ABSTRACT

This document presents detailed institutional enrollment tabulations by career and transfer program areas as well as by sex, full-time or part-time enrollment, and total enrollment figures. It consists principally of 12 tables: the first six tables present overall enrollments by institution and by program in 158 two-year colleges (67 junior colleges, 38 community colleges, 36 technical colleges, and 17 technical/vocational institutes); the remaining six tables present enrollments of full-time freshmen by program in the same institutions. The following eight program areas are considered: trades and industrial, technical, natural sciences, health, arts and humanities, social science and public service, business contact and marketing, and business detail and office. Fifty-eight percent of the 234,008 students enrolled in the 158 sampled colleges chose essentially career type programs, but 41.7 percent continued to elect basically baccalaureate-bound options. The fact that there was no more than a two percentage point differential between freshman and total enrollments in any one program indicates no significant shift in the attendance pattern of the 1973-74 freshmen class as compared to the total student population counted. CAREER EDUCATION AND TRANSFER PROGRAM ENROLLMENTS IN 2-YEAR COLLEGES, 1973-74

Garland G. Parker

Career education enrollments by academic programs in postsecondary institutions are a subject of high importance and great mystery. In 1972-73, The American College Testing Program (ACT) began its sponsorship of a study series by this author on 2-year colleges and their enrollments, with emphasis on career education programs. In the 1972-73 and 1973-74 ACT-sponsored reports, much attention was given to the rationale, importance, and growth of, as well as to trends in, career education programs. Summations of subset calculations, based on a career education questionnaire supplementary to the more general one requisite for the larger study, were presented and interpreted in the articles, but space and resource limitations precluded the publication of complete institutional tabulations by types of programs.¹ Although the interpretive material set forth in those articles is not repeated here, this ACT Special Report goes beyond the previous studies and presents, for the first time to our knowledge, detailed institutional enrollment tabulations by career education and transfer programs as well as by men, women, full-time, part-time, and total categories. Some additional interpretation is presented by the author, but it is the hope and expectation that this "inside" view of enrollments by programs will provide the basis for further study by institutional representatives as well as by other researchers whose analyses may yield additional information and observations of value to the higher/postsecondary education community.

2 CAREER EDUCATION ENROLLMENTS

Overall enrollments by programs in 158 2-year colleges. In Tables 1-5, enrollments are set forth in the above-mentioned categories for junior, community, technical, and technical/vocational schools on the basis of the following program designations: trades and industrial, technical, natural sciences, health, arts and humanities, social science and public service, business contact and marketing, and business detail and office. After the tables and copy for the career education segments of the April 1974 article in *Intellect* had been prepared, reports from a number of additional institutions were received. Since then, time has permitted a more exhaustive analysis of the returns from the schools included in the calculations for the above-noted study. On the basis of refinements in program classifications and emphasis on the tabulation of comparable enrollments by the indicated categories, a final selection of 158 schools was made for inclusion in this ACT Special Report. Some institutions were deleted from and others added to the list of units comprehended in the April 1974 *Intellect* study. While the data from the two reports generally are compatible, they are not identical. This report is submitted as a more exhaustive and refined study of the information derived from the enrollment by program questionnaire returns received incidental to the prior report. In the years ahead, it is anticipated that ACT will continue to sponsor the publication of this more elaborate and detailed analysis of career education transfer programs, subsequent to the publication of the more general article. A special word of thanks is extended to the 158 institutions that submitted complete enrollment data on the program bases indicated in the tables printed in this report. Such reporting was a complicated, time-consuming, and, no doubt, costly endeavor, but the concerted efforts of these 158 schools make available a treasure trove of heretofore unrevealed program information that has great significance for higher/postsecondary education, society, and the nation.

In accordance with the definitions found on p. 6, the 67 junior colleges reporting their enrollments completely and comparably indicated a total enrollment of 37,480, or 16% of the total students in the 158 schools. Of these, 55% were women, with 80.1% enrolled on a full-time and 19.9% on a part-time basis; 80.5% of the men were full-time and 19.5% were part-time. The 38 community colleges reported enrollment of 129,517 students, 55.4% of the total students in the 158 colleges. Of these, 42.1% were women, with 44.7% of the 54,515 women enrolled full-time and 55.3% part-time. Of the 75,002 men, 48.4% were full-time and 51.6% were part-time. In the 36 schools classified as technical, with 20.7% of students in all reporting schools, 30.2% were women, and, of that number, 55% were full-time and 45% were part-time. Of the 33,896 men, the full-timers comprised 54.7% and the part-timers 45.3%. In the 17 technical/vocational schools with 18,472 enrollees, or 7.9% of the total, only 28.1% were women. Of the 13,286 men,

66.3% were enrolled full-time and 33.7% part-time; the 5,186 women showed 70.9% as full-time and 29.1% as part-time students. In all 158 reporting units, the total enrollment was 234,008, of whom 40.6% were women. Of the 139,067 men, 55.6% were full-time and 44.4% were part-time, while the 94,941 women were reported as 55.4% full-time and 44.6% part-time registrants.

