## ABSTRACT

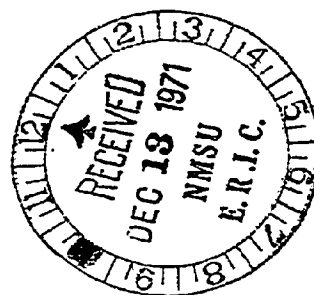

Only a brief summary of selected data is included here. If you desire additional information, the Department of Education will make every effort to provide it at your request.

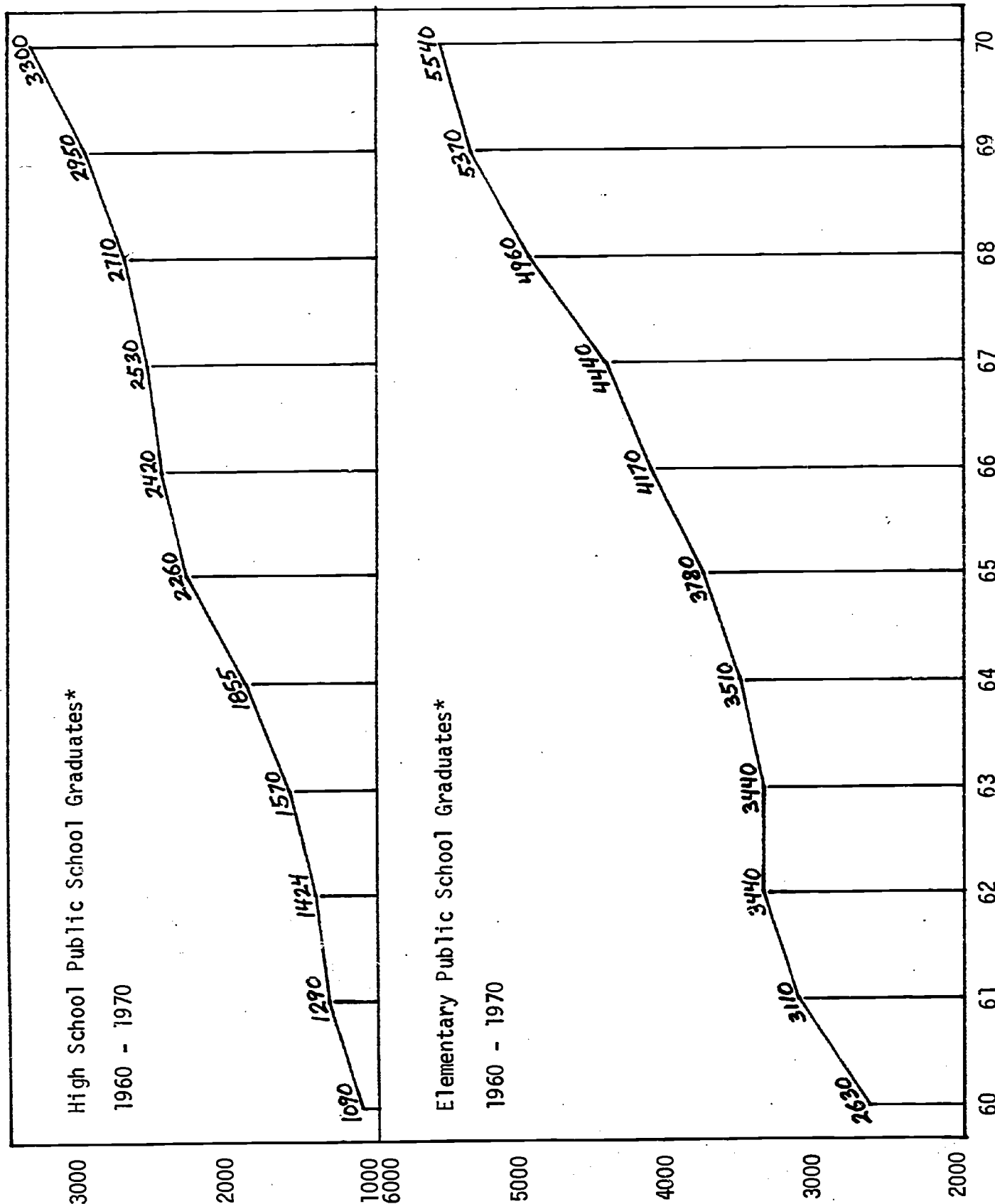

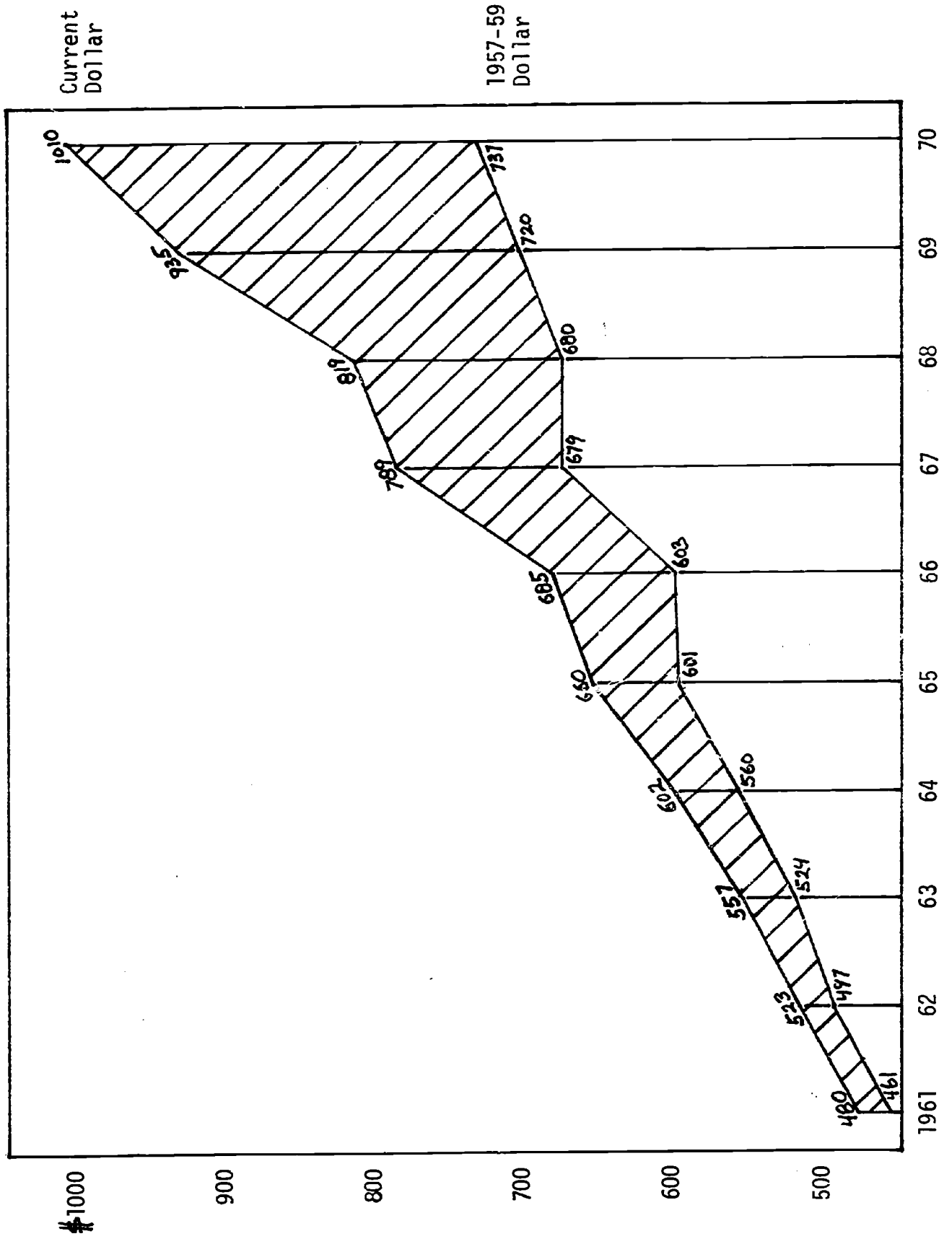

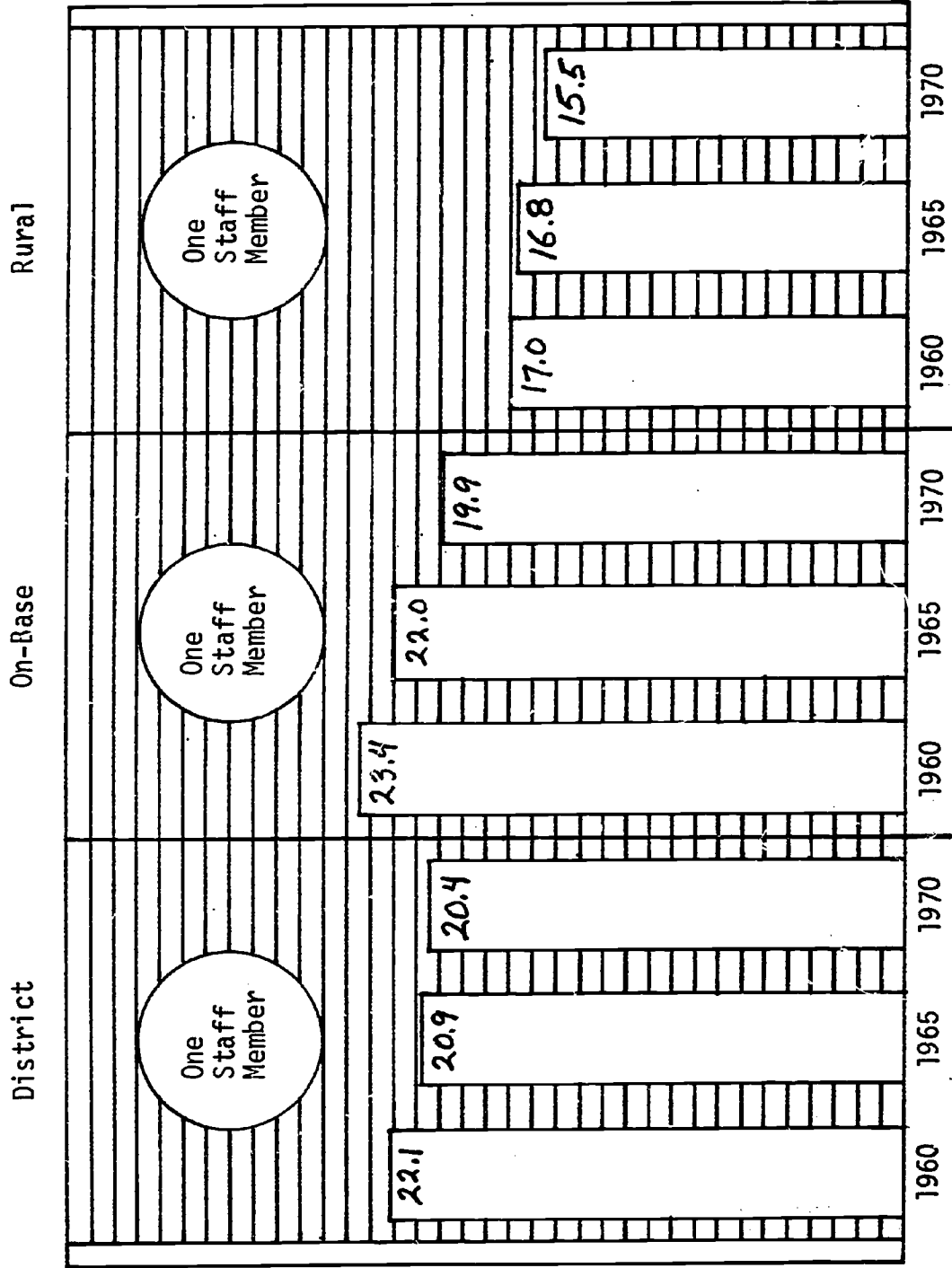
