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ABSTRACT

Prepared by the Research and Statistics Section of the Minnesota Department of Public Welfare, this 1972 annual report contains data on public assistance expenditures for American Indians. Data are broken down by program and funding source. The programs are Old Age Assistance, Aid for Dependent Children, Aid to the Blind, Aid to the Disabled, General Relief, and Medical Assistance. Programs use either Federal, county, or State funds. Statistical data pertain to the 21 counties with the majority of Indians and the City of Minneapolis. Trends in public assistance expenditures for Minnesota Indians are reported for 1956 to 1972. A graph showing total public assistance for Indians and percent of total public assistance for all Minnesota recipients for 1959 to 1972 is also included. (NQ)

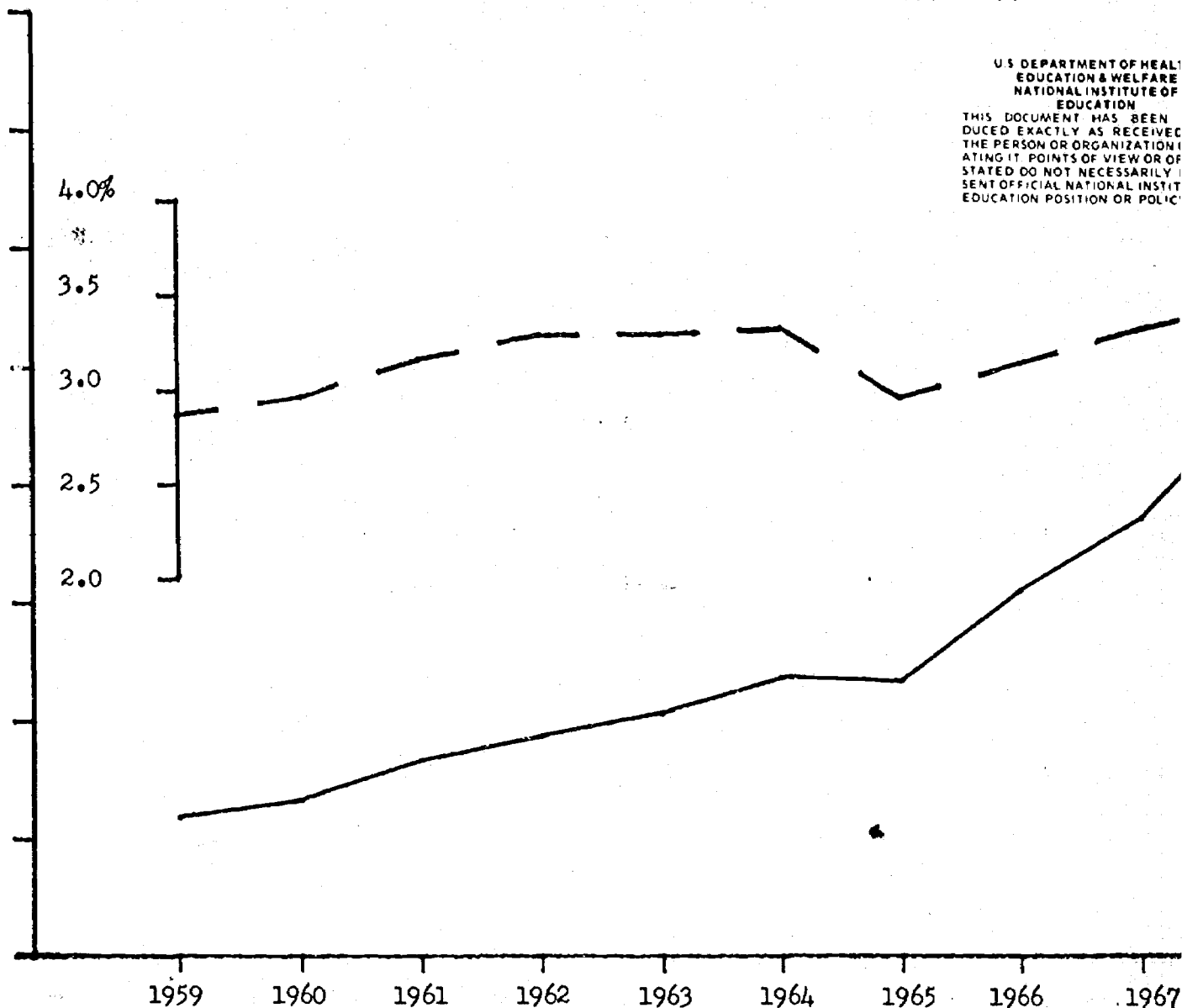
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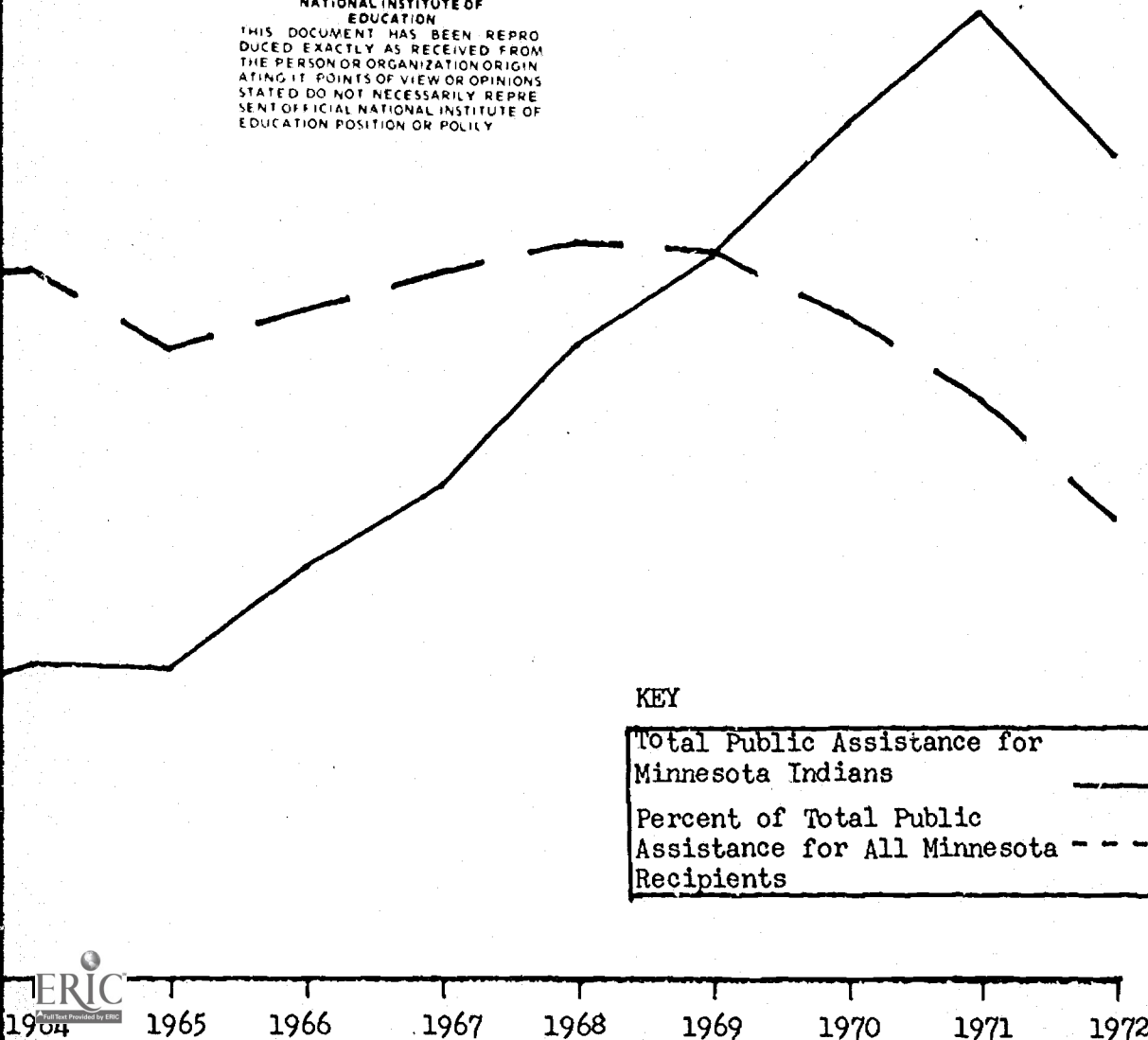

