#### AESTRACT

The survey of adult education in Nevada contains out a comparative enrollments, 1963-70, for the state, counties, and participating institutions; enrollment by school districts; and a statewide summary of public school continuing education programs in 1970. The comparative enrollment and statewide summary data are further divided into enrollment by occupational education: agricultural, business and office, distributive, health, home economics, technical, post secondary, and trade and industrial; and by general adult education: adult basic education, adult general high school education, community programs, and civil defense adult education. The larger part of the document is devoted to county enrollment summary data including course titles, instructors, number enrolled per course, and hours of instruction. (PT)
