Students wishing to enter the University of Wisconsin--Madison, must submit scores for the American College Testing (ACT) Program or the College Entrance Examination Board Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) as part of their application for admission. After the student has been admitted he must take several tests for placement in math, English, and foreign language courses. Information obtained from these tests may also be used for general counseling and advising purposes.

Each of the University of Wisconsin admission and placement tests is described in Table 1. Local normative data for the CQT, English, and math placement tests previously have been published (Thomas, 1969).
