ABSTRACT

The 1971 annual report on public assistance, prepared by the Research and Statistics Section of the Minnesota Department of Public Welfare, presents data pertaining to expenditures for American Indians. The \$8,285,789 of expenditures are broken down by program and funding source. The programs are Old Age Assistance, Medical Assistance, General Relief, Aid to the Disabled, Aid to the Blind, and Aid for Dependent Children. Programs use either Federal, county, or State funds. Statistical data are given for the 21 counties having a majority of Minnesota Indians. Trends in public assistance expenditures for Indians and trends in cases and persons by program are given for 1956 to 1971. (NQ)

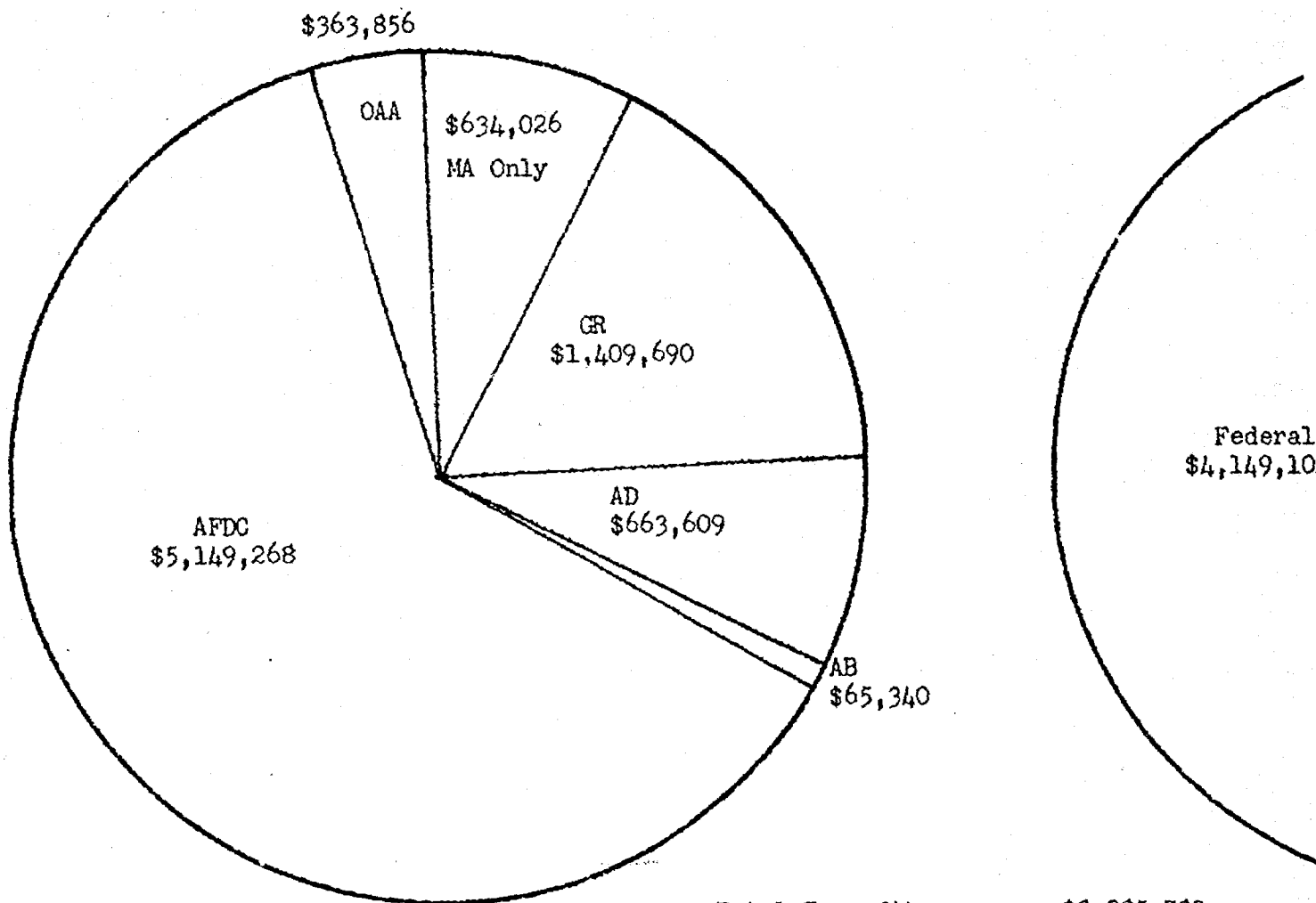

Total Expenditures were \$8,285,789

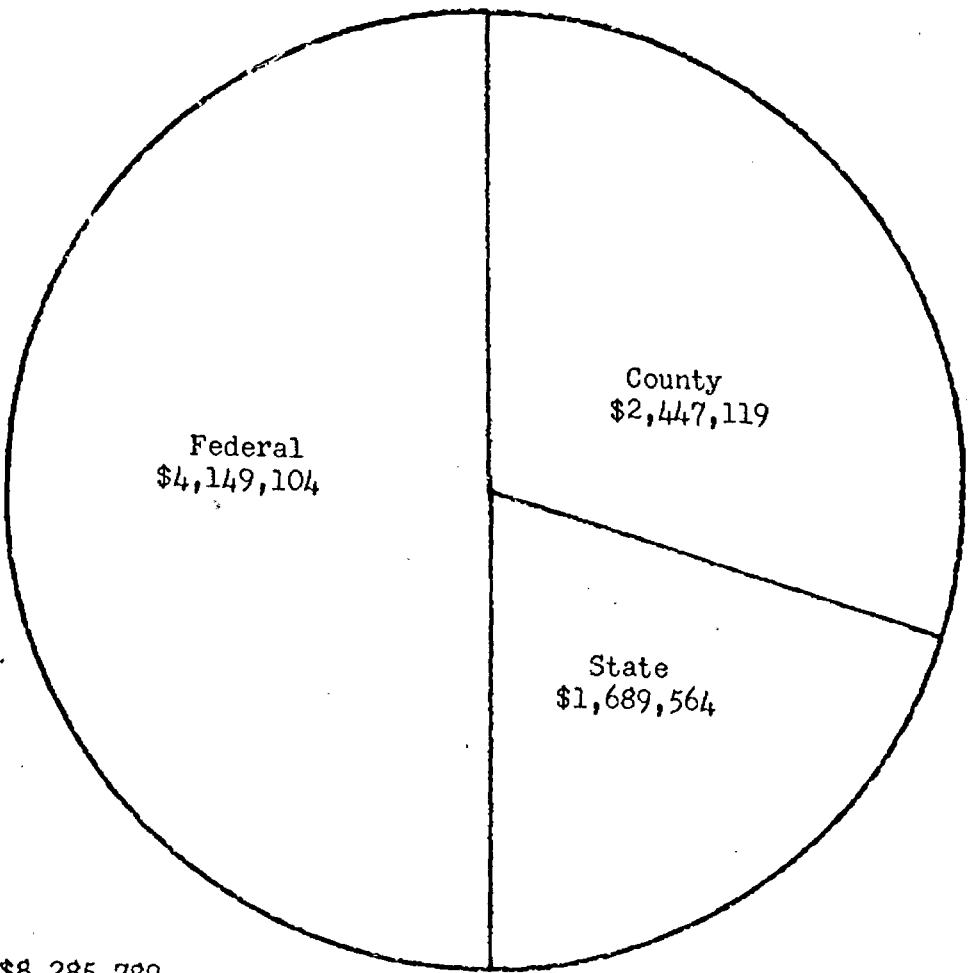

The two graphs on the front cover of this report present a part of the data from Table I. The total expenditures for Minnesota Indians in 1971 is broken down by the six programs as in Table II and the total number of funds as in Table IV.

Expenditures increased while recipients decreased from 1970 to 1971. Table I shows that total expenditures increased \$843,138 or 11.3% whereas Table II shows that the total number of recipients decreased by two changes resulted in the change in average payment per person from \$388.04 in 1970 to \$382.12 in 1971 as shown in Table XII.

Some caution must be used in comparing the figures between the various tables of this report. The 1971 data are actual 1971 calendar year data except that certain noted figures are not available. The AFDC person count is missing for Hennepin and Ramsey counties. The AD person count is missing for Mahnomon County. No data at all was received from St. Louis County. Tables IV, XI, and XII contain state totals which include estimates for St. Louis County. Table I is for St. Louis County only.

The procedure used in estimating the missing figures was to make them proportional to the total. If a figure was missing, the estimate was obtained from a proportion using the money payment and the total for all the remaining counties. Including estimates for St. Louis County involved two steps. The estimate for expenditures and recipients was derived from a proportion using the 1970 total, and the 1971 total minus St. Louis. After this, breakdown within programs for Tables I, II, III, IV, XI, and XII to the corresponding totals minus St. Louis.

Changes were made in the grouping of General Relief accounts. These changes were made to be consistent with General Relief reports for all persons. Account 5105, Burials was in General Relief. Account 5130, Illegitimacy Costs was in Other and is now in Medical Care. Account 5131 (T.B.) was in Medical Care and is now in State Institutions. If no change had been made, the following would have been presented:
