ABSTRACT

For the past 7 years, the State Council of Higher Education has published a report of selected characteristics and degree programs for Virginia's state-supported colleges and universities. By combining data from independent institutions with information collected from the state-supported colleges, a more comprehensive picture of higher education in the Commonwealth has been obtained. This report has been developed to provide information frequently required by students, parents, and other citizens. For each school the following information is provided: the address, president or chancellor's name, enrollment for 1972, year founded, whether coeducational or not, institutional charges, and degree programs. These descriptions are divided into 3 parts: 4-year private colleges and universities; 2-year private colleges; 2-year state-controlled community and 2-year branch colleges, and 4-year state-controlled colleges and universities. 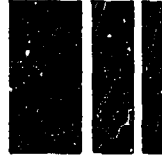

INTRODUCTION

For the past seven years, the State Council of Higher Education has published a report of selected characteristics and degree programs for Virginia's state-supported colleges and universities.

In January 1971, twenty-six accredited colleges joined together to form the Council of Independent Colleges in Virginia. Working through the Council of Independent Colleges, the State Council of Higher Education has been able to collect information on selected characteristics and degree programs from the private sector of higher education in Virginia.

By combining data from independent institutions with information collected from the state-supported colleges, a more comprehensive picture of higher education in the Commonwealth has been obtained.

This report has been developed to provide information frequently requested by students, parents, and other citizens. Prospective students are encouraged to seek information concerning admission standards and procedures from the Director of Admissions at each institution in which they are interested. Although costs are generally higher at the independent colleges, it should be noted that financial aid opportunities at these institutions may compensate for the additional cost.

Although the State Council will be pleased to respond to questions of a general nature about information in this publication, requests for additional or more detailed information should be directed to the individual institution.

All data included in the report are for the academic year beginning September, 1973 and changes may occur during the year.

The State Council hopes that this report will prove to be a valuable service to higher education in the Commonwealth. The Council welcomes comments and suggestions for future improvements in this publication.

