ABSTRACT

This document provides a listing of vacancies for college freshmen and transfer students in 2- and 4-year colleges in the states of Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming. All vacancies reported are for the fall term, 1972, at the 287 colleges and universities that returned the questionnaires. Specific information regarding application deadlines is given when available.

The COLLEGE VACANCY SURVEY is conducted by the office of Special Higher Education Programs at NICHE each May as a service to institutions of higher education and the public that they serve in the 13 WICHE states. The 1972 Survey has been computer processed.

The following information is important to understanding and using the Survey:

1. All vacancies are for Fall term, 1972.
2. CATEGORIES: Institutions are divided into two-year and four-year categories within states, with freshman and transfer vacancies reported for each institution.
3. STATISTICS: 443 colleges and universities were surveyed by questionnaire in May, 1972, and 287 of those institutions responded. Vacancies are summarized by state at the beginning of the report. The most important point in regard to these statistics is that they represent the minimum number of openings reported by the colleges and universities -- this occurs because there is no way of indicating numbers for the institutions that have stated an open door admissions policy, a trend that is increasing in frequency among western institutions.
4. FOOTNOTES: An asterisk in the footnote column, immediately to the right of the name of the school, indicates qualifying information about vacancies or contains other important data. Please read.
5. APPLICATION DEADLINES: Specific information regarding application deadlines is given when available. Students are reminded that they should contact the institution of their choice directly, but that they should not reapply to any institution that has already denied them admission. Students will still be admitted on the basis of each school's requirements.

The COLLEGE VACANCY SURVEY is conducted by the office of Special Higher Education Programs at WICHE each May as a service to institutions of higher education and the public that they serve in the 13 WICHE states. The 1972 Survey has been computer processed.

The following information is important to understanding and using the Survey:

1. All vacancies are for Fall term, 1972.
2. CATEGORIES: Institutions are divided into two-year and four-year categories within states, with freshman and transfer vacancies reported for each institution.
3. STATISTICS: 443 colleges and universities were surveyed by questionnaire in May, 1972, and 287 of those institutions responded. Vacancies are summarized by state at the beginning of the report. The most important point in regard to these statistics is that they represent the minimum number of openings for the colleges and universities -- this occurs because there is no way of indicating numbers frequency among western institutions.
4. FOOTNOTES: An asterisk in the footnote column, immediately to the right of the name of the school, indicates qualifying information about vacancies or contains other important data. Please read.
5. APPLICATION DEADLINES: Specific information regarding application deadlines is given when available. Students are reminded that they should contact the institution of their choice directly, but that they should not reapply to any institution that has already denied them admission. Students will still be admitted on the basis of each school's requirements.

ARIZONA

Arizona State University, Tempe, Arizona. ASU maintains an open admissions policy.

Cochise College, Douglas, Arizona. Professional Pilot Training and Nursing are closed to both freshman and transfer students.

Maricopa Technical College, Phoenix, Arizona. Maricopa Tech maintains an open admissions policy, however, students desiring admission in one of the health curricula should be in contact with the appropriate department before applying with regard to prerequisites for application and the setting up of a personal interview.

CALIFORNIA

Art Center College of Design, Los Angeles, California. At the Art Center College of Design vacancies exist in these majors: Advertising Design, Advertising Illustration, Fashion Illustration, Package Design, Illustration, Fine Arts, Transportation Design, Product Design, and Environmental Studies.

California State College - Fullerton, Fullerton, California. Application deadline will be held open until enrollment quotas are filled.

California State College - Los Angeles, Los Angeles, California. Enrollment is closed in Nursing and to foreign students.

Chaffey College, Alta Loma, California. This institution maintains an open door policy regarding admissions.

Chapman College, Orange, California. Vacancies pertain both to the home campus (Chapman College in Orange, California) and the World Campus afloat aboard ship.

- John F. Kennedy University, Martinez, California. Transfer vacancies occur in English, History, Police Science, and Political science. Transfer and graduate vacancies occur in Art, Business Administration, Law, Psychology, and Public Administration. Studies are available only at the upper division and graduate level. No dormitory facilities are available.
- Los Angeles City College, Los Angeles, California. Los Angeles City College maintains an open admission policy on enrollment.
- Menlo College, Menlo Park, California. Vacancies occur in Business Administration.
- Merced College, Merced, California. This institution has an open admissions policy.
- Miramar College, San Diego, California. Freshman and transfer openings occur only in the following curricula: Criminal Justice, Fire Science, Airframe, Powerplant Mechanics.
- Monterey Institute of Foreign Studies, Monterey, California. Monterey Institute of Foreign Studies offers only upper division and graduate studies. Dormitory facilities are not available.

