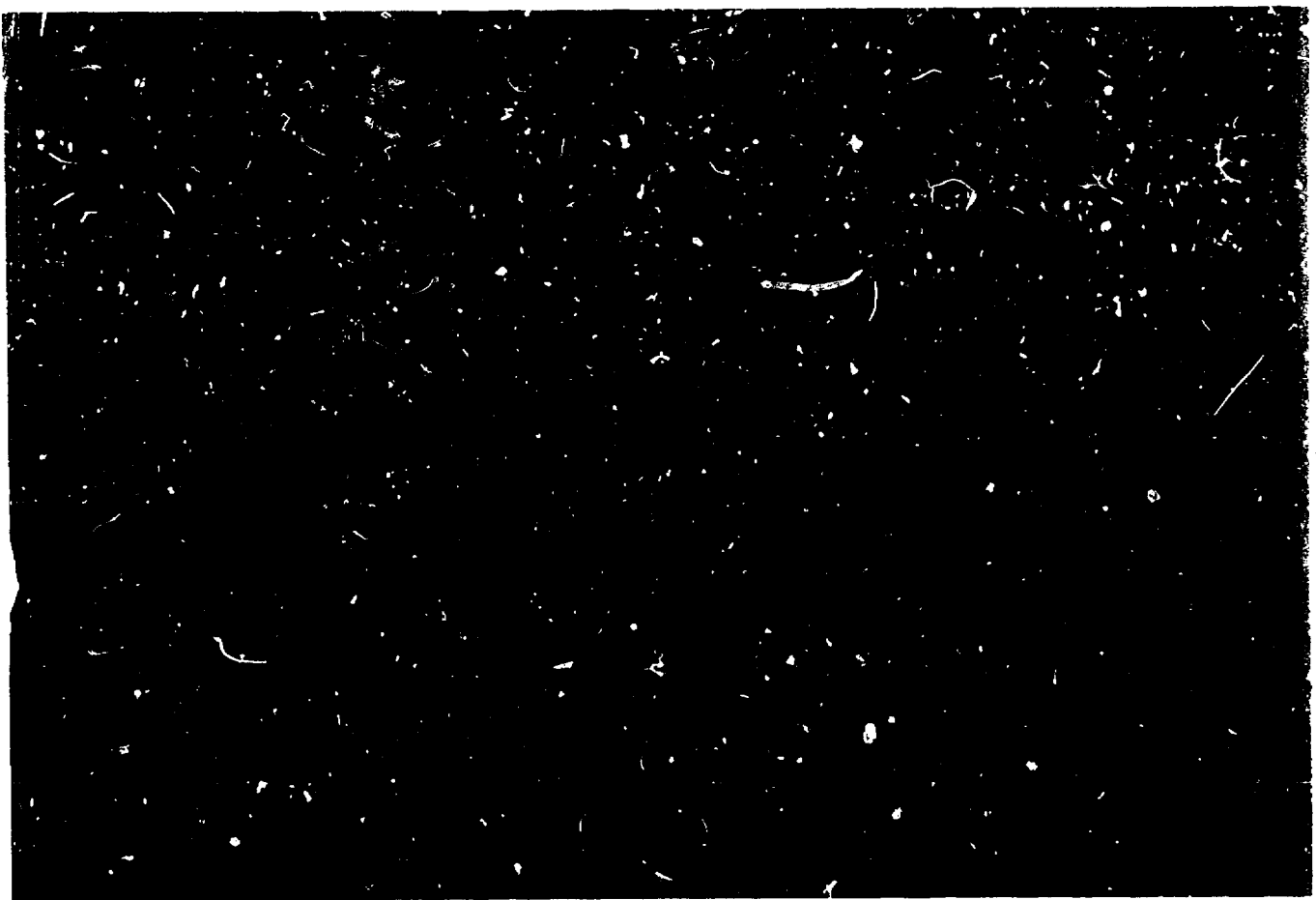

FOREWORD

One of the responsibilities of those concerned with the establishment (or expansion) of institutions for agricultural education and training in developing countries is the adequate provision of textbooks and training materials.

