ABSTRACT

Designed (1) to determine both the communication barriers arising among high school students of divergent subcultural backgrounds, and how low socioeconomic status black and middle socioeconomic status white listeners evaluate members of their own and different subculture groups as well as speakers of Network English as persons and (2) to examine communication barriers, this test consists of four maps. Each map contains two sets of directions--one set produced by a black dialect speaker and read by a black dialect speaker and a Network English speaker, and one set produced by a Standard English speaker and read by a Standard English speaker and a Network English speaker. [This document is one of those reviewed in The Research Instruments Project (TRIP) monograph "Measures for Research and Evaluation in the English Language Arts" to be published by the Committee on Research of the National Council of Teachers of English in cooperation with the ERIC Clearinghouse on Reading and Communication Skills. 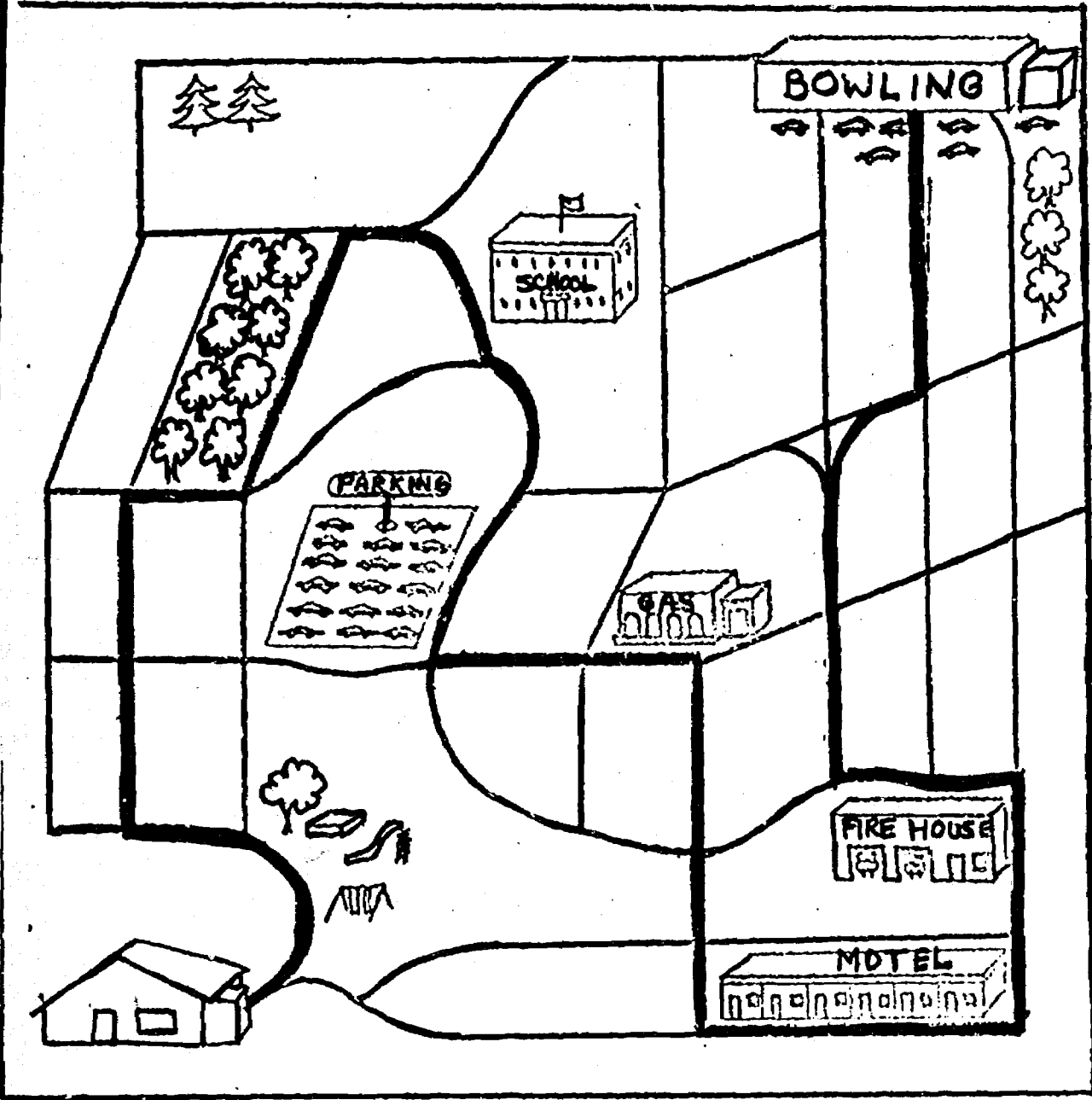
Description of Instrument:

