INTRODUCTIONA

Section 142(d) of Part D of the Vocational Education Amendments of 1968 provides Federal funding for State-administered Exemplary Projects in Vocational Education. These Federal funds can be used by each State for making grants to or contracts with local educational agencies, colleges and universities, and other public and private agencies and organizations for the development, establishment, and operation of exemplary and innovative occupational education programs or projects designed to serve as models for use in vocational education programs.

The funds are allocated to the States on the basis of a complex formula prescribed in Public Law 90-576. In Fiscal Year 19 for example, the State of Alaska received \$104,204, while the State of California received \$355,464. The total funding appropriated for State use under Section 142(d) of Part D amount to \$6.5 million in Fiscal Year 1970, and \$8 million in each succeeding fiscal year.

The purpose of this publication is to provide a listing of the projects supported in each State through grants and contracts funded by the States under Section 142(d) of Part D of the Vocational Education Amendments of 1968. The listing, which is arranged alphabetically by States, shows the title of each project, the name of the grantee or contractor conducting the project, and the amount of Section 142(d) funding obligated for the project. For any given State, the total amount of funds obligated in a particular fiscal year may or may not be equal to the State's allotment for that fiscal year. The reason for such differences between funds allotted and funds obligated is that Public Law 90-576 permits a State to obligate Section 142(d) funds during the fiscal year in which the funds are appropriated and during the succeeding fiscal year. Thus, a State could darry Fiscal Year 1971 funds over and obligate them during Fiscal Year 1972, could carry Fiscal Year 1972 funds over and obligate them in Fiscal Year 1973, etc.

This listing of State-administered Exemplary Projects was compiled on the basis of information supplied to the U.S. Office of Education by each State. Persons wishing to secure in-depth information about a particular project should correspond with the State Director of Vocational Education in the State concerned.