It is almost platitudinous, whether we are speaking of Africa or elsewhere, to state that textbooks, journals, etc. are essential to effective tuition and that a properly organised library is indispensable to serious study. Yet the attention given to these matters in planning new institutions and the resources devoted thereto are too often totally inadequate.

The Agricultural Education Branch of FAO is involved in this question in two ways. First, it seeks to stimulate the preparation of textbooks and manuals about subjects which are badly catered for at present (or not catered for at all) in relation to the particular environment - physical, economic or social - in which tuition is taking place. Secondly, FAO is often called upon to offer guidance to institutions establishing new libraries by suggesting books, manuals and periodicals which can form the nucleus of such libraries. Hence this select list of textbooks, manuals and periodicals has been prepared for general distribution.

Its compilation is the work of the agricultural education advisers in Africa, in consultation with the teaching staffs of African agricultural education and training institutions. Valuable contributions have also been made by the personnel of the FAO Library, members of the Technical Divisions in FAO, by Miss P.M.J. Edwards and particularly by the Consultant Mrs. J. Lancaster-Jones.

The list is not an exhaustive one. Suggestions for additions or amendments to the information in this document will be much appreciated and will be made use of for the improvement of future editions. It is planned to issue a comparable list in the French language in due course.

INTRODUCTION

In any establishment where teaching or research or both are carried on the Library holds a key position and its stock should be readily available to all - teachers, research workers and students. This publication has been compiled to help the library build up the collections of books and periodicals and make consultation of these as simple as possible both for themselves and for the people that the library serves.

The list of books and pamphlets on the agricultural sciences and related subjects is classified in broad groups with the items arranged in alphabetical order of the authors' names within each group. The grouping follows the order of the Universal Decimal Classification (U.D.C.). Each item begins with the author or authors' name(s), followed by the title of the work, the place of publication, the publisher's name, the date of publication, the price and a grading symbol indicating advanced or intermediate standard. When no author's name appears the title is preceded by ... (3 dots).

A list of periodicals covering the agricultural sciences is also included. This is arranged by the country of origin.

To assist in ordering and identifying the books and periodicals lists of the principal American, United Kingdom and other publishers of books and periodicals in the English language have been added, with the addresses to which orders should be sent.

To facilitate the tracing of books an alphabetical index of authors' names has been compiled.

Books should be ordered through the local book-seller wherever possible. This makes it easier to deal with any queries which arise. The name of the author, full title of the book, publisher's name and date of publication must be included. It is wise to add the price but it will be realised that as prices are always rising that given in the list may no longer be valid. For periodicals the name of the journal and that of the publisher must be used on the order.

In order to help countries which have difficulty in making payments in foreign currencies to obtain educational material UNESCO has devised a scheme whereby UNESCO coupons can be bought with the local currency and used to buy books abroad. The countries in Africa in which this scheme operates are Algeria, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo (Brazzaville), Congo (Democratic Republic), Ethiopia, Gabon, Ghana, Guinea, Madagascar, Morocco, Rwanda, Senegal (Republic of), Sudan, United Arab Republic, Upper Volta. NOTES ON THE CONTENTS OF THIS DOCUMENT

The entries in the selected list of books consist of author(s) name(s), title of book or pamphlet, place of publication, publisher's name, date, price as given in the publishers' catalogues and grading letter (occasionally omitted).

Books thought to be out of print i.e. not to be found in publishers' catalogues have been included with the words out of print added to the entry. It is possible that they may be reprinted that they may be available second hand or may be obtained on loan from other libraries. They cannot be ordered through a bookseller.

Items marked with an asterisk are thought likely to be in print but cannot be checked in the available bibliographies. They can probably be obtained by writing to the issuing bodies. A list of the addresses of some of these is included.

