ABSTRACT

This is a summary report on the total number of associate, baccalaureate, first-professional, master's and doctoral degrees conferred during the 1973-74 fiscal year by the 29 institutions of higher education in Kentucky accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. (Associate degrees are awarded for the completion of programs requiring at least two years but less than four years of study beyond the high school level. First-professional degrees are those awarded in law, dentistry, and medicine.) Degrees conferred in 1973-74 total 19,227 including 1,676 associate degrees, 12,463 bachelor's (baccalaureate), 823 first-professional, 4,083 master's and 182 doctoral degrees.

SUMMARY

This is a summary report on the total numbers of associate, baccalaureate, first-professional, master's and doctoral degrees conferred during the 1973-74 fiscal year by the twenty-nine institutions of higher education in Kentucky accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

(Associate degrees are awarded for the completion of programs requiring at least two years but less than four years of study beyond the high school level. First-professional degrees are those awarded in law, dentistry, and medicine.)

Degrees conferred in 1973-74 total 19,227. There were 1,676 associate degrees, 12,463 bachelor's (baccalaureate), 823 first-professional, 4,083 master's and 182 doctoral degrees conferred.

Associate Degrees

The thirteen University of Kentucky community colleges conferred 809 associate degrees in 1973-74. The eight state-supported senior institutions conferred 734 associate degrees, and 133 were conferred by the twenty-one private two-year and four-year institutions.

The largest percentage of associate in nursing (R.N.), with 43.3 percent of the total in secretarial technologies, and 3.8 percent in recreation technologies.

This is only the second year for which data has been reported. Future reports compare this year's data with previous years' data.

Bachelor's Degrees

A total of 12,463 bachelor's degrees were conferred by Kentucky institutions during the 1973-74 fiscal year. Of these 25.7 percent were in education, 15.3 percent in business and management, and 11.3 percent in social sciences. In the 1970-71 fiscal year, the first year degrees were reported by the Council on Public Higher Education, 12,375 bachelor's degrees were conferred. Of these 25.7 percent were in education, 16.5 percent were in business and management, and 14.5 percent were in social sciences and

This is only the second year for which associate degree data has been reported. Future reports will contain comparisons to previous years' data.

Bachelor's Degrees

A total of 12,463 bachelor's degrees were awarded by Kentucky institutions during the 1973-74 fiscal year. Of these 25.7 percent were in education, 15.8 percent in business and management, and 11.3 percent in social science. In the 1970-71 fiscal year, the first-year degree data was compiled by the Council on Public Higher Education from HEW figures, 12,375 bachelor's degrees were conferred. Of these, 31.1 percent were in education, 16.5 percent were in social science, and 14.5 percent were in business and management.
