**1972-73**

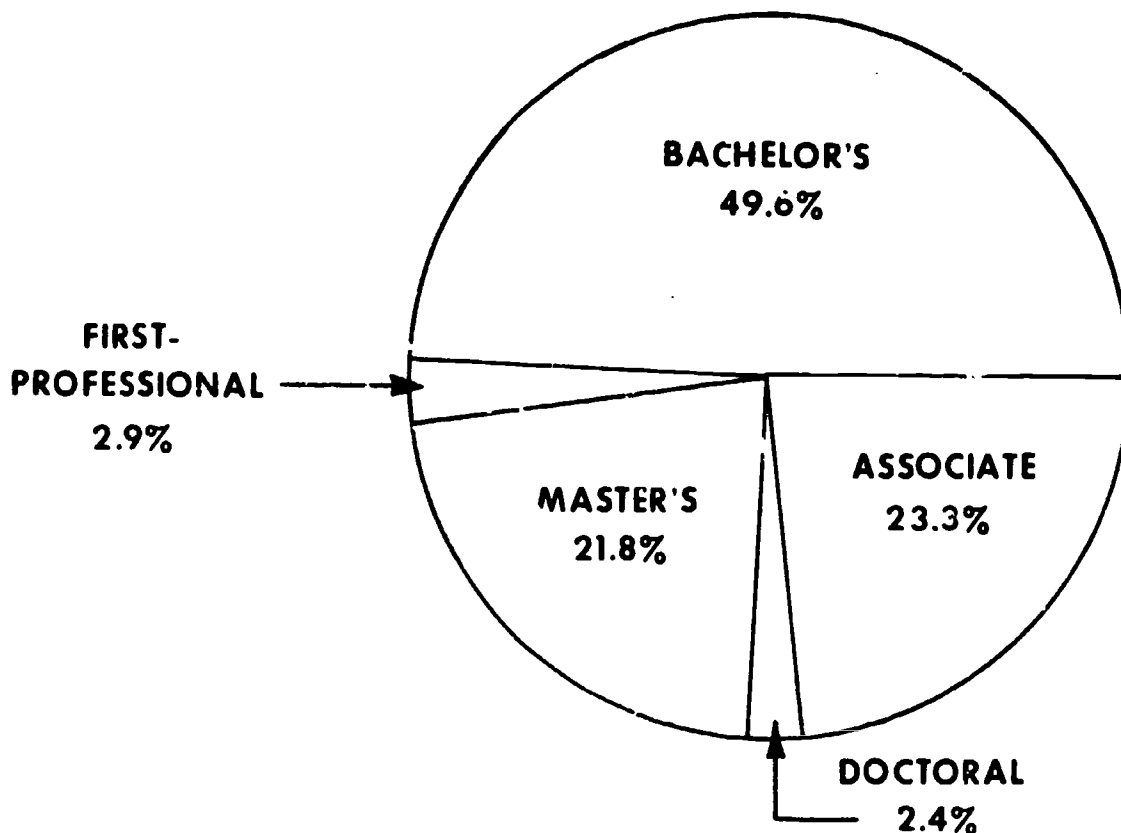