CALIFORNIA (continued)

Mount St. Marys College, Los Angeles, California. All Liberal Arts programs, except for Nursing, are open to freshman and transfer students.

Occidental College, Los Angeles, California. This institution maintains a rolling admissions policy.

San Diego City College, San Diego, California. An open door policy exists at this institution with regard to San Diego residents living within the community college district boundaries. Application should be made in person at the time of scheduled registration (check with Admissions Office for Fall registration dates).

San Diego State College, San Diego, California. Openings occur only in Engineering, for both freshman and transfer students.

San Francisco Art Institute, San Francisco, California. San Francisco Art Institute maintains a rolling admissions policy. Openings currently occur only in the areas of Painting, Sculpture/Ceramics.

San Joaquin Delta College, Stockton, California. Because of the local tax-based support, this institution solicits for students of its own area.

San Jose State College, San Jose, California. The following majors are closed at this institution: BS Aeronautics Operation, BA Art, BA Behavioral Sciences, BS Criminal Justice Administration, BA Fine Arts, BA Graphic Design, BA Interior Design, BS Nursing, BS Occupational Therapy, BA Psychology, BA Social Service, BA Sociology.

Santa Ana College, Santa Ana, California. Santa Ana College accepts all students who are 18 years of age, have attained a high school diploma and meet residence eligibility requirements (established by California state law). Students accepted from outside the community college district are subject to other residency standards. The closing of curricula, due to over enrollment, would provide the primary reason for limiting the number of applicants accepted.

University of California - Berkeley, Berkeley, California. Openings for entering freshman exist in the Dept. of Ethnic Studies and the Colleges of Chemistry, Engineering, and Environmental Design. Openings for lower division transfers exist in the Dept. of Ethnic Studies and the College of Engineering. Openings for upper division transfers exist in the Dept. of Ethnic Studies and the College of Agricultural Sciences, Chemistry, Engineering, and Letters and Science (majors grouped under the general headings of Physical Sciences and Languages and Literature).

University of California - Davis, Davis, California. Transfer vacancies exist only in Engineering.

University of California - Irvine, Irvine, California. Freshman and transfer vacancies occur only in Engineering.

University of California - Los Angeles, Los Angeles, California. Openings for freshman and transfer students exist in Letters and Science departments only.

University of Southern California, Los Angeles, California. Cinema and Biology are closed to all entering students.

University of the Pacific, Stockton, California. The Pharmacy curriculum is closed.

West Hills College, Coalinga, California. Transfer vacancies pertain only to sophomores.

Yuba College, Marysville, California. The fields of Vocational Nursing and X-Ray are closed.

COLORADO

Arapahoe Community College, Littleton, Colorado. Nursing is closed for Fall 1972, to freshman as well as transfer students.

Colorado State University, Fort Collins, Colorado. Freshman vacancies apply only to Colorado residents; transfer vacancies apply to both Colorado and non-Colorado residents. There are restrictions upon the number and resident qualifications of persons entering Preveterinary Medicine; those students interested in this field should be in contact with CSU Admissions Office.

Community College of Denver, Denver, Colorado. The three Community College of Denver Campuses maintain an open door policy regarding enrollment. Classes begin on September 25.

Loretto Heights, Denver, Colorado. There are no openings for transfer students in nursing.

Metro State College, Denver, Colorado. This institution maintains an open door policy.

University of Colorado, Boulder, Colorado. Freshman vacancies pertain to Colorado residents only. The field of Environmental Design is closed to both freshman and transfer students.

University of Denver, Denver, Colorado. There are no vacancies in the School of Hotel Management.

University of Northern Colorado, Greeley, Colorado. Psychology is closed to both freshman and transfer students.

HAWAII

University of Hawaii at Hilo, Hawaii Community College, Hilo, Hawaii. Openings exist only in the following curricula: Business, Diesel, Machine Shop, Welding, Restaurant/Food Service, and Liberal Arts.

