ABSTRACT

Listed in the circular are approximately 32 commercial and volunteer producers of large type materials, approximately 50 large type books for reference and special needs, and five further sources of large type materials. Usually given for each alphabetically listed producer are the address, specialty (whether producer of specific categories or of photographic reproductions), type size, and price. Listed alphabetically by subject or category are large type reference books, and usually stated are publisher, type size, and price. Subjects and categories covered include blindness, careers, cookbooks, dictionaries, an encyclopedia, piano music, scouting, and song books. Listed are five further sources of large type materials such as textbooks, music, and Catholic textbooks. (MC)

INTRODUCTION

Large type books provide easier, more comfortable reading for many persons who have difficulty reading normal print, among them are the partially sighted and the elderly. Magnifiers enable some partially sighted persons to read books in smaller type, but not all persons who can read large type are able to use magnifiers.

Commercially produced large type books have been available in the United States since 1965. Many public libraries have added large type books to their circulating collections.

Type is measured in points from the bottom of the lowest letter (for example, the tail of the letter "y") to the top of the tallest capital letter; type an inch high measures 72 points. Large type, or large print, generally refers to letters which are 14 to 30 points high. However, 16 points is the minimum size which meets the standards for large type established by the National Accreditation Council for Agencies Serving the Blind and Visually Handicapped. By comparison, most adult books are set in 10 or 12 point type, and newspaper print is often 8 point type.

Large type materials are produced by three methods:

- 1) setting the material to be printed in type which is the desired size, the best method for achieving sharp, uniform letters;
- 2) photographically reproducing and enlarging material already printed in ordinary type, a less expensive method, especially for a limited number of copies;
- 3) typing on a large type typewriter, a method often used by volunteers to meet the individual needs of students and other partially sighted persons.

This Reference Circular lists commercial and volunteer producers of large type materials and describes the kinds of large type materials available; the type size is indicated when known. Please write to the producers for the latest information on the large type books each provides; in most cases, free catalogs are available on request.
