ABSTRACT

The 1974-75 academic year is the first in which student credit hours have been accumulated for the entire University of Maine, utilizing uniform definitions. The purpose of this document is to summarize those data for both semesters. A total of 578,457 student credit hours were generated by all campuses of the University of Maine during the 1974-75 academic year. The largest proportion of these were generated at the Orono campus. Orono and Portland-Gorham together accounted for 73 percent of student credit-hour generation. Tables include listings of student credit hours generated by the University of Maine during 1974-75 by campus and instructional level; the average full-time equivalent students by instructional level; a headcount of students; distribution by course loads; full-time equivalent student by campus, comparing old and new figures; degree credit enrollment; degree credit enrollment by student origin, county or state. 1974-75 is the first academic year in which student credit hours have been accumulated for the entire University of Maine, utilizing uniform definitions. The purpose of this memorandum is to summarize those data for both semesters.

Student Credit Hours Generated

578,457 student credit hours were generated by all campuses of the University of Maine during the 1974-75 academic year¹-- 292,832 in the fall semester and 285,625 in the spring semester.

The largest proportion of these were generated at the Orono campus. Orono and Portland-Gorham together account for 73% of student credit hour generation. It should be noted that additional instructional activity is present, but at the present time non-credit instructional production is not accumulated. Table 1 shows the overall student credit hour data distributed by campus.

There is no significant difference from fall to spring semester this year in the generation of student credit hours.

Student credit hour data are also accumulated by instructional level. Table 2 portrays this distribution.

It is noteworthy that 13% of the student credit hours are generated by associate degree students and 5% by graduate students.

An average of 19,910.9 full-time equivalent students attended the University of Maine during both semesters of the 1974-75 academic year. Corresponding information by instructional level is shown in

Table 3.

While full-time equivalent students is a more useful statistic for some purposes, clearly it must be closely associated with total headcount when considering support services. As the number of part-time students increase relative to total students, the costs of support services are likely to increase disproportionately. Table 4 indicates headcount enrollment for the fall and spring semester of this academic year.

From Tables 3 and 4, one can deduce that one full-time equivalent student is generated for each 1.296 individuals or conversely, each actual student equates to .772 full-time equivalent students.
