ABSTRACT

The 1974-75 survey of full-time faculty salaries in California community colleges was constructed by reproducing the salary schedules of the 69 reporting districts. The salary schedules included here are those published schedules adopted by district boards. Minimum standards for each salary class are described by the degrees, credentials, and additional units required, and bonuses for extra achievements are listed. (Author/DC)

PREFACE

Format of the 1974-75 survey of faculty salaries in California Community Colleges has been changed from that of previous years in order to distribute this information on a more timely basis for district use in decision-making. To accomplish this, the report has been constructed by reproducing the salary schedules as submitted by districts to our office. Consequently, any inconsistencies in reported data should be discussed directly with the district in question.

The full-time faculty salary schedule is included for reporting districts. Two other schedules, distribution of salaries for full-time faculty and fringe benefits for full-time faculty and administrative personnel, included in the 1973-74 survey, have been omitted this year.

The salary schedules for full-time faculty are those published schedules adopted by district boards. Minimum standards for each salary class are described by the degrees, credentials, and additional units required and bonuses for extra achievements are listed.

Maximum initial placement on the salary schedule shall be Step 6 of the appropriate class. Instructors shall receive appropriate credit for previous teaching and related work experience that may allow them a maximum of five steps on the salary schedule, therefore placing them on Step 6. Instructors will receive year for year credit on the salary schedule for teaching experience and one year credit for each two years of related work experience.

Instructors having a Doctor's Degree shall be placed on the appropriate step of Class IV, and shall receive an additional 6.6% of the salary schedule base.

CLASS AND STEP REQUIREMENTS

For purposes of salary classification, one year of full-time related work experience is equated to twelve semester units for career instructors (B).

A = Placement of both career and non-career area instructors.

B = Placement of career area instructors only (requires a Vocational-Technical Credential).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. Credit for previous teaching experience will be granted on a year-for-year basis up to a maximum of five years. Staff members reaching the maximum credit for experience in Classes 1, 2, and 3 (steps 8 and 11) will receive credit for additional accrued experience at Cabrillo when they move to the next classification.

Credit for occupational experience is given only for verified work experience beyond the minimum credential requirement. Each additional two years of experience equals one step, up to a maximum of two steps credit. (This applies at time of initial salary placement only.)

2. All units earned at an accredited college or university subsequent to the attainment of a bachelor's degree are credited for salary purposes. (See Policy #5331.) These shall be credited in semester units (a quarter unit equals 2/3 of a semester unit).
- *3. The normal route for horizontal progression from Class 1 to Class 2 involves obtaining the M.A. degree. To recognize the merit of alternate patterns of preparation in certain fields, the following equivalencies are provided:
 - (a) Life Class A Vocational Credential or Standard Designated Subjects credential issued for life. For those with a bachelor's degree, note 2 above shall apply. For those without a bachelor's degree, progression beyond column 2 shall be based on units earned after receipt of either of these life credentials.
 - (b) Community College Vocational-Technical Instructor Credential (full-time regular) plus 30 units.
 - (c) 45 units beyond the bachelor's degree, of which a minimum of 24 units must be courses for graduate credit in the teaching field.

4. Instructors may become eligible for a salary increase at 5-year intervals after serving at the 12th step. The increase, called a career increment, will be based on the differential between the 5th and 6th steps in Class 4.

Instructors in Class 4 may earn one career increment equal to that differential. Instructors in Class 5 may earn two career increments at the rate of 1-1/2 times the differential. Instructors in Class 6 may earn three career increments at the rate of twice that differential.

An instructor qualifies for the career increment applicable to the class in which his educational qualifications place him at the completion of the five-year service requirement. If he changes class after qualifying for the increment, he becomes eligible for the increment in the new class effective the next September 1.

**Grandfather Line

- Instructors with an earned doctor's degree will be placed at the appropriate step on Column 'E' plus, the difference between Column 'D' and 'E' at step 12.
- Only employees who were below the Grandfather Line in Columns 'A' through 'D' as of September 14, 1965, may remain at their 1973-74 step placement. They may not progress to a higher step in that column for their 1974-75 placement; however, they may move across to the appropriate step above the Grandfather Line on a higher column when eligible.
- Due to the column reduction in the 1970-71 salary schedule, only those employees who are relocated to steps below the Grandfather Line as of September 1, 1970, may remain at their step placement below the line. They may not progress to a higher step in that column, however, they may move across to the appropriate step above the Grandfather Line on a higher column when eligible.

Maximum of five years teaching experience will be allowed for entry into this schedule.

If three years or more of work experience in an occupation are required for the Vocational Credential requested by this College, then three years of such experience will be accepted for initial placement on this schedule and in addition, teaching experience will be credited up to five years.

Only units earned at an accredited college or university will be accepted and applied toward salary increments. Unless the Superintendent approved of an exception, all units credited to an instructor's salary increment must lead toward and fulfill the requirements of an advanced degree in the field in which the instructor is assigned to teach.

Full time instructors may have credited for salary schedule advances, a maximum of 12 units per year, including not more than three units earned during each Spring and each Fall semester.

SALARY SCHEDULE

The following salary schedule was adopted by the Governing Board of Palomar Community College District on September 24, 1974. It is formed on the principles underlying earlier salary schedules that academic training and teaching experience shall form the basic elements for salary determination. Supervisory or administrative responsibilities and services for greater than ten calendar months are the basis for increments to the basic schedule. This schedule shall become effective on November 1, 1974.

Salary credit will be granted for the completion of any upper division or graduate level course work at an accredited institution, with transcripts of units of credit.

Base Salary Five classes of base salaries are defined, and all other adjustments in the salary are based upon these levels of base salary by means of multiplying factors. The base salaries are computed on academic preparation and/or credential requirements and are defined as follows:

Anniversary Increments

The purpose of the anniversary increment is to stimulate the continued professional growth and currency in subject matter of the veteran teacher who has reached the top step of the salary schedule.

Anniversary increments will be available only to instructors who have been at Class V, Step 14, for a minimum of three years.

To qualify for the initial anniversary increment, the instructor must have earned either six units of qualifying credit during the time he has been at Class V, Step 14, or twelve units of such credit during the previous six years.

Subsequent increments, up to a total of five, may be granted to teachers who have served a minimum of three years since their previous increment and who have earned an additional six units of qualifying credit during that period.

Qualifying units earned under this program must be either upper division or graduate units and must be applicable to or relevant to the teacher's assignment.

Units submitted for qualification under this program must be recommended by the screening committee and have prior Board approval. This ad hoc committee consists of the Dean of Instruction, the President of the Academic Senate, and a Faculty member jointly chosen by the latter two.

The anniversary increment shall be equivalent to the differential between steps 13 and 14 of Class V of the District Salary Schedule for Certificated Employees.