## Public Assistance for Minnesota Indians

The graphs on the front cover of this report show the pattern of change in total Indian Public Assistance through 1972. One source of data for the graphs is table XII of this report. The other source is the Statistical summaries from 1960 through 1972. The total Public Assistance from the summaries is \$1,253,486. The total Public Assistance from the summary for St. Louis County's General Relief for 1971. The total Public Assistance is not the same as that total only includes those counties specified as "Indian Counties".

The upward nearly exponential curve of the Indian Assistance is broken by the two years 1965 and 1972. The 1965 graph shows the 1965 aberration to be prominent but the 1972 drop is shown to fit into a downward trend.

The 1971 to 1972 drop occurred prominently in Hennepin County. Even though several counties experienced a decrease in payment, Hennepin County carried the state in the downward trend. Hennepin's total dropped only \$933,813. Hennepin's maintenance payments dropped \$1,253,486 and the medical payments dropped \$1,253,486. The greatest decrease occurred in Hennepin County, a decrease of 67.5% of the 1971 figure.

Tables XI and XII include 1972 totals which are greater than the totals from the other counties. This is because an estimate for St. Louis County is included. The estimate adjusts the 1972 total to be proportional to the change occurring in the other 20 counties.

Hennepin County's reporting procedures for reporting Indian Assistance changed for 1972. The downward trend in caseload and payments from 1971 to 1972. In years prior to 1972 the reports were not as precise means, so the reports for those years give an inflated picture of Indian Assistance.

by the two years 1965 and 1972. The percent of total income is shown to fit into a decreasing rate which began in 1969.

Though several counties showed substantial decreases in income, the total for the State dropped \$1,398,805 while the state total for 1972 was \$4,886 and the medical payments dropped \$332,682. These decreases occurred in AFDC which dropped \$1,218,992,

from the other calendar year tables of this report. The estimate adjusts the 1970 St. Louis total by a figure

changed for 1972. This is likely the major factor in the decrease in income prior to 1972 the estimates were obtained through less income from Indian Assistance.