It is of great interest to note that the enrollment of men, women, total, and percent of total students enrolled by academic programs in 158 schools is as follows: trades and industrial, 22,151 men, 2,218 women, 24,369 total, and 10.4% of all enrollees; technical, 32,256 men, 5,731 women, 37,987 total, and 16.2% of all; natural sciences, 4,677 men, 2,802 women, 7,479 total, and 3.2% of all; health, 4,364 men, 14,270 women, 18,634 total, and 8% of all; arts and humanities, 35,423 men, 32,790 women, 68,213 total, and 29.1% of all; social science and public service, 12,924 men, 10,139 women, 23,063 total, and 9.9% of all; business contact and marketing, 14,591 men, 7,185 women, 21,776 total, and 9.3% of all; business detail and office, 12,681 men, 19,806 women, 32,487 total, and 13.9% of all students. The combined counts for primarily transfer-oriented programs (sciences, arts and humanities, and business contact and marketing) equal 97,468 students, or 41.7% of the total. It is significant, on the one hand, that 58.3% of these students chose essentially career-type programs, but also important that 41.7% continued to elect basically baccalaureate-bound options. The percentage spread of enrollments by program within the institutional types comprising the 158 schools is shown in Table 6. The concentration of enrollees in trades, technical, and business detail programs in the technical and technical/vocational schools is as might be expected, but also it is of interest to note that 13.5% of technical and 5.2% of technical/vocational school students elected programs in the arts and humanities.

Enrollment of full-time freshmen by programs in 158 2-year colleges. The second set of calculations, Tables 7-12, comprehends full-time enrollments in the 158 2-year schools at the first-year or freshman level. For purposes of detecting trends, and as a harbinger of future enrollment patterns, it is of interest to study freshman counts by institutional types and programs in comparison to overall enrollments.

Freshman enrollments for 67 junior colleges totaled 18,828, 21.4% of the total in all 158 schools; of them, 10,287, or 54.6%, were women. In the 38 community colleges, the total was 41,770, 47.6% of the total; 40.1% of these were women. The 36 technical schools registered 17,964 students, 20.4% of the total, and 32.7% of them were female. The technical/vocational category, with 17 schools, counted 9,277 students, 10.6% of the total, and showed 31.2% of them to be women. In all 158 institutions, with 87,839 students, the proportions were 59.2% men and 40.8% women.

4 CAREER EDUCATION ENROLLMENTS

In the 158 schools, freshmen elected program choices as follows: trades and industrial (62 schools), 8,936 men, 798 women, 9,734 total, or 11.1% of all enrolled freshmen; technical (95 schools), 12,548 men, 1,898 women, 14,446 total, 16.4% of all; natural sciences (47 schools), 1,865 men, 811 women, 2,676 total, 3% of all; health (91 schools), 1,725 men, 7,188 women, 8,913 total, 10.1% of all; arts and humanities (102 schools), 13,166 men, 11,050 women, 24,216 total, 27.6% of all; social science and public service (86 schools), 4,239 men, 3,400 women, 7,639 total, 8.7% of all; business contact and marketing (94 schools), 5,029 men, 2,315 women, 7,344 total, 8.4% of all; and business detail and office (112 schools), 4,504 men, 8,367 women, 12,871 total, and 14.7% of all students. It should be noted that not all schools had identifiable freshman enrollments in each tabulated program. The fact that there was no more than a 2 percentage point differential between freshman and total enrollments in any one program (health—10.1% in the freshman and 8% in the total category) indicates no significant shift in the attendance pattern of the 1973-74 freshmen as compared to the total students counted. In Table 12, the percentage spread of program enrollments by institutional types, while showing a wider range of differentiation of choices, is not indicative of any great disparities in program choices between freshmen and all enrolled students.

