



This booklet in the ROOM TO GROW series has one purpose: To motivate each student to investigate the SELF, and as this process of discovery of the self proceeds, to generate sufficient excitement within the student to continue to develop potentialities and abilities.

JOBS is intended for use in 5th and/or 6th grade, however JOBS can supplement career development activities in other grades.

A word of caution: students are introduced to new concepts and vocabulary. Hence, it is essential that sufficient class time be devoted to clarification of all new words and terms.

JOBS require thinking, doing, and evaluating for the teacher and student. Each page should be independently developed and extended by additional teacher, student activities. PLANS FOR MY FUTURE (page 23) should summarise discoveries, "about myself" on pages 7 and 8, and 12 through 19.

JOBS may be reproduced in the school, as needed. Each pupil should have a copy.






SOME COMMENTS FOR TRACHERS

Theories of vocational choice have proliferated during the past two decades, variously referred to as; sociological, trait-factor, developmental, psychoanalytical, realistic. The issue is not whether a theory is right or wrong, but rather that it adds data, information or methodology, explanatory of the phenomeno being investigated. The theories of vocational choice are directive in the sense that each adds something to the understanding of vocational decision making.


JOBS utilizes the trait-factor theory to assist the student in probing the "Self". JOBS should aid the user to develop insights about feelings in such affective areas as: what are my interests, what do I do well, what do I want to do better, would I rather work with people, data, things or ideas?