IDAHO

College of St. Gertrude, Cottonwood, Idaho. This institution provides evening classes in continuing education for all residents of the area, but particularly for veterans of military service. NEVADA

Sierra Nevada College, Incline Village, Nevada. Trailers are available to freshman and transfer students in lieu of dormitory facilities.

Western Nevada Community College, Carson City, Nevada. Freshman and transfer vacancies occur in Liberal Arts, Business Education, Food Service Management, and Fire Science Technology. Radiological Technology and Registered Nursing are closed.

NEW MEXICO

Eastern New Mexico University - Clovis Campus, Clovis, New Mexico. The Clovis Campus of the Eastern New Mexico University offers academic programs in the late afternoon and evening. Vocational classes are conducted during the daytime. No student services, housing, or cafeteria facilities are available. The faculty is employed on a parttime basis from the partner institution.

New Mexico Institute of Mines and Technology, Socorro, New Mexico. The Minerals Industry Educational Foundation has awarded New Mexico Tech ten \$500 academic scholarships, to be awarded for the Fall semester, 1972. Each recipient of these awards must major in mining or metallurgical engineering. Scholarships are renewable each year for a four-year period. Eligibility requirements are as follows: (1) Nonresident students only may apply; (2) preference will be given to entering freshmen; (3) student is not required to furnish evidence of financial need; (4) minimum academic standards are B average (3.0 GPA) and upper 25% of graduating class. Deadline for application is August 1, 1972. Application should be made to Office of Admissions, New Mexico Tech, Socorro, New Mexico 87801.

New Mexico State University, Las Cruces, New Mexico. Regulations regarding the enrollment of commuting and resident students may change after June 1, 1972.

University of Albuquerque, Albuquerque, New Mexico. Nursing is closed.

University of New Mexico, Albuquerque, New Mexico. This institution maintains an open admissions policy.

OREGON

Clackamas Community College, Oregon City, Oregon. Clackamas Community College has an open admissions policy with regard to all entering students.

Pacific University, Forest Grove, Oregon. There are no openings in Optometry.

Portland Community College, Portland, Oregon. This institution maintains an open door policy, and enrollment is closed only on the basis of limited classroom facilities. The application deadline listed pertains to those who wish to be allowed to participate in early registration; open enrollment for Fall term is also held (no previous application by mail) during the last two days of the scheduled enrollment. Check with the institution for these registration dates.

Portland State University, Portland, Oregon. This institution charges a late registration fee for applications placed after August 25.

Reed College, Portland, Oregon. This deadline for application may be extended until enrollment is filled.

Southwestern Oregon Community College, Coos Bay, Oregon. This institution maintains an open door policy with regard to admission.

UTAH

Utah State University, Logan, Utah. Utah State has basically an open admissions policy for all graduates of Utah high schools. Graduates of non-Utah schools are accepted if they have a GPA of 2.25 and are entering USU directly from high school. Students not having this GPA may also be evaluated, however.

Utah Technical College at Provo, Provo, Utah. Preference will be given to Utah residents on all applications. Freshman vacancies are closed in these curricula: Practical Nursing, Dental Assisting, and Building Construction. Openings for transfer students exist mainly in the second year trade-technical programs.

WASHINGTON

Central Washington State College, Ellensburg, Washington. Application deadline will be extended to 9-26-72, if openings are still existent.

Clark College, Vancouver, Washington. Nursing and Dental Hygiene programs are closed.

Seattle Pacific College, Seattle, Washington. Nursing School is currently filled to transfer students. Those interested in entering this program may be placed on a waiting list for Fall 1972.

Shoreline Community College, Seattle, Washington. No openings in Nursing or Dental Hygiene programs for entering freshman.

The Evergreen State College, Olympia, Washington. Openings exist only for part-time adults who live in the area. Applications for full-time students will be accepted for a waiting list, in the event that full-time vacancies should occur.

University of Puget Sound, Tacoma, Washington. The field of Occupational Therapy is closed.

Walla Walla Community College, Walla Walla, Washington. Associate Degree in Nursing and Licensed Practical Nursing curricula and Auto Mechanics and Auto Rebuilding curricula are closed to both freshmen and transfers.
