ABSTRACT

.....

In order to clearly identify the target population of Federal activities in adult education, the Research Committee gathered State-by-State demographic information from the 1970 U.S. Census. This compilation of over 3,700 separate figures provides a profile of adults relating to an eligible population for a Federal-State-Local partnership program. The material is not interpreted and should be considered as an initial resource tool. The data are arranged by State and consists of six principal parts: the target population (persons sixteen years of age and older not enrolled in school who have not completed high school); selected population information (sex, race, Spanish speaking); education information; adult basic education; state correctional institution; and income and occupational information classified by white collar, blue collar, service workers, and farm workers. The target population includes 57,667,171 persons, or 28 percent of the United States population. (MS)

FOREWORD

The National Advisory Council on Adult Education is charged by law to review the effectiveness of programs under the Adult Education Act.

Early in 1972, the Council initiated a study of <u>Federal Activities in Support of Adult Education</u> in order to determine adult education and training programs being carried on by federal government agencies. The report stimulated the implementation of cooperation and coordination among agencies serving adults.

As work developed on that federal activities material and the Council completed its Annual Reports and recommendations, it became obvious that in order to assess, to any degree, program effectiveness, a target population must be more clearly identified. The target population for the Federal Adult Education Act (P.L. 91-230) is those persons 16 years of age and older not enrolled in school and who have not completed their secondary education.

The Council summoned its Research Committee, chaired by Mr. Charles P. Puksta, to gather information not only on this specific target population, but to assemble other demographic data which would be essential as a first step in program assessment and program planning.

The state-by-state demographic information was compiled by the Research Committee and staff from census volumns, state directors' reports, association documents, and special studies. This selected state information contains over 3,700 separate figures for the 50 states and the District of Columbia.

The material is unusual, if not unique. It is a compilation of selected state population characteristics and provides one of the first profiles on adults relating to an eligible population for a federal-state-local partnership program.

The interpretation, state by state, rests with each reader. For the Advisory Council and adult education, the document can be used as an initial resource tool on the target population identified in the Adult Education Act.

INTRODUCTION AND EXPLANATIONS

GENERAL CONTENT AND ORGANIZATION

This selected population information material is arranged state by state in alphabetical order and consists of six principal parts.

1) The Target Population:

Persons sixteen years of age and older not enrolled in school who have not completed high school. The target population figure was computed from the individual 1970 state census counts by adding the 16 through 24 year-olds not in school, and the 25 year-olds and older who had not completed their secondary education.

2) Selected Population Information:

Male and female population numbers for the total state population are given by total count, male and female percentage of the total state population, by race and by persons of Spanish language.

The Census Eureau estimated in April 1973 that after a new analysis of census figures, it had overlooked approximately 5,300,000 Americans in the census of 1970.

An analysis of the undercount by the Bureau disclosed that two-thirds of the number missed were whites; those blacks missed in the counting amounted to a higher rate because of the smaller size of the total black population.

The figures used in this adult education document have not been adjusted to include the 2.5 percent estimated error since the Census Bureau did not make adjustments in state figures.

3) Education Information:

There are 23 items on each state relating to education information. Additional computations by the reader can provide percentages for a particular segment of the population and DHEW regional totals.

4) Adult Basic Education:

The purpose of this selected demography is to provide stateby-state data for the purpose of assessing enrollment compared to the general and target population, average pupil hours and cost factors, and students enrolled by race and ethnic groups.

The primary sources of information were reports filed by state departments of education for the school year 1971 (USOE Report Forms 3058 and 3119). Additional ABE data can be obtained from the Office of Education publication number (OE) 73-11413: Adult Basic Education Program Statistics.



5) State Correctional Institution:

The Council's Research Committee obtained the correctional institution population figures for persons over 16 years of age (unless otherwise noted) from the Directory of Juvenile and Adult Correctional Institutions published by the American Correctional Association.

The only figures on a national basis for individuals in correctional facilities are for some 38 federal correctional sites. Little information is collected state by state, and tabulated into a national report.

Figures are not readily available on education levels of state inmates, education programs available, or the state dollars allocated for educational opportunities for persons in prisons and jails.

ABE figures for the nation in FY-71 show over 46,000 men and women received adult basic education instruction in correctional facilities. Some states reported no ABE enrollees in the federal state grant program which may indicate financial support for education came from other sources.

6) Income and Occupation Information:

Median family income is the income level that divides families into equal groups with half having incomes above the median and the other half having incomes below the median. The source for this figure is the Congressional Districts data booklet compiled by Congressional Quarterly, Washington, D.C.

The four major classifications for employed persons are as follows:

- White collar: professional, technical and kindred workers; managers and administrators, except farm; sales workers; clerical and kindred workers.
- Blue collar: craftsmen, foremen, and kindred workers; open lives, except transport (i.e., includes by and large per ons who operate machines or tools); transport equipment operatives; laborers, except farm.
- Service workers: service workers, except private households; private household workers.
- Farm workers: farmers and farm managers; farm laborers and farm foremen.

Persons 14 and 15 years of age employed full-time in the labor force have been included in the state occupational information section. Many of these individuals have not finished their secondary schooling and can be added to the target population as potential ABE enrollees.



SPECIAL EXPLANATIONS

Each state has 28 boxes of information. Each box is referenced in the back portion of the publication. In four boxes, footnotes are provided which further clarify the figure or percentage used.

Figures for Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, and the Virgin Islands are not included. Complete data was not available on these geographical areas.

Census Sampling Techniques: Total state and congressional district population are based on complete count census data. Census data for other categories--voting age, income and occupation, education, housing, race and ethnic groups--were derived from representative samples of the population, rather than complete count. The samples consisted of 5 percent, 15 percent, and 20 percent, depending on the subject covered. The sample data was adjusted by the Census Bureau to reflect the entire population. For a measure of the sampling variability of the sample data and for comment regarding reliability of the data, see the section "Accuracy of the Data" in U. S. Census of Population, 1970, Vol. I, Characteristics of the Population, Bureau of Census, Washington, D. C.

LIMITATIONS

Differing laws at the state level prevented some states from reporting specific ABE items.

The census information was obtained from the most recent 1970 census figures, however, the Bureau of Census is constantly refining its tabulations which may result in some figure modification.

The ABE information is from the FY 1970-71 school year which relates the closest to the 1970 census count.

■ THE NATIONAL TARGET POPULATION: 57,667,171

This figure represents persons 16 years of age and older who have not completed secondary school and are eligible for adult education under provisions of the Federal Adult Education Act, P.L. 91-230.

- In 1970, the population of the United States was 203,210,158. Within that population, approximately 28% of all persons 16 years of age and older had less than the completion of secondary education.
- In the United States, there are over 5,255,000 persons 16-24 years of age not enrolled in school with less than the completion of high school.
- In the 1970 census, females and males 25 years and older totaled 109,899,359. In that population bracket, 48% have not completed high school.



● There are 1,768,293 persons in the United States today with no school years completed.

● There are nearly 756,000 14 and 15 year-olds employed full-time in the labor force.

Between 1967 and 1971, over 2.8 million adults have been enrolled in the Federal Adult Education State Grant Program.