The reporting schools in geographical perspective. The geographical spread of schools and their enrollments by regions of the country are of interest but deserving of some interpretation. In the New England region, with 25 schools reporting 18,809 students, the distribution of institutional units by number and their enrollment counts, respectively, were as follows: Connecticut, 5 and 8,086; Maine, 2 and 1,110; Massachusetts, 12 and 7,035; New Hampshire, 3 and 892; Rhode Island, none; and Vermont, 3 and 1,686. In the Middle Atlantic states, there were 4 institutions in New Jersey and 1,274 students; in New York the respective figures were 6 and 2,658; in Pennsylvania they were 10 and 14,339; and, in the whole region, the totals were 20 and 18,271.² In the East North Central region, the numbers of schools and students respectively reported by states were as follows: Illinois, 3 and 3,579; Indiana, 2 and 594; Michigan, 6 and 29,117; Ohio, 17 and 31,287; Wisconsin, 6 and 19,271; and the regional totals were 34 and 83,848. Similar tabulations for the West North Central region by state were: Iowa, 8 and 7,169; Kansas, 4 and 4,056; Minnesota, 2 and 885; Missouri, 5 and 2,319; Nebraska, 1 and 2,673; North Dakota, 1 and 642; South Dakota, 1 and 411; and for the entire region, 22 and 18,155.

In the South Atlantic region, the counts by states were: Delaware, 1 and 1,010; Florida, 1 and 108; Georgia, 4 and 3,580; Maryland, 4 and 2,983; North Carolina, 12 and 8,244; South Carolina, 3 and 3,281; and the regional totals were 25 and 19,206.³ The East South Central region reported by states as follows: Alabama, 3 and 2,414; Kentucky, none; Mississippi, 3 and 1,543; Tennessee, 2 and 1,900; and, for the region, the overall totals were 8 and 5,857. The West South Central regional tallies by states showed: Arkansas, none; Louisiana, 1 and 6,317; Oklahoma, 4 and 3,256; Texas, 2 and 1,492; and the regional totals were 7 and 11,065. In the Mountain States region, the similar state tabulations were: Arizona, 2 and 18,088; Colorado, 3 and 4,270; Idaho, none; Montana, 1 and 510; Nevada, 1 and 6,946; New Mexico, none; Utah, 1 and 4,741; Wyoming, 1 and 528; and the regional totals were 9 and 35,083. The Pacific region totals by states were: Alaska, none; California, 3 and 5,891; Hawaii, none; Oregon, 2 and 6,584; Washington, none; and for the region as a whole, the totals were 5 and 12,475. The Commonwealth and Territorial region, encompassing 1 school in American Samoa with 809 students, 1 in Puerto Rico with 10,040, 1 in the Eastern Caroline Islands with 390, reported a total of 3 institutions and 11,239 students. In all 158 reporting schools in the nation, there were 234,008 students.

6 CAREER EDUCATION ENROLLMENTS

Definitions for ACT Special Report Eleven on Career Education and Transfer Program Enrollments in 2-Year Colleges: The general definitions used in this ACT Special Report are listed below:

The *full-time student* devotes substantially all of his or her working or study time to the college curriculum. This is interpreted generally to mean 12 collegiate-credit hours, presumably 75% of a normal load or more. The presumption is that these students are assessed full-time fees.

The *part-time student* normally takes collegiate-credit courses in the late afternoon, on Saturday, in the evening, frequently in the day, or by extension, and enrolls for fewer than 12 credits, or less than 75% of a normal load.

Freshman students are presumed to be full-time students classified as first-year or freshman undergraduate students. They are not necessarily first-time, degree-credit students, because such a restriction would preclude the listing of any students registered as freshman who began their college work in the previous winter, spring, or summer.

Two-year college students are those enrolled in collegiate credit-hour courses in 2-year (certificate or associate degree levels) postsecondary junior and community colleges, other multi-purpose colleges, technical and/or vocational schools or institutes, and university branch colleges/campuses/centers (i.e., administered by 4-year institutions). It is presumed that all such enrolled 2-year collegiate credit-hour students are counted. For the purposes of this report, all reporting institutions are comprehended in the following four categories: junior, community, technical, and technical/vocational institutions.

The definitions of academic programs covered in this study are as follows:

1. *Trades and Industrial:* auto mechanics, drafting, machine work, other trades
2. *Technical:* agriculture, engineering technologies, other technologies
3. *Natural Sciences:* natural sciences related to 4-year collegiate programs
4. *Health:* dental assisting, practical nursing, regular nursing, other health
5. *Arts and Humanities:* liberal arts and the humanities
6. *Social Science and Public Service:* cosmetologist, fireman, food service, police science, other social and public service fields

7. ***Business Contact and Marketing:*** business administration related to 4-year program, advertising, real estate, sales, transportation, other business contact and marketing fields
8. ***Business Detail and Office:*** accounting, computer programming, data processing, secretarial science, other related fields

Reporting institutions were asked to observe the following guideline:

"Only those students enrolled for collegiate-level credit in postsecondary 2-year: junior and community colleges, other multi-purpose colleges, technical and/or vocational schools or institutes, and university branch colleges/campuses/centers that have regional association, professional organization, and/or state agency recognition, approval, or accreditation should be reported."
