DEFINITIONS

STUDENT - All students taking resident credit, irrespective of the time of day or workload of the student. NOT INCLUDED ARE:

- a. Students in noncredit adult education courses,
- b. Students taking courses at home by mail, radio, or television,
- c. Students enrolled only for "short courses",
- d. Auditors,
- e. Students studying abroad.

SPECIAL/UNCLASSIFIED STUDENTS - Students taking undergraduate or postbaccalaureate level credit courses regardless of intention concerning a degree, diploma, or certificate although taking courses in regular classes with other students; this category also includes students who cannot be classified by academic level.

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS - Students who have not completed a full four-year program or its equivalent and those in a five-year bachelor's degree program. The year level designation of undergraduate students will be determined by institutional policy.

GRADUATE STUDENTS - Students who hold the bachelor's or first professional degree, or equivalent, and are candidates for a graduate degree.

PROFESSIONAL STUDENTS - Students who have completed the baccalaureate degree and are enrolled in a postbaccalaureate program leading to a professional degree in law or medicine.

COMMON MARKET STUDENTS - Students enrolled at NDSU but registered for course work at Moorhead State College and/or Concordia College, Moorhead, Minnesota, for simultaneous course work.

CREDIT HOUR - The unit by which an institution measures its course work for application towards a degree.

RESIDENT STUDENTS - Resident students, for the purposes of this report, are students having legal domicile in North Dakota.

NONRESIDENT STUDENTS - Nonresident students, for the purposes of this report, are students having legal domicile other than North Dakota.

FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT STUDENT - The total credit hours of all students registered for credit hours using the following division in determining full-time equivalent enrollments

a. Undergraduate and Special/Unclassified	16
b. Graduate	12
c. Professional	12