Purpose: to determine what kinds of communication barriers arise among high school students of divergent subcultural backgrounds when they give and follow directions on maps; to determine how low S.E.S. black and middle S.E.S. white listeners evaluate members of their own subculture group, members of a different subcultural group, and speakers of Network English and communicators and as persons; to examine relationships between communication barriers and evaluative reactions to speech.

Date of Construction: 1972

Physical Description: This test consists of four maps; each with two sets of directions - one set produced by a Black Dialect speaker and read by a speaker of Black Dialect, and a speaker of Network English, and one set produced by a speaker of Standard English, and read by a speaker of Standard English, and by a speaker of Network English. The test is scored by the number of turns (minimum =15) which the subjects mark correctly on a map in response to the oral directions.

Map 1: BWS Producer #1

P TOWN

Well, the first thing I tell him is to leave out the back door, and go around the curved street. Pass the park with the swing and the slide And it's a big tree. You cross that street in front of the tree, And go down one block, and turn right. Go up for two blocks in front of the row of trees. Then you turn right. One block...then you turn left. Then you keep up the long street, And you turn right, up to this...right beside the school. Then you turn left. Come down for two blocks, and you'll be besides the parking lot. O.K. When you get there, you go...you turn left, down by the gas station. Keep going two blocks until you meet the gas station, And then you go, go right, go right all the way down, past the motel. And then you turn left again. Go down far as you can go. Turn up by the fire house. That'll be left. Keep down for two blocks, and then you turn right. Keep straight for about two blocks, for two blocks. Then turn at the fork in the road. You curve to the right. Then you stop at the next corner. Then you turn left, You keep straight to the bowling alley.

An evaluative reaction form accompanies the test and is completed by the listeners after each taped presentation. The form includes four items about the speaker's communication skills and four about his personal characteristics. A Home Background Survey about the listener and his family is also completed by each subject.

Validity, Reliability and Normative Data:

No validity nor reliability data are stated specifically for the test. The description of how the test was constructed tends to provide content validity. This discussion focuses on: 1) the procurement of directions which were technically correct in terms of map turns, 2) the selection of suitable subjects for reading the transcripts, 3) the selection of maps which were comparable in difficulty. Normative data are derived from forty-eight grade ten Black students and forty-eight White students. Means and standard deviations for Black and White listeners for each map are given.

