It also includes reports on computer-assisted test construction and the adaptation of criterion-referenced tests to individualizing learning and instruction.

References listed cover the period from 1965 to the present and were located through three primary sources: Current Index to Journals in Education, Research in Education, and the library collection at Educational Testing Service.