The grading letter A or B shows the academic level for which the book is thought to be particularly suitable.

A = advanced.
B = intermediate.

A place name in brackets following the place of publication New York, (Maidenhead), McGraw Hill, indicates that though the book was published in New York it can be ordered from McGraw Hill, Maidenhead.

NOTES FOR LIBRARY ASSISTANTS

If a book is to be of any use in a library it must be easy to find. Some readers may ask "Have you a book by, say, White"? Whilst others may say "What have you on tractors"? In order to provide the answer to the first kind of question it is necessary to have a catalogue, arranged alphabetically by author's name (author catalogue). For the second, another catalogue, arranged by subject is needed, similar to the list of books in this publication (subject catalogue). As the library is always growing, these catalogues must be able to take in additions and put them in their proper place, that is, in the correct alphabetical order in the Author Catalogue and the correct subject group in the Subject Catalogue. Thus catalogues on cards, one card to each item, are needed. Cards for each type of catalogue should measure 5" x 3" as this is the standard size for library catalogue cards. If cards are difficult to obtain, slips of paper, cut to this size can be used instead. The details of the book to be given on each card, whether for the Author or for the Subject catalogue are: Author's name, title of work, place of publication, date, size in centimetres, number of pages, number of plates and illustrations. If the book contains extensive bibliographies they should be mentioned in a note.

Specimen entry. The spacing should be followed as it is in use in many libraries.

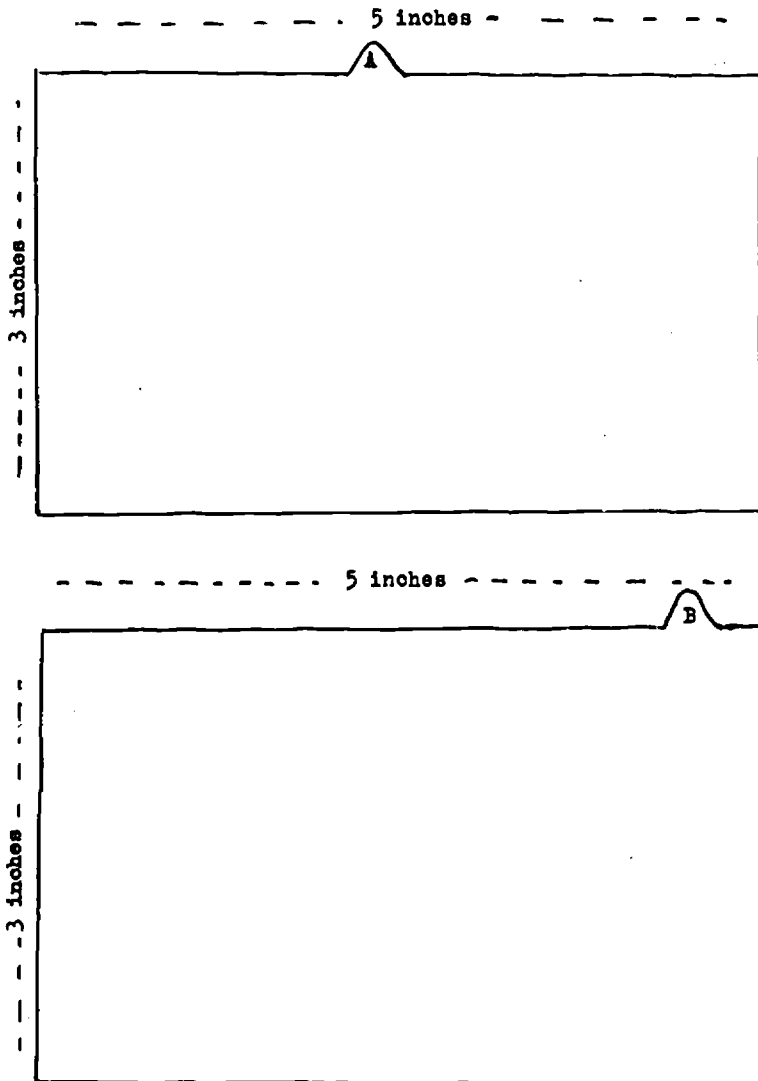
Where the book is by more than 1 author the second name (of two) should be given at the top, eg. EDWARDS, D.C. and BOGDAN, J.V. If there are more than 2 authors the words and others should be added after the first author's name as in the list in this publication. When 2 authors only are given, as with Edwards and Bogdan, a cross reference should be made

