#### DISTRICT-WIDE SERVICE COMMITTEE

#### General Purpose

District-wide Service Committees are established to create a procedure for administrative and service personnel of the District with common educational interests to develop a systematic method to communicate and discuss educational and operational assues pertinent to the group.

#### Chairman

Chairman of the various District-wide Service Committees will be <u>named</u> annually by the President of the District upon recommendation of the Management Council.

### Operational Procedure and Coordination

The Chairman shall call monthly meetings (or more often when necessary) and be responsible for the development of the agenda.

Minutes will be kept and disseminated to appropriate personnel - a copy to be forwarded to the office of the Vice-President for Education Services.

Policy and procedural recommendation for the improvement of the operations of the District will be made to the President.

#### Membership

One representative from each college as designated by the Executive Dean or as determined by the Office of the appropriate Operational Dean.

Ex Officio membership from the staff of the President.

#### DISTRICT-WIDE INSTRUCTIONAL COUNCILS

#### General Purpose

District-wide Instructional Councils are established to create a procedure for instructional faculty with common educational and student learning interests and to provide an opportunity for the faculty to discuss and consider issues and problems related to their areas of instruction.

The main function of each council is to promote communication and coordination between a common instructional area and across college lines. An auxiliary function is to collectively formulate and pursue recommendations that will be beneficial to the teaching-learning process.

While these Councils may stimulate and discuss common educational problems of curriculum and student learning, they will <u>not</u> be used as a forum to standardize programs.

#### Chairman

Group will choose its own chairman during the first meeting of each year.

#### Operational Procedure and Coordination

The Chairman shall call an orientation meeting in September, meet again before Christmas, and again before April 1, 1973. Of course, the Council may wish to meet more often.

The Chairman will have the responsibility for the assembling and development of the agenda. Brief minutes will be kept and disseminated to each Dean of Instruction and to the Office of the Vice-President for Education Services.

#### Membership

One representative from each college of the instructional area represented by the Instructional Council. This representative will generally be the Department/Division Chairman or his representative.


