ABSTRACT

Enrollment figures and estimates for institutions of higher education covering fall 1973 and 1974 are presented. Tables indicate growth rated in public and private 4-year institutions and the 4-year branches of universities, and for 2-year institutions and the 2-year branches of other institutions. Data are also presented by sex and attendance status of students by state. Statistics indicate that enrollments in higher education have increased by a greater percentage than expected and by more than early estimates had predicted; enrollments increased by 5.5 percent overall, with a 6.3 percent increase in public institutions and a 3 percent increase in private institutions. TO THE PRESIDENT:

In the fall and winter of 1972 and 1973, the National Center for Education Statistics issued early estimates of enrollment in higher education. These releases of data have proved useful. Accordingly, we have produced the attached release of data for the fall of 1974.

Enrollments in higher education have increased by a greater percentage than expected and by more than early estimates had predicted. The data in this early release indicate that enrollment increased by 5.5 percent overall, with a 6.3 percent increase in public institutions and a 3.0 percent increase in private institutions. This is the second consecutive year in which the prior trend of annual declining rates of growth has been reversed.

The accompanying tables make it possible to distinguish between growth rates in independent 4-year institutions and the 4-year branches of universities and, similarly, for 2-year institutions and the 2-year branches of other institutions. The separate tables for universities aggregate only units classifiable as universities without including branches that are not university units. The separate tables for other 4-year institutions and 2-year institutions aggregate all 4-year institutional entities whether independent or branches, and all 2-year entities whether independent or branches. Data on universities plus all their 2-year branches are available on request.

The data for the fall of 1974 will undoubtedly be slightly modified after careful editing and tabulation of a type that is not possible in such an early release. Experience with the early releases in 1972 and 1973 indicates that the final grand total enrollment figure for the fall of 1974 can be expected to vary by less than 1 percent at the U.S. level from these early estimates. Final totals over all types of institutions for individual States can be expected to vary somewhat more than this.

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Out of a total of 3037 reporting units (institutions, branches, campuses, etc.) which were in operation in the fall of 1974, only 8 were unable to report their enrollment by November 20, 1974. For the non-respondent institutions, the National Center has substituted their 1973 enrollments into the 1974 totals. The enrollment at these institutions represents less than 2 tenths of 1 percent of the overall national total.

Totals in the enclosed tables have not been rounded but are given as they were obtained by simple addition of the figures for individual institutions. The presentation in no way implies that totals and subtotals are accurate to the last few digits.

Additional information from the same survey is available in three forms: (1) computer tape, (2) online retrieval and (3) institutional printout. Since data are preliminary, they are subject to revision.

A copy of the computer tape providing data on total full-time and part-time enrollment by sex and first-time enrollment by degree status for all institutions of higher education in the United States may be purchased for \$78.

The data on the computer tape mentioned above are also incorporated into the EDSTAT online educational information access system operated by NCES. This system can be entered through modestly priced keyboard terminals anywhere in the United States. Enrollment data by institution for 1974-75 may be compared with those for previous years and related to financial, institutional, and degree characteristics.

Finally, printouts are available listing selected enrollment items by individual institutions, at a charge of \$10.

*Individual institutions, branches, or other reporting units are categorized on the basis of the programs in those units without regard for the category of the parent, or other related units, although the relationships among units are recognized in the categorization. The six categories and their code numbers are:

- Code 1 - A university unit, excluding its 4-year and 3-year branches
- Code 2 - A 4-year unit which is not a university or part of a university, excluding its 2-year branches
- Code 3 - A 2-year unit which is not a branch or campus of a university or any other 4-year institution
- Code 4 - A 4-year branch of a multicampus university
- Code 5 - A 2-year branch of a multicampus university
- Code 6 - A 2-year branch of a 4-year multicampus institution which is not a university

In the table above, these six categories are shown both separately and in combination to make up the traditional three-way classification of universities, other 4-year institutions, and 2-year institutions. Also, data are combined in still a different way to show enrollment in all 4-year (nonuniversity) units and in all 2-year units, without regard for relationship to other units. Combinations of the six basic data codes are shown below:

Universities	• Sum of codes 1, 4, and 5	All other 4-year units	• Sum of codes 2 and 4
Other 4-year institutions	• Sum of codes 2 and 6	All 2-year units	• Sum of codes 3, 5, and 6
2-year institutions	• Code 3 only		

The institutional level categories represented in the tables that follow are based on university units excluding other 4-year and 2-year branches, other 4-year institutions and their 4-year branches plus the other 4-year branches of universities, and 2-year institutions plus the 2-year branches of all levels of institutions.

**Of the 8 nonrespondents, 6 are Rabbinical schools in the State of New York, whose combined enrollment was 1,755 in 1973; the other 2 are located in Nevada and Puerto Rico. For the nonrespondent institutions, 1973 enrollments have been substituted into the 1974 totals.
