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ABSTRACT

This fifth annual report is intended to provide an accurate and current compilation of enrollment data for the 22 institutions in the Washington community college system. Data are reported in 25 tables, many of which contain historical enrollment data which appeared in earlier reports, with comparable data added for the 1974-75 academic year. Total fall enrollment in 1974 was 146,784, an increase of 6.62 percent from fall 1973, and 455.09 percent from fall 1962, the first year for which data were available. Full-time equivalent (FTE) student enrollment for fall 1974 was 80,203, up 4.44 percent from fall 1973, and 409.58 percent from fall 1962. Total FTE enrollment for the 1974-75 academic year shows 44,453 (53 percent) enrolled in academic programs, 39,302 (46 percent) enrolled in occupational programs, and 679 (1 percent) enrolled in community service programs. Data on program enrollments are further broken down by quarter and individual institution. Data are also provided for FTE and headcount enrollment by funding source and program type, and the program enrollments of FTE students by academic quarter for each of the last seven academic years are shown. Data on sex, age, residency, credit hour load, source, ethnic background, and educational intent are offered for academic and occupational students enrolled in the fall of 1974. (NEM)

Final Quarterly Enrollments is the fifth in a series of operations reports dealing exclusively with student-oriented enrollment data for the community college system in the State of Washington. As in the case of the four earlier reports, this publication is intended to provide an accurate and current compilation of information concerning such enrollment. Tables 1, 2, 3 and 4 contain historical enrollment data which appeared in the earlier reports, with comparable data added for the current reporting period. Additional historical enrollment information can be found in tables 13 through 24.

Students enrolled only in courses classified as "community service" are defined to be "community service students" for headcount reporting purposes. In the same manner, students enrolled for at least one credit in courses classified as "academic" or "occupational" have been defined as "academic and occupational students."

Student demographic information (i.e., age, sex, etc.) collected during Fall Quarter, 1974, is summarized in table 25. Please note that these data cover "academic and occupational students only" as defined above. Although only state-level summaries have been provided, data by institution is available and can be furnished upon request.

As in the past, a full-time-equivalent (FTE) student is derived from the total number of student credit hours generated by students in each category, divided by fifteen. The category (academic, occupational, or community service) is determined by the intent of the institution in offering the course. An annualized FTE student is derived by dividing the sum of the quarterly FTE's for all four quarters, by three. (i.e., one annualized FTE student equals 45 student credit hours). This publication also includes breakdowns of annualized averages by funding source (state-supported, ABE and federal funding).

The source of these data was the 1974-75 MIS-1 Student Enrollment Report. The number of FTE students was also verified by the MIS-2 Course Effort Report for the same period. The enrollment statistics reported reflect "final" enrollment which is defined to include net 8th day enrollment plus all subsequent new registrations and adds.
