ABSTRACT

Data on formal staff training activity by county welfare departments in the State of California from July 1, 1968, to June 30, 1969 are summarized. The counties were divided into three groups according to the number of employees; the total number of cases in all programs; and the scope of complexity of the agency programs and organizations. Some of the subject areas are: orientation and induction; intake training; community resources; medical assistance; understanding and use of casework concepts; employment preparation and achievement; and differential use of the staff. Man hours of training per employee during the year ranged from none in four counties to 10.7 in one county. Forty-one percent of all training man hours received by ten percent of the trainees was devoted to orientation and induction. Three fourths of the formal courses were designed for social workers; the next largest amount of training directed toward specific staff groups was provided for clerical staff. These data do not cover all formal training activity in all counties. (PT)

STAFF TRAINING ACTIVITY - COUNTY WELFARE DEPARTMENTS

INTRODUCTION

Data on formal staff training activity by county welfare departments from July 1, 1968, to June 30, 1969, are summarized in the following tables. These data may not cover all formal staff training activity in all counties but, with a few exceptions where insufficient data were given, all of the "Staff Training Reports" submitted to the State Department of Social Welfare on Form Gen 240.1 are included in the tabulation.

Trainee counts, as indicated, are duplicate counts; that is, an employee who participated in more than one course of training during the year is counted once for each training unit he attended. Units of training, county groupings, and the selected subject areas covered in these tables are defined on page 2.

FINDINGS

In summary, the range and types of training activity in the counties is as follows:

- 1. Man-hours of training per employee during the year ranged from none in four counties to 102.7 in one county. Percent of total available staff time spent in formal training sessions ranged from none to 5.4. The greater variation among Group A counties in these relationships is to a large degree due to the smaller base number of personnel involved.
- 2. Forty-one percent of all training man-hours received by ten percent of all trainees was devoted to orientation and induction. This may be a reflection of the high turnover rate among welfare workers. The second largest block of training activity (18.2 percent of all training units, 9.8 percent of training man-hours) was related to the understanding and use of casework concepts. Other subject areas to which more than five percent of the training sessions was directed were medical assistance (9.7 percent) and community resources (8.6 percent).
- 3. Three-fourths of the formal courses of training were designed for social workers. The next largest amount of training directed towards specific staff groups was provided to clerical staff (6.2 percent).



DEFINITIONS

Unit of Training

A unit of training is any formal training activity developed to meet a specific need and is reportable when the training course is completed.

County Groups

The counties have been divided into three groups according to a formula which considers three basic factors: 1) the number of employees, 2) the total number of cases in all programs, and 3) the scope and complexity of the agency programs and organization.

Group A includes counties which have too few staff and cases to warrant the employment of full-time staff development personnel.

Counties classified in Group B administer a large number of programs that require at least one full-time staff development position to assume responsibility for staff development programs.

Counties in Group C are the largest counties in the state and require a fulltime professional staff development supervisor and other appropriately qualified training personnel.

Subject Areas

- 1. Orientation and Induction: This category includes orientation and induction training for both experienced and inexperienced personnel.
- 2. Intake Training: This type of training is concerned with intake procedures and the type of services provided during the intake process.
- 3. Fraud Prevention: This category covers training in fraud prevention procedures, the use of special investigators, and the preparation of case budgets.
- 4. Non-discrimination and Related Topics: This category covers training related to minority groups, civil liberties and other areas involving non-discrimination.
- 5. Services to Families with Children: Training in this category deals with the scope, variety and delivery of social services specifically as they relate to Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) recipients.
- 6. Services to Adults: This category covers training in the scope, variety and delivery of social services to adults.
- 7. General Services to all Clients: This subject area covers social services programs of a general nature, not specifically related to either adults or AFDC cases.
- 8. Desertion or Pending Desertion: This category includes training in the areas of marital counseling, the problems of a one-parent family, techniques of interviewing an absent parent to increase his responsibility toward his child, and methods of enforcing support.

- 9. Children in Need of Protection: Training in this area provides information about the role of the police department, foster home intake, money management (public housing procedures and consumer education), physically deprived, emotionally disturbed or unsupervised recipients, identification of abuse, etc.
- 10. Family Planning Services: Training programs classified in this subject area give information on agencies such as the Public Health Department and Planned Parenthood which deal with all aspects of family planning.
- 11. Employment Preparation and Achievement: Training in this category relates to interviewing and to identifying problems and strengths of the recipient, as well as preparing him for problems related to employment, e.g., apprehension over working, child-care problems, home management and employer expectations. The subject area also includes information about job referrals for the handicapped and community employment resources for all recipients.
- 12. Adoptions: The adoptions category covers problems of placement, of the adoptive parents and of the natural parents.
- 13. Community Resources: This category includes training in referrals to available community agencies such as the Public Health Department, Department of Human Resources, Legal Aid Society, Veterans Administration, marriage counselors, etc.
- 14. Medical Assistance: This category includes training in identifying medical or mental problems, motivation for treatment and the various types of available medical assistance.
- 15. Understanding and Use of Casework Concepts: This subject tea is concered with principles of casework, programs and procedures, interviewing techniques with both the cooperative and the hostile recipient, use of role playing, worker-client relationships, case recording, case diagnosis, case evaluation, formulation of goals for case implementation and completion of plan, short term crass intervention, financial management, etc.
- 16. Children's Growth and Development: Training grouped in this subject area provides information on normal physical and emotional development in childhood and adolescence.
- 17. Differential Use of Staff: Training in this area relates to the varying roles of caseworkers, supervisors, consultants, eligibility workers, case aids, etc.
- 18. Placement and Licensing: This subject area covers placement problems, resources, and adoptive and foster home placements. It also includes training on placement and licensing regulations and procedures.
- 19. Courses or Seminars: This category includes seminars on subjects in the areas of Social Work, Sociology, Child Development, Psychology, etc.
- 20. Social Service Supervisors' Training: This training deals with the development of supervisory skills.
- 21. Clerical Supervisors' Training: This training is concerned with the development of clerical supervisory skills.
