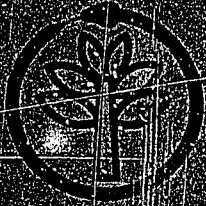

ABSTRACT

INTRODUCTION

This bibliography now contains brief details of nearly 300 programmes listed under their publishers. To facilitate reference, the programmes have been listed under the subject-matter KEYWORDS of their titles.

Unpublished programmes are in general not listed in this collection. Tape/slide, etc., lectures are only included where the publisher concerned also publishes 'regular' programmes. (Many of the available audiotapes and tape/slide presentations are listed by the Medical Recording Service Foundation - see Reference Section for address.) General Health Education and school-level programmes have only been included where these are of use in nursing, etc., courses.

Many programmes not specifically written for medical, dental or nursing audiences may be of value in certain courses; details will be found in the general bibliographies listed in the reference section.

Although details of nearly all the programmes have been obtained directly from their publishers, the entries are for information only. In particular, the inclusion of a programme implies nothing about its quality or usefulness. Critical information on the programmes, comments, criticisms and details of omissions will be gratefully received by the compilers: these should be sent to RE Wakeford (Department of Audio Visual Communication, British Medical Association, London WC1H 9JP), as should further inquiries about programmes listed.
