ABSTRACT

The books included in this bibliography were written by or about notable Americans from the 16th century to the present and were selected from the holdings of the Penfield Library, State University of New York, Oswego, on the basis of the individual's contribution in his field. The division into subject groups is borrowed from the biographical section of the "Encyclopedia of American History" with the addition of "Presidents" and includes fields in science, social science, arts and humanities, and public life. A person versatile in more than one field is categorized under the field which reflects his greatest achievement. Scientists who were more effective in the diffusion of knowledge than in original and creative work, appear in the tables as "Educators." Each bibliographic entry includes author, title, publisher, place and date of publication, and Library of Congress classification. An index of names and list of selected reference tools containing biographies concludes the bibliography. (JH)

PREFACE

American History, through biographies is a bibliography of books written about the notable Americans, found in Penfield Library at S.U.N.Y. Oswego. Because of the great number of famous Americans, and because of time restrictions, comprehensiveness was not attempted. Thus, this bibliography by no means represents the total holdings of the library dealing with this subject.

The selection of figures was based on the top-level contribution in their own fields of individuals who helped build the nation from the early sixteenth century to the very present.

The division of subject groups was based upon the biographical section of Encyclopedia of American History, except for "Presidents," for which a separate division was provided. People versatile in more than one field were categorized under the fields which reflect their greatest achievement. Scientists who were more effective in the diffusion of knowledge than in original and creative work, appear in the tables as Educators.

Arrangement of figures:

Figures in each table are arranged chronologically according to the date of birth and not performance of taking of office. Exception has been made for Presidents Kennedy, Johnson, and Nixon, whose taking office was considered.

In case of more than one book for one person, the arrangement of the books were according to the names of their author.

In cases where more than one person was born in the same year, alphabetical arrangement of the names was adopted.

My expression of appreciation goes to Mrs. Rosemary Kellogg, for her patience and kindness, which made the typing of this bibliography possible.