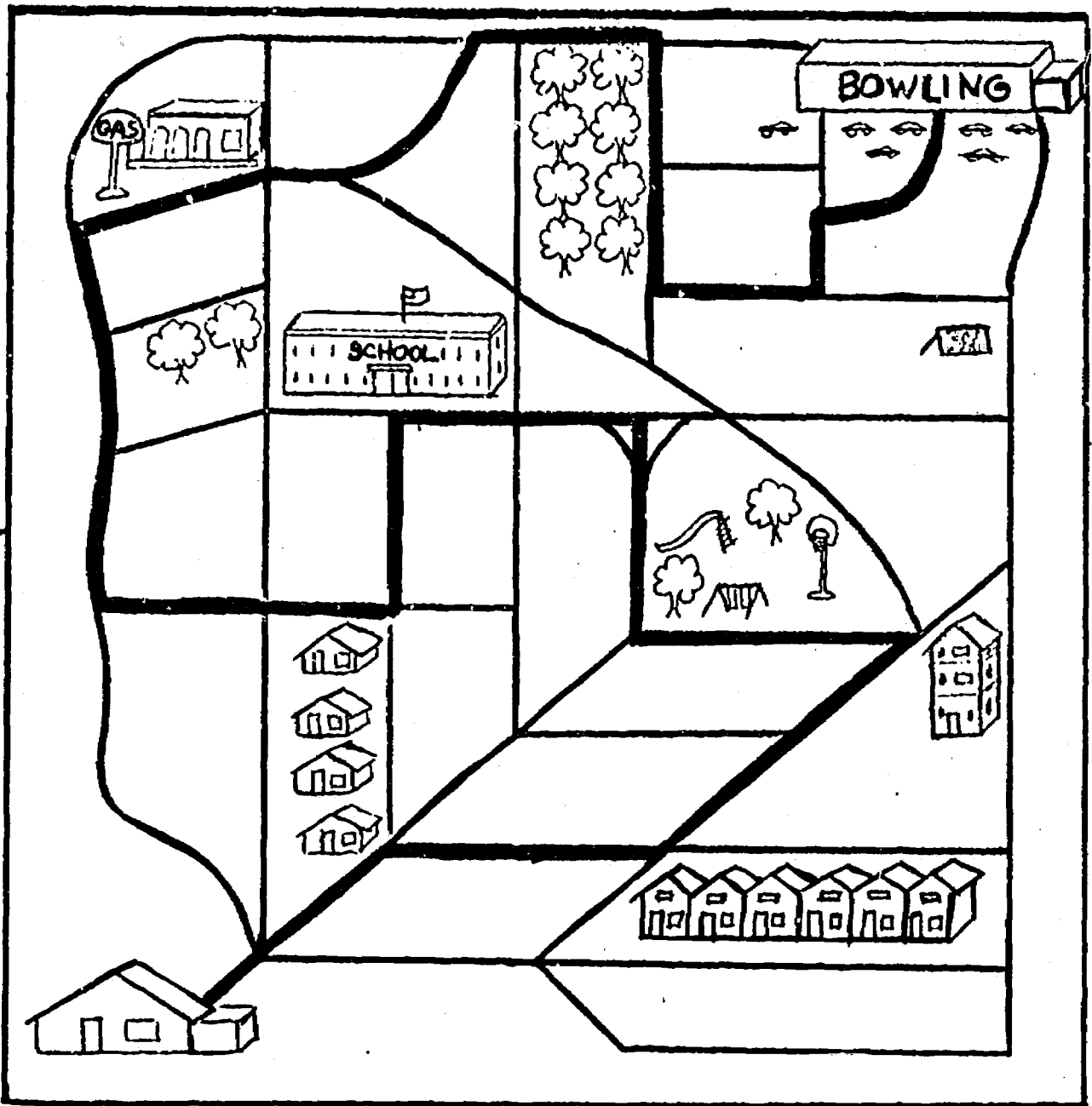

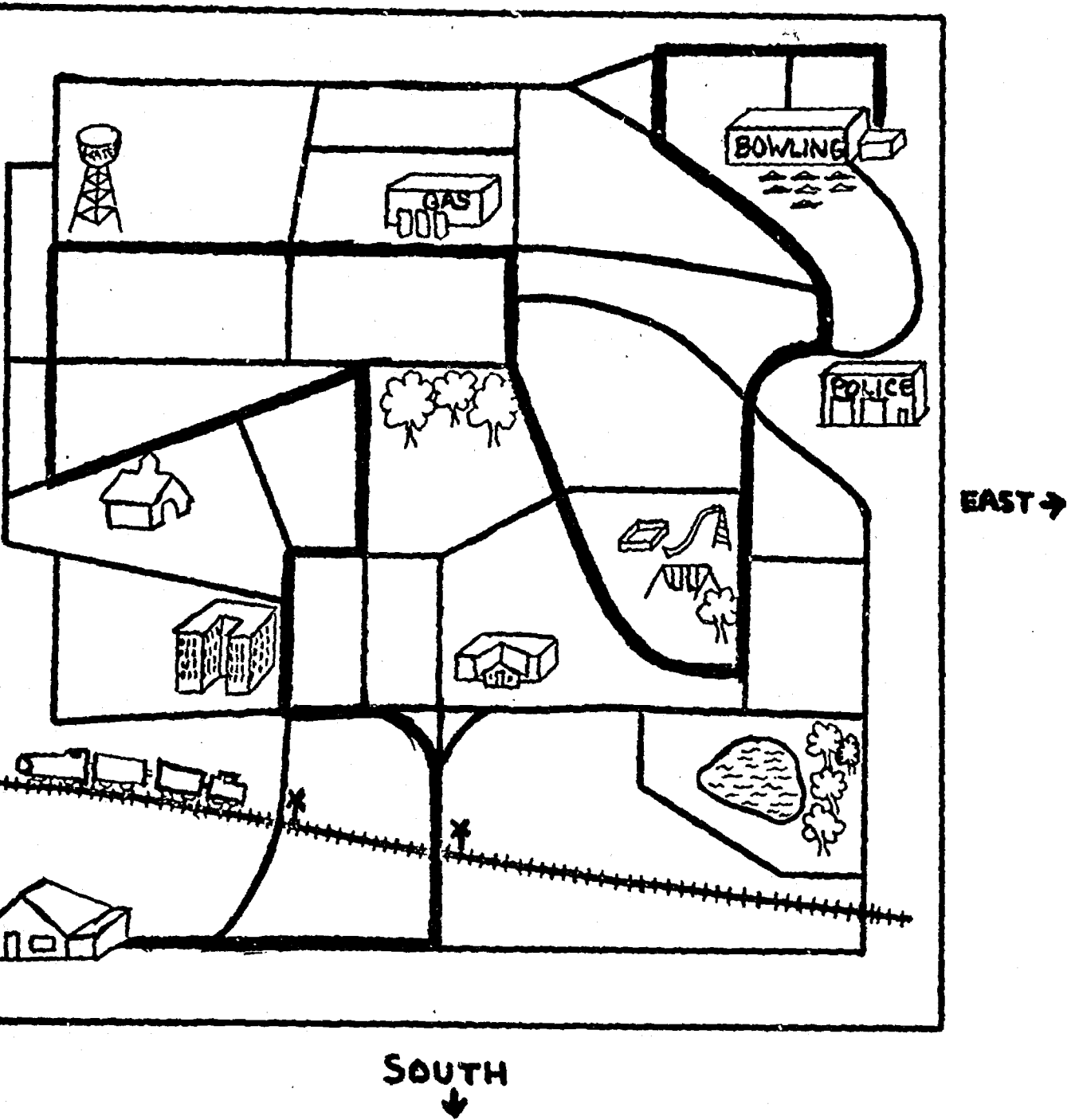

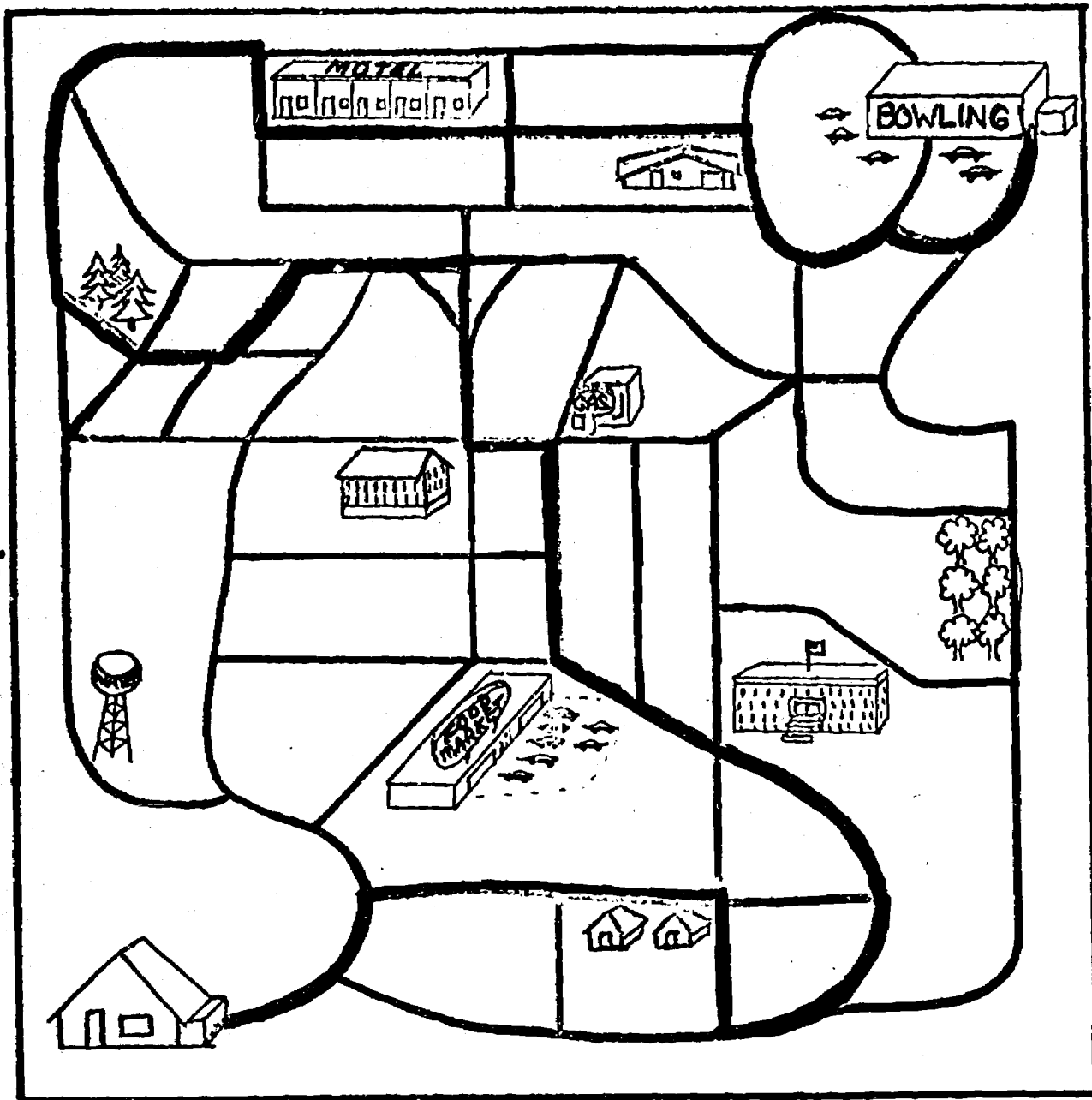

SAMPLE PRODUCERS' TRANSCRIPTS

Map 1: BWS Producer #1

P TOWN

Well, the first thing I tell him is to leave out the back door,
and go around the curved street.

Pass the park with the swing and the slide

And it's a big tree.

You cross that street in front of the tree,

And go down one block, and turn right.

Go up for two blocks in front of the row of trees.

Then you turn right.

One block...then you turn left.

Then you keep up the long street,

And you turn right,

up to this...right beside the school.

Then you turn left.

Come down for two blocks,

and you'll be besides the parking lot.

O.K. When you get there, you go...you turn left,

And turn eastward straight toward the...right in front of the motel,

'til the end of the other side.

And then there's a street going northward.

So you go straight up northward...behind the fire house.

You pass... let me see ...

there's a street going westward toward...behind the fire house.

And you go westward toward the street.

And go two blocks to the...up after you leave the fire house way.

You go northward straight up until you, you see a three lane traffic.

And you get on the lane towards your left, towards your right.

