**ABSTRACT**

This study presents data on full-time faculty appointees at each Hawaiian community college. The material is presented in a series of tables cross-referencing information about each campus, program categories, tenure status, sex, age, education, and salary. Of the 749 appointees, 68 percent are full-time, 2 percent are part-time, and 30 percent are lecturers. Eighty-two percent of the professional staff serve in instruction; 372 in general education, 240 in vocational education. Following previous years' patterns, 63 percent are male. The average age is 40, average salary \$14,413, and 61 percent have a masters degree. Lecturers tend to work in general education areas and earn \$1,569 for a course. As compared to full-time staff, lecturers are younger; more have only a B.A. degree, and more are women. Fifty-seven percent of the full-time professional staff is tenured. It is expected that over 80 percent will be tenured by 1978. (MJK)

Faculty data are receiving greater attention and study over time. Many developments in higher education are related--fewer dollars, collective bargaining, the reexamination of traditional personnel practices--to name a few.

The primary focus of this report is on all FULL-TIME BOR APPOINTEES WHOSE STANDARD FORM 5Bs (SFSBs) WERE SUBMITTED TO AND PROCESSED BY THE UNIVERSITY PERSONNEL OFFICE BY OCTOBER 31, 1974. Minimal information (mostly headcount) is provided on: lecturers, part-time BOR appointees and professional staff on leave.

Information for this report was abstracted from Faculty-Staff Information System (FSIS) summary reports 2530-2535, as of October 31, 1974. Standard Form 5Bs were used as the basis of these computer reports.

Data on the BOR staff is summarized by five major groups. (See Appendix A.) These categories were developed jointly by representatives from the colleges, Management Systems Office and the Office of the Vice President for Community Colleges.

HIGHLIGHTS

Table I. Unduplicated Headcount, by Program Category and by Full- and Part-time Status

1. FSIS computer reports show a total of 749 BOR appointees on the rosters of professional employees of the community colleges this fall.
2. Of these:
  - a. 513, 68 percent, are full-time staff members
  - b. 15, 2 percent, are part-time staff members
  - c. 221, 30 percent, are lecturers. (Note: This is an understated figure since it is an unduplicated count of lecturers. It excludes those lecturers whose "home base" may be another community college, the Manoa campus or another unit of the University system.)
3. Personnel in instruction number 612 and comprise 82 percent of the professional staff: 572 in general education and 210 in vocational education.

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Table II. Sex, Highest Degree Earned, Total and Average Salaries Earned, Full-Time Professional Staff

1. Full-time BOR staff number 513, 42 more than last fall. Of these, 386, 75 percent, are instructors; 46, 9 percent, are in student services. The proportion of staff in academic and institutional support tended to be higher in the smaller institutions.
2. Sex Distribution
  - a. Males: 65 percent, similar to previous years.
  - b. Campuses vary, reflecting to a large extent the program offerings of the institutions. Over 70 percent of the staff are males at Honolulu and Maui Community Colleges. The ratio is almost even at Kapiolani while females comprise slightly over half of the staff at Windward Community College.
  - c. Females are especially outnumbered by males in the non-instructional areas such as institutional and academic support.
3. Highest Degree Earned
  - a. The distribution of professional staff by highest degree earned shows a pattern similar to last year: master's degree, 61 percent; bachelor's degree, 20 percent; less than bachelors, 12 percent; doctoral degrees, 7 percent.
  - b. Instructors with less than bachelor's degrees are found in the vocational programs where expertise in a trade and technical area is considered an acceptable criterion for employment.
  - c. At Windward Community College 19 of the 20 instructors have master's degrees; 1, a doctorate. (Windward's instructional program is largely composed of general education courses.)
  - d. Of the 72 instructors with bachelor's degrees, 25 are teaching general education courses; 47, vocational education courses.
4. Salaries
  - a. Salaries paid full-time staff amounts to \$7,394,016 per annum for the six community colleges. (This figure excludes salaries paid to lecturers, faculty on overload, faculty on sabbatical leaves, and part time professional staff as well as those hired on a "casual" basis.)
  - b. The average salary of \$14,115 is about \$250 higher than the \$13,861 noted for last fall.
  - c. Average salaries range from \$13,415 (Windward C.C.) to \$15,745 (Kapiolani C.C.).

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Tables III and IV. Tenure Status by Age and by Year of Expected Tenure  
(See Tables Ia-f for details by college.)

1. Age

- a. The mean age of the full-time staff this fall is 40.7 years compared to 39.5 years last fall. Mean ages range from 35.8 (Windward CC) to 43.0 (Kapiolani CC).
- b. The great bulk of the staff, 329, 64 percent, is in the 25-44 age group.

2. Tenure Status

- a. Of the 513 full-time staff members, 57 percent are tenured, 26 percent are on the tenure track and 17 percent are not eligible. (The comparable figures last fall were: 48 percent tenured, 35 percent on tenure track, 17 percent not eligible.)
- b. The proportion of staff with tenure varies by campus from 18 percent (Windward) to 65 percent (Leeward). The relatively lower tenure rates for the "older" institutions such as Honolulu Community College can be partly attributed to the employment of proportionately more new instructors in recent years.
- c. An analysis by program category shows the highest tenure rates for staff in student services and in instruction, 61 percent each.
- d. By 1978, all except Honolulu Community College may have over 80 percent of the total professional staff with tenure and over 90 percent of the instructors with tenure.
- e. The mean age of those with tenure is 45.6 years.
- f. Non-instructional staff such as those in institutional and academic support with tenure were granted tenure as instructors, not as deans, etc.

Table V. Comparative Data: Selected Characteristics of Full-time Instructors  
(See Tables Ia-f for details by college.)

In analysis of the data for the past few years indicated:

- a. Little change in the distribution of instructors by sex (males, 56 percent; females, 44 percent),  
57 percent.
- b. Higher mean age (45.6).

- c. A higher mean salary: mean salary has been increasing at the rate of 200-300 dollars per year.
- d. A notable change in the tenure status of full-time instructors, from 41 percent tenured in fall 1972 to 61 percent in 1974.
- e. Proportionately more with master's degrees compared to fall 1971.

Table VI. Profile of Lecturers

- 1. Of the 221 lecturers, 62, 28 percent are at Leeward CC and 56, 25 percent, are at Kapiolani CC.
- 2. Profile: A 35.3 year old male teaching a course in the general education area. He has a master's degree and is earning \$1,569 for his work for the fall semester. (There were, however, proportionately more lecturers with bachelor's degrees, more women and more teaching in the general education area compared to the full-time instructors. Lecturers were also younger.)

Summary

- 1. Of the 749 BOR appointees, 68 percent are full-time, 2 percent part-time, and 30 percent lecturers.
- 2. Eighty-two percent of the professional staff serve in instruction, of the 612--372 in general education and 240 in vocational education.
- 3. Following previous years' patterns, males predominate, the distribution of highest degree earned--master's and doctorate total 68 percent, average salary slightly higher than the previous year.
- 4. Sixty-four percent of the staff is between 25-44 years of age, mean age of tenured is 43.6 years and 57 percent of the full-time staff is tenured, 61 percent of the full-time instructors are tenured compared to 41 percent in 1972.