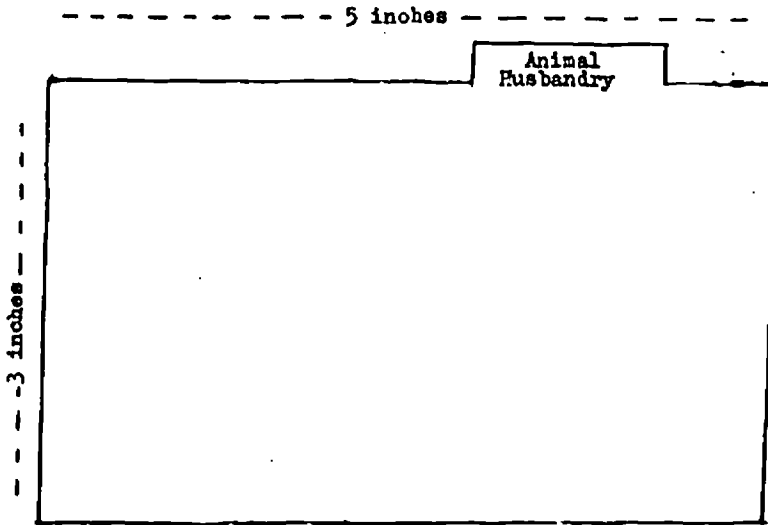
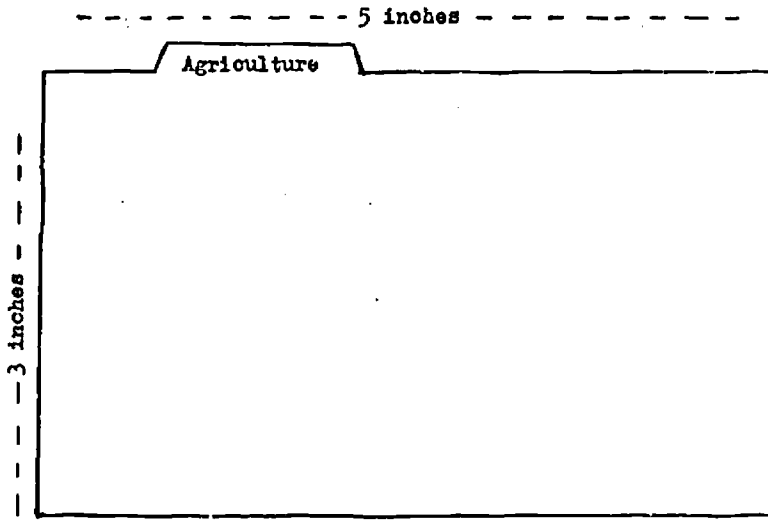
An exact copy of the complete entry, with the subject indicated at the top right hand corner should be filed under the subject. Thus for the specimen entry 1 card would be filed in the Author catalogue under M and one in the Subject catalogue under Gardening. The cards should be filed in drawers and guide cards should be used to divide them into convenient groups. For the Author catalogue there should be a guide card at the beginning of each batch of cards beginning with the same letter.

Periodicals, which should probably be catalogued under their titles are also probably best listed in a separate section of the Author catalogue but the duplicate entry cards for the Subject catalogue should be filed at the end of the cards for the books on a particular subject, i.e. periodicals on tropical agriculture should follow the books on that subject.

Drawers to hold the 5" x 3" cards could easily be made locally.
