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ABSTRACT

This is an annotated list of recorded materials for teaching oral skills to those studying English as a second or foreign language or for special purposes. The materials listed are recorded in British English, with a few exceptions. Included are tape recordings, records, cassettes and films, with accompanying texts, workbooks, and teachers' manuals. The list details materials on language courses, both class and home-study; phonology and pronunciation; spoken English; listening comprehension; English for special purposes; grammar; songs; ancillary materials; films and film loops for students, and material for teachers. A continuation of the first series: still dealing with the spoken language, but now in rather more detail and with rather younger children. Again it is advisable to use the accompanying handbook for discussion questions and suggestions for utilisation.

The first 5 films (13-17), written by the general editor, suggest ways of tackling specific points of language, using a 'situational' method. Film 13, by B C Brookes, suggests how the teacher can begin to link the teaching of language with the teaching of scientific concepts.
