ABSTRACT

This selective bibliography lists approximately 100 items dealing with the teaching of English as a native language. The entries include mainly British book publications fairly easily available through booksellers in Great Britain. Periodical literature has been minimally treated. The majority of the items were published between 1969 and 1973, but a few date back to the early 1960's or late 1950's and some even to the 1940's. The list is divided into the following sections: general, books and reading, language, talking, writing, poetry, drama, primary schools, and periodicals. (TL)

In preparing this list, we have tried to include only books fairly easily available through booksellers in Great Britain. As a result none of the huge and valuable periodical literature is included. Neither will you find any textbooks directly prepared for use in schools. But many of the books on the list contain their own considerable bibliographies, in which information of this kind can be found.

We have also tried to keep the list to about a hundred items, to avoid cumbersome and expense in postage. As a result, it is highly selective and still, although several of us have been concerned, rather subjective. It is not, and is not intended to be, exhaustive or definitive.
