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ABSTRACT

This report is a compilation of statistics on minority group enrollment, housing, and financial aid at the institutions under the program at the State University of New York from 1969 through 1971. The report contains data on the minority group status of full-time credit course students only. With few exceptions, the proportion of minority students has increased in all types of state university institutions. Progress can be seen in two dimensions: in minority students as a percent of total enrollment for each year, and in the net gain in this percent from 1969 to 1971. Some indication of the effort to encourage minority student enrollment can be found in the tables on institutionally determined financial aid that list the number and amounts awarded by each college to each minority group. University-owned or university-supported housing statistics show similar gains in the number of minority students served. These gains in enrollments and services over a 4-year period attest to the commitment of the State University of New York to equal educational opportunity.

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INTRODUCTION

This report is a compilation of statistics collected over the last three years on minority group enrollment, housing, and financial aid at the institutions under the program of the State University of New York.

The information in these tables is reported annually to the Central Staff Office of Institutional Research by each of the institutions under the program of the State University of New York. We collect these statistics in order to comply with federal and state government requests for minority group enrollment data. In addition, housing and institutionally determined financial aid statistics are collected to assist the University's self-evaluation of its own progress in providing equal educational opportunity to every New York State student capable of completing a program of higher education.

This report contains data on the minority group status of full-time credit course students only. Part-time students and those enrolled at Cooperative College Centers are excluded from this report. Foreign students are not included in any of the four minority groups regardless of their racial or national identity.

The sensitive nature of this information and earlier restrictions

on maintaining racial or ethnic data in student records have presented problems in collecting these statistics. A combination of student self-designation, visual survey, and other means of identification of minority group students has undoubtedly led to some imprecision; however, these are the best data available.

The tables of this report are arranged in sections for each year.

The summary tables preceding the first section show the actual and percent minority enrollments for all full-time students over a four year period and for first-time students over a three year period. A first time student is one who has never attended any college before.

It is encouraging to note that minority enrollment as a percent of total enrollment has risen each year since 1968. With the growth in total student population at all campuses of the State University each year from 1969 through 1971, it is necessary to look at minority enrollment as a percent of total enrollment to ascertain progress. When these percents are calculated by type of college for 1969 and 1971 they yield the results shown on the following page.

INTRODUCTION (Continued)

With few exceptions the proportion of minority students has increased in all types of State University institutions. Progress can be seen in two dimensions; both in minority students as a percent of total enrollment for each year, and in the net gain in this percent from 1969 to 1971. The rising proportion of minority students at the University Centers and Health Sciences Centers as well as at the community college level is a favorable trend. The fine record of some of the community colleges reflects an effort to recruit minority students and offer them attractive and relevant programs as well as it reflects the racial or ethnic composition of the community served.

Some indication of the effort to encourage minority student enrollment can be found in the tables on institutionally determined financial aid which list the number and amounts (in mean values) awarded by each college to each minority group. Excluded from these tables is data on financial aids such as Scholar Incentive Awards, Regents Scholarships, or veterans assistance for which the institution does not select the recipient.

On the whole, the numbers of awards to minority group students have increased each year. This, and the fact that the percent of minority group students receiving awards was consistently higher than the ratio of minority to total enrollments, points to a consistent effort to attract and provide for minority group students. For instance, in 1969 2,894 or 16.5% of the 17,588

undergraduate financial awards granted by all institutions went to minority group members. At the same time the full-time, undergraduate, minority group enrollment was 5.9% of the total full-time, undergraduate enrollment. By 1971, 6,430 or 24.1% of the 26,712 undergraduate financial awards went to minority group members while the full-time, undergraduate, minority enrollment was 11.1% of the total.

University-owned or University-supported housing statistics show similar over-all gains in the numbers of minority students served. Minority students accounted for 3.1% of the students housed in 1969. In 1970 with a rise in total and minority students the minority group accounted for 5.5% of the places. By 1971 this percentage had risen to 6.6% again with a rise in both total students and minority group students.

These gains in enrollments and services over a four year period^a attest to the commitment of the State University of New York to equal educational opportunity. We believe that the statistics in this report are helpful as a benchmark in the continuing efforts to realize that goal.
