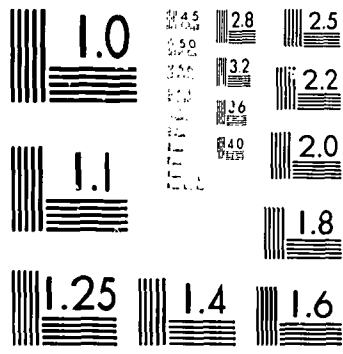

ABSTRACT
