ABSTRACT

The State Council of Higher Education presents a report on the Fall 1972 head-count and full-time-equivalent student enrollment (including off-campus students) in Virginia's state-controlled institutions of higher education. Its figures and tables summarize student enrollments for individual institutions, for groups of institutions (two-year and four-year), and for all state-controlled institutions for the Fall semester or quarter, 1972. The council's annual comprehensive report on student enrollments for the year 1972-73 will be issued in the Summer of 1973.

Enrollment figures have been derived from data submitted by each institution on State Council forms for all resident and off-campus classes taught for credit during the Fall semester or quarter, 1972. Definitions of enrollment categories are consistent with enrollment definitions in the Council's report on student enrollment for academic year 1971-72.

Head-count enrollment is a count of

the number of individual students attending an institution of higher education. Full-time-equivalent (FTE) student enrollment is a convenient statistic derived from the student credit-hour productivity of an institution. Full-time-equivalent enrollments are reported according to seven student levels: Foundation, Lower--Terminal-Occupational, Lower--Bachelor's Credit, Upper, First Professional, Graduate--First Year and Graduate--Advanced. The number of students in off-campus courses reflects the total number of students enrolled in all courses, and not just the number of individual students enrolled.

Tables 1 through 7 report head-count enrollment. Tables 8 through 10 summarize full-time-equivalent enrollment in Virginia's state-controlled institutions of higher education for the Fall of 1972. Tables 12 through 15 include the number of classes, number of students and full-time-equivalent enrollments in off-campus courses offered by Virginia's state-controlled institutions of higher education.
