ABSTRACT

Since each Master's degree program has several areas of concentration, the areas of concentration have been alphabetically arranged within each institution. In addition, an index has been included in the front of Section two to help in locating those master degree programs of possible interest.

PREFACE

This booklet provides a listing of both long-term and short-term education programs designed to prepare registered nurses to work in an expanded role, and is the product of a cooperative effort by the American Nurses' Association and the Division of Manpower Intelligence, Bureau of Health Resources Development, Health Resources Administration. This booklet is aimed at providing students, counselors and health planners with much needed information on training programs in these relatively new fields of nursing. It contains program information on such items as location, entrance requirements, length of program, and sources of financial aid.

This booklet separates programs that prepare registered nurses for an expanded role into two sections:

- I. Programs Awarding a Certificate.
- II. Programs Awarding a Master's Degree.

Section I, Programs Awarding a Certificate, is alphabetically arranged by state, program, and city. Section II, Programs Awarding a Master's Degree, is arranged alphabetically by state and city. Since each Master's degree program has several areas of concentration, the areas of concentration have been alphabetically arranged within each institution. In addition, an index has been included in the front of Section II to help in locating those master degree programs of possible interest.

The information contained in this booklet was obtained from a number of sources and represents an effort on the part of the American Nurses Association and the Division of Manpower Intelligence (DMI), Bureau of Health Resources Development to make the list as complete as possible. The basic data about programs awarding a certificate were gathered in a DMI-sponsored 1972-73 study conducted by Interstudy (Contract N01-MI-24206 CPFF). Data about programs awarding a master's degree were secured by the American Nurses' Association.

A number of programs that fulfill the requirements for inclusion in this directory may have been inadvertently omitted. Any corrections about existing programs or information on programs omitted are welcomed and should be sent to the American Nurses' Association, Incorporated, 2420 Pershing Road, Kansas City, Missouri 64108. Such contributions will be included in the next edition of this publication.

INTRODUCTORY STATEMENT BY THE AMERICAN NURSES' ASSOCIATION

Providing the best nursing care possible is and has always been the primary concern of professional nurses. As an outgrowth of that concern, the nursing profession has continually kept pace with the technological and scientific changes in health care, and the role of professional registered nurses has continually been expanded in response to society's health needs.

Today's nurse, operating in an expanding role as a professional nurse practitioner, provides direct care to individuals, families, and other groups in a variety of settings -- homes, institutions, offices, industries, schools, and other community agencies. The nurse practitioner engages in independent decision-making about the nursing care needs of clients and collaborates with other health professionals, such as the physician, social worker, and nutritionist in making decisions about other health care needs. The nurse practitioner is an expanding role practices in primary, acute and chronic health care settings. As a member of the health care team, the nurse practitioner plans and institutes health care programs.

As the practice of nursing changes, nurses are continuing to improve and demonstrate their capabilities. The concept of registered nurse practitioners working in an expanding role is supported by the American Nurses' Association and by the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare.

In the 1971 report, "Extending the Scope of Nursing Practice", DHEW called for an extension of nursing's role to increase the effectiveness and efficiency in the delivery of health services to the consumer, as well as to provide wider professional opportunity and better utilization of manpower for the individual. The report was prepared at the request of Elliot I. Richardson, Secretary of the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, by a group of distinguished leaders in the field of health under the chairmanship of Dr. Roger Egeberg, Special Assistant to the Secretary for Health Policy. The ANA Congress for Nursing Practice endorsed the statement in 1972.

The competency of nurses to offer optimum quality nursing care to all people is also supported by the Board of Directors of the International Council of Nurses which is located in Geneva, Switzerland.

The American Nurses' Association, recognizing the full range of professional services which nursing can provide, firmly believes that no restrictions should be placed on nurses' opportunities to fulfill every aspect of their professional role. The functions of nurses are changing primarily because nurses themselves have recognized and demonstrated their competence to perform a greater variety of services.

Nurses realize that it is their responsibility to enhance their professional development through a variety of continued learning experiences. The concept of continuing education is endorsed and encouraged by the American Nurses' Association.

The programs listed here provide information or opportunities available to nurses to prepare themselves for an expanded role, so that they can maximize their contribution to nursing's primary goal -- the best possible health care for all people.

Inclusion in this list in no way constitutes endorsement or recognition of a program by either the ANA or HPA, nor should this be considered a complete listing of all continuing education programs to prepare nurses for expanded roles.
