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## ABSTRACT:

This survey is designed to provide comparative information for classified personnel in the six counties of western New York State. Data collection was more difficult this year than in previous years because of the increasing length of the negotiation process. This year 74 of 89 districts supplied data. This study includes two features that were not in the 1973-74 report: a presentation of "other positions" and a section containing definitions of full-time employment. The latter section has been added in order to aid school districts in establishing their definitions. A table includes definitions for full-time employment by occupational groupings by district as well as a summary of minimum, maximum, and mode for each occupational grouping. The data are arranged alphabetically according to county. The salaries and fringe benefits are listed according to the classifications prescribed by the state department of education and the state civil service commission. Care should be exercised in comparing compensation for specific titles among districts, as assigned duties may vary from district to district. (Author)

## PREFACE

The need for comprehensive and accurate comparative data has become increasingly important in the negotiations process in local school districts. This survey is designed to provide comparative information for classified personnel in the six counties of Western New York.

Data collection for the report this year was more difficult than previous years because of the increasing length of the negotiation process. Many school districts were in negotiation with classified personnel well into the school year. Despite this problem, the participation of school districts in this report was up 3% from last year. This year 74 school districts supplied data out of a possible 89, which represents a participation of 83%.

This study includes two features that were not in the 1973-74 report: a new presentation of "other positions" and a new section containing definitions of Full Time Employment. Table 9 (Other Positions) is used to list the positions which can not be categorized into traditional classifications.

Section C has been added in order to aid school districts in establishing their definition of full-time employment. This information is an out growth of the newly established Part 316 of New York State Codes, Rules and Regulations which stipulates that each school district must define its minimum requirements for full-time employment by April 1, 1975. Tables 12-14 include definitions for full-time employment by occupational groupings by district as well as a summary of the minimum, maximum and mode for each occupational grouping by counties and for the Western New York Region.

The data for the districts are arranged alphabetically according to county to facilitate use by school district personnel. The salaries and fringe benefits are listed according to the classifications prescribed by the State Education Department and the State Civil Service Commission. Care should be exercised in comparing compensation for specific titles among districts, as assigned duties may vary from district to district.

The Finance and Legislation Program welcomes suggestions for further improvements in these surveys. These surveys are modified every year in the interest of keeping them up to date and responsive to district requirements.

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## DEFINITIONS.

- Classified Personnel - Includes custodial, maintenance, school lunch, office and transportation personnel; plus clerical, library, and classroom aides.
- F.T. - Full time, 30 or more hours per week, 10 or more months per year. Specific data in Section C shows full time employment by Occupational groupings.
- Mode - The most frequently given response in a series of data.
- P.T. - Part time, less than 30 hours per week.
