#### **ABSTRACT**

This bibliography provides a comprehensive survey of the literature of labor negotiations related to professional employees in higher education. Areas of concern include academic mission, administration, collective bargaining agents, audic tapes, blue collar employees, bibliographies, collective bargaining, conferences, contracts, discrimination, due process, facilities usage, faculty rights and responsibilities, financing collective bargaining, fringe benefits, governance, grants and research projects, grievances, insurance, layoffs, legislation, management, maternity leave, model collective bargaining laws, negotiations, neutrals in bargaining, NLRB and court rulings, productivity, public sector labor relations, retirement, sabbatical leaves, salaries, students rights, teachers bargaining, tenure, women faculty, workload, and additional references. #### **PREFACE**

This bibliography, <u>Collective Barqaining in Higher Education</u>

1971-1973, provides a comprehensive survey of the literature of labor negotiations related to preofessional employees in higher education.

Previous coverage, listed herein under the heading <u>BIBLIOGRAPHIES</u>, has been limited by the newness of the experience. Due to a time constraint in preparing this bibliography for the Center's April 12-13, 1973 conference, no attempt has been made to survey the literature prior to 1971. Perhaps K. E. Marks' bibliography, <u>Collective Barqaining in U.S. Higher Education</u>: 1960-1971, is the most comprehensive one available. It is suggested that you review Mr. Marks' <u>Preface</u> which substantially indicates the aims, purposes, and importance of this updated version.

The lack of adequate bibliographic information in higher education collective bargaining is not due wholly to the paucity of publications in the field since 1965, but due most probably to the absence of an information center or service specifically devoted to acquisition and dissemination of this form of information. This Center now fills the void. Additionally, the widespread emergence of student activism in the mid-1960's related to college and university administration has given rise to and support for faculty activism. Faculty negotiations are proving to be a key issue in higher education in the seventies. A review of the special sub-headings in this bibliography shows the decreased frequency of literature related to STUDENT RIGHTS - CHRONOLOGICAL . . . , and the increased frequency under COLLECTIVE BARGAINING - CHRONOLOGICAL . . . . beginning in 1969.

This bibliography concentrates on a survey of literature relating to faculty members, with few references to blue-collar and non-faculty employees, although we do maintain a file of NLRB and Court Rulings/ Arbitration Awards related to non-faculty employees. The bibliography includes literature complementary to faculty collective bargaining, such as <a href="DISCRIMINATION">DISCRIMINATION</a>, <a href="LEGISLATION">LEGISLATION</a>, <a href="PUBLIC SECTOR LABOR RELATIONS">PUBLIC SECTOR LABOR RELATIONS</a>, <a href="STUDENT">STUDENT</a></a> <a href="RIGHTS">RIGHTS</a>, <a href="WOMEN">WOMEN</a>, etc.

This Center proposes to make information available to all parties concerned with higher education collective bargaining by expanding and updating the current bibliography, preparation of a computerized index to contracts, and many other needed information services.

<u>SPECIAL FEATURES</u> of this bibliography, in addition to the <u>Chronicle</u> of <u>Higher Education</u> references, include many briefly annotated references and such special headings as <u>AUDIOTAPES</u>, <u>CONFERENCES</u>, and <u>NLRB AND COURT RULINGS/ARBITRATION AWARDS</u>. Included among the references are books, journal and newsletter articles, unpublished speeches, research proposals, and references from the <u>Government Employee Relations Report</u>, and <u>Labor Relations Reference Manuals</u>. Many of these sources have not previously been tapped.

Additions and corrections to this bibliography will be appreciated.

The Center solicits copies of unpublished speeches and reports to be included in future bibliographies, and/or published in the Center's proposed newsletter. We also would appreciate reprints of all appropriate articles, briefs in representative unfair labor practice, arbitration cases, and arbitration awards.