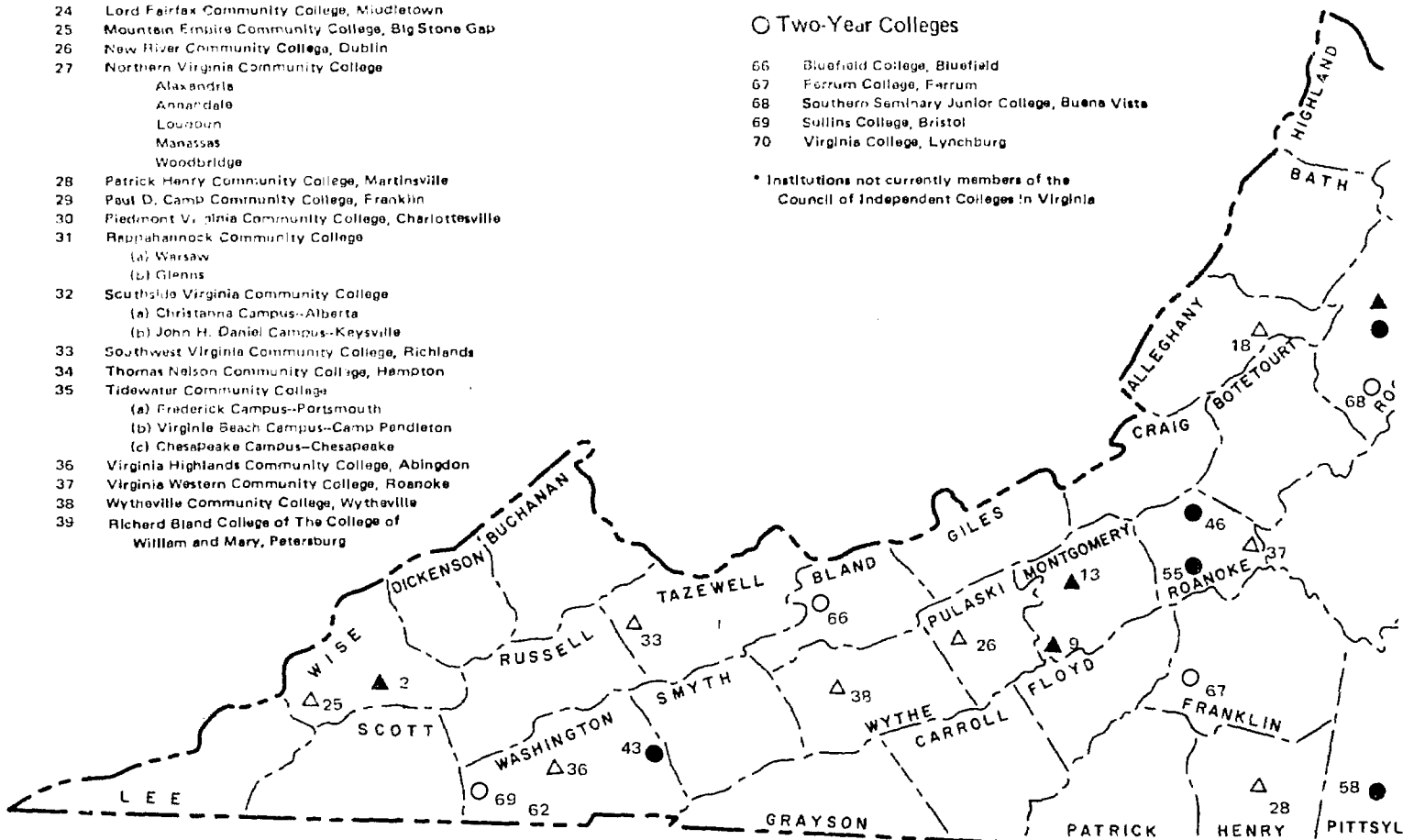

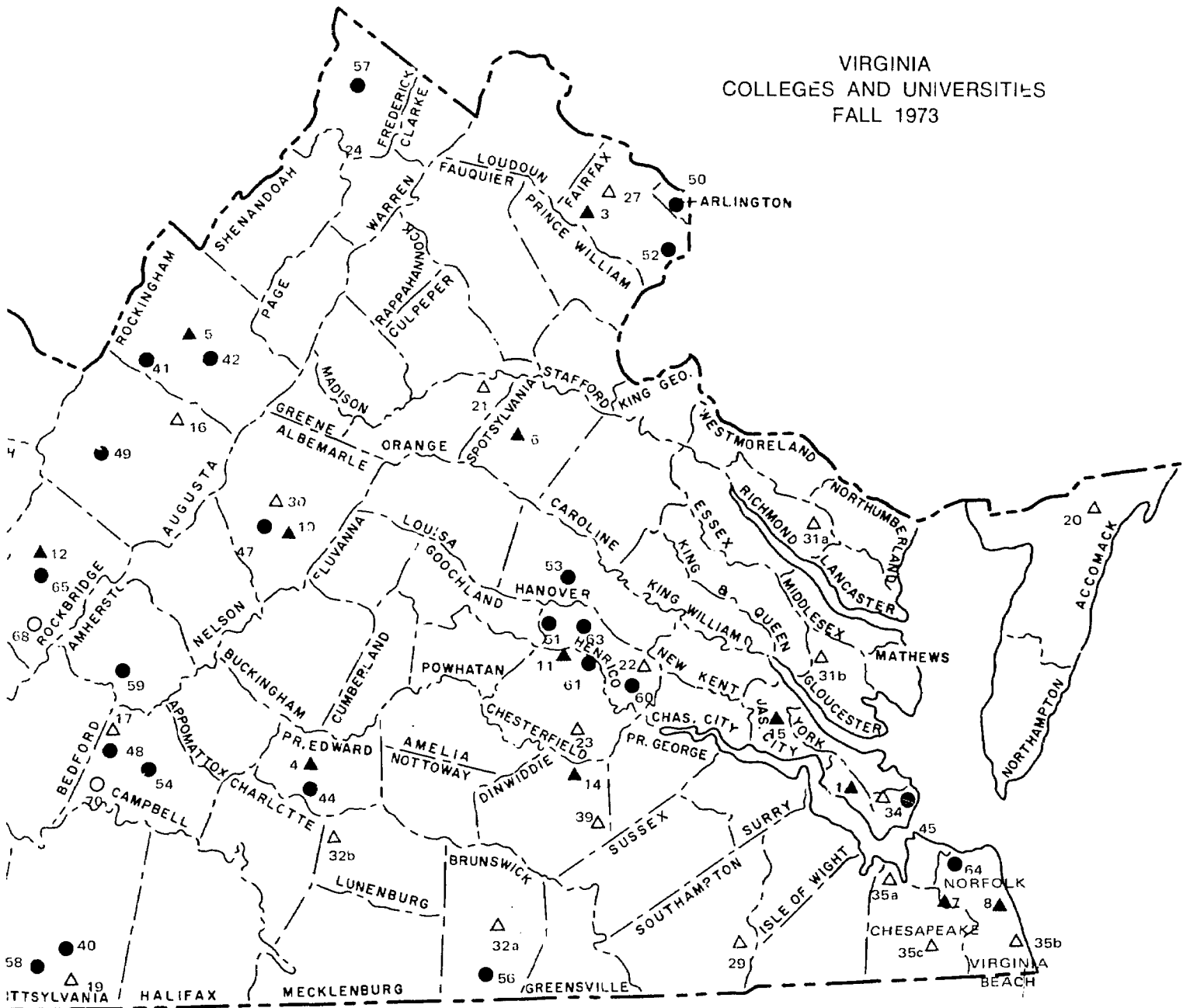