You get on that lane and go, go eastward.

And when you get toward eastward, you turn to the first street you get to.

And go straight up toward the bowling alley

the left fork in your road right before your house.

And you'll go, you'll go past one street.

and the motel is on the whole side of the street.

There, you'll take a left hand turn. Turn right after you pass the motel.

Go up to the fire house.

And at the fire house, you take a left hand turn.

Go down two blocks that way.

Go east...No, you go west two blocks.

At the second block, you take a right hand turn.

You'll go up two blocks before you see a little fork in the road.

You have three directions you can go--right, left, or just straight on.

You take the right fork.

And keep going on the right, on that street,

And just go down just a short ways,

And you take a left hand turn the first street you come to.

And that'll take you to the bowling alley.

You keep straight up, past two streets, all the way up to the gas station.

Stop at the gas station.

Turn right all the way up one block to the other,

to the street on this other side of the gas station.

O.K. Keep straight, and you...

it's a fork in the road,

And you go to the left, all the way to the north side of town.

O.K. Then you turn right.

Then you... you be about a block and a half, a half block away from the...

You can see the trees.

You keep straight past them.

Take the street on the east side of the trees.

You turn right, down for two blocks.

And you'll be at the bowling alley.

At the gas station, you'll turn right.

Go down one street...No, there'll be an intersection at the gas station,

And you'll just go right through the intersection.

There'll be a fork, there'll be a fork in the road.

You take your left fork. You veer to the left.

And that, take you to another street. A bigger street.

Turn right there.

Go down one, two blocks.

You'll pass a big grove of trees on your right.

On the second block, on the second street after you, after you, you pass...

Take a left hand turn there.

The first street on the right, it's the bowling alley street.

Map 3: BWS Producer #1

I tell him to leave out of his back door again.

Keep straight.

Pass the first street, and then turn left.

Pass the railroad tracks.

You curve to the left at the fork in the road.

Keep going straight and pass the, the first street.

Turn right at the second street.

You pass the big building, which's shaped like a U, like a horse shoe.

Then you keep straight up, past the first street behind that building.

Then you turn, turn right, turn right at that, that corner.

And then you go down for one block.

