## ABSTRACT

The biographical characteristics and achievements of the 1373 cadets who entered the Class of 1974 are presented. A separate report compares selected characteristics of this class with previous classes. In order to obtain data on the American College Testing Program, the ACT was administered to 1336 members of the Class of 1974 in July 1970. Tabulated data are presented on: distribution of scores on academic qualification measures, whole man score measures, and height, weight and age; high school characteristics; subject exposure; preparatory school attendance; awards and scholarships; clubs and positions held or awarded; nominations and appointments; ROTC; military service; fathers' military status, rank, and component; fathers who are graduates of Federal academies; class year of fathers who are USMA graduates; sport participation; number of non-varsity sports or activities in which participated; number of varsity sports in which participated; non-varsity sports and physical activities; varsity sport and type participation; miscellaneous; representation by state of birth; and American College Testing Program class profile. 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## Preface

This report presents the biographical characteristics and achievements of the 1373 cadets who entered the Class of 1974. A separate report will compare selected characteristics of this class with previous classes. In order to obtain data on the American College Testing Program, the ACT was administered to 1336 members of the Class of 1974 on 6 and 7 July 1970. The results of this test are included in Table 24.

The following abbreviations, explanations and definitions of terms apply to this report:

CEER	College Entrance Examination Board Tests and High School Rank (This is a statistically derived weighted composite score of four College Board tests (Scholastic Aptitude Test-Verbal, Scholastic Aptitude Test-Mathematics, English Composition, and Mathematics Achievement) and a standardized high school rank score).
High School Rank	This is a score derived by converting the actual high school rank to a standard score using a formula developed by the Educational Testing Service.
Whole Man Score	This is a weighted composite score of the CEER, the Physical Aptitude Examination score and the Leadership Potential Score.
Physical Aptitude Examination Score	This is a standardized score developed to measure physical capabilities.
Leadership Potential Score	This is a score derived from the ratings of the candidate by his secondary school teachers and evaluations by admissions officials of his type of participation in athletic and other school and community activities.
ACT	American College Testing Program.
