INTRODUCTION

This bibliography of alcohol and drug materials in the Oregon State Library was prepared in recognition of a need to make information available to the citizens of Oregon on this subject. It has been prepared by the staff of the State Library for the Alcohol and Drug Section of the Mental Health Division.

The literature on alcohol and drugs is extensive and covers a wide time span. While some older works have been included, the emphasis is on current material. Significant representative state and federal documents have been included, but all government publications have not been listed. The State Library has extensive holdings of U. S. government publications which are available for circulation. The publications of the U.S. Public Health Service and of the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs are particularly useful. Pamphlets under 50 pages have generally been excluded.

Annual supplements of this publication are planned to provide a continuing awareness of educational materials. Suggestions for changes or improvements of this bibliography will be appreciated.