That be the next street. You turn left.

Keep straight up.

And then there'd be a kind of a L in the road, past three big trees there.

Then you turn back sharp left.

Keep straight down past the first street, and past the church, past the church.

The next street after the church, you turn right.

Keep straight up past one street,

all the way up 'til you hit the water tower.

Then you turn right.

Keep straight, past the first street, past the gas station.

And then you turn down, turn right all the way down.

Then you swing to the left,

And you be at the big . . . three big trees again,
but you're on the other side.

And then you keep straight, past one street,
all the way down 'til you're behind the park.

And then you stop at the corner. Turn left.

Keep straight up all the way past 'til you get to a police
station.

And the street behind the police station, you turn left.

Then you go around the corner from the curve,

'til it past one street,

'til you hit the next street.

And then you turn right.

Keep straight,

And then you turn right again.

And then keep straight past one street.

Turn right,

and you'll be at the bowling alley.

I'm on the way to the bowling alley from your house.

You go straight from your house, going eastward to about two blocks.

And you go straight up toward north 'til you, you reach the railroad station.

Pass by the, the railroad track.

Pass by the railroad track 'til you get to a three lane traffic,

and curve to your left.

Turn to your left 'til you . . . 'til you get to the second street

next to the, the apartment house.

When you get toward the apartment house, go straight up northward

on the eastern side of it.

Go straight up 'til you get to the second street, toward the church,

off toward the church.

And you turn eastward at the first street you can for about half of a block

'til you see a lot of trees.

And go straight up north 'til you get at the end of those trees.

Let me see . . . and then after you get, reach the trees,

end of the trees, you go . . . you go westward, southwestward
'til you see a big, beautiful church.

And at the church, there's a two streets,

And then you get to the first street that you get to and
turn northward,

And you go straight on north two blocks,

'til you get to . . . 'til you get to . . . 'til you get to
a water tower.

And when you reach the water tower, you stop there
and go eastward two whole blocks.

It's a long walk, but still walking.

Go straight eastward 'til you get to a filling station.

And then at the end of the corner, at that filling station,
there's a street going southward.

You go straight down that street

'til you get to a street that going katty corner . . .
like northeast, southeastward.

And you go straight down 'til you see a play ground,
where little children will be.

And then you turn the curve . . . the end of the play ground.

And go up on the east side of the play ground,

And go north, straight up the street

'til you get to a three . . . four lane traffic.

When you get to the four lane traffic,

stay on the same street and go around the bend

and then stop when you get to the police station.

Then when you get . . . get on the, on the north, north street,
a street going up . . . going straight up north katty cor-
ner . . . northwestern,

You get on the street and go straight around the bend
'til you see a lot of dusty roads.

You turn north and follow that road all the way north.

And turn east. Two blocks. And then south to the bowling
alley.

Go east from your house two blocks and take the second left.

Go across the railroad track.

When you get to the fork, curve to the left.

And go another whole block and take a right.

Go another block. Take another right.

Go one more block and take a left.

Go beyond the forest and then take a sharp left southwest.

Go past the church and then take the first right.

Go up that street a couple of blocks to the water tower
and take another right.

Go past the, get to the gas station, and take a right.

You stay on that street until you get to the park
and take a left there.

The street'll take you up by the police station.

You take a left at that street.

Go on up that street. Then take a right.

And take a right again at the end.

And it'll lead you into the bowling alley.

Take the second block and go into the bowling alley.

From your house, you will go two streets,
straight, straight on the street coming right from your house.

Where this road, where that road ends, you'll take a left
hand turn there.

police station. The police, you take a left hand turn.

You'll pass one street, and you just keep going on your
street.

Take a right hand turn on the first street to your right.

Take a right hand turn there.

Go down one street. Take a right hand turn.

Go down two blocks. Take a right hand turn.

And you're at the bowling alley.

L TOWN

You have to leave out of the side door or your back door.

Go around the curve in the road directly behind your house,

past one street to the next one.

Then you turn right,

all the way down for a block, and past the two little houses on the corner.

Turn...turn right. Turn south.

You go all the way down until you can't go any further.

Then you'd have to turn east.

You go all the way around the curve.

There'd be a fork in the road,

but you keep on to the left.

Swing to the left, past the next street, and the next one, and the next one.

And then at the fork, you have to turn right.

Pass one street,

and at the next corner, there be a gas station.

There be a gas station to your right,

but you turn left.
