ABSTRACT

The guide to local resources was compiled by the Tri-County Industry-Education-Labor Council for teachers and guidance counselors seeking specific career education information. The resources are classified according to the 15 occupational clusters, as identified by the U.S. Office of Education, plus economic education for integration with classroom material. The guide lists: definitions of career education, the 15 occupational clusters, agencies and businesses for economic education, sequential career management tasks for kindergarten through post-high school, procedures for obtaining resource people and conducting a field trip, other services available from the Council, audiovisual materials available from the Council and other sources, a statement on the Armed Services and the world of work, and Library of Career Counseling Films and locally available films. The bulk of the document (72 pages) is a resource chart providing specific information organized by occupational clusters, about regional businesses, industries, educational institutions, and service agencies. The chart indicates the possibilities and requirements for interviews, classroom visits (location, advance notification requirements, age groups), and field trips/career visits (maximum number of students, best days/months, time of day, age groups, time length of tour, and areas/departments open to visitors). ## WHAT IS CAREER EDUCATION?

Career education has often been confused with vocational education or occupational education. Most authorities agree that both are a part of career education, but the latter includes one's entire life style, leisure pursuits, activity during retirement as well as the occupation or number of different occupations one pursues during a lifetime.

In 1974 the Chief State School Officers from the 50 States adopted a tentative definition of Career Education which reads:

Career Education is essentially an instructional strategy, aimed at improving educational outcome by relating teaching and learning activities to the concept of career development. Career Education extends the academic world to the world of work. In scope, Career Education encompasses educational experiences beginning with early childhood and continuing throughout the individual's productive life. A complete program of Career Education includes awareness of self and the world of work, broad orientation of occupations (professional and non-professional), in-depth exploration of selected clusters, career preparation, an understanding of the economic system of which jobs are a part, and placement for all students.

The Ohio State Center for Vocational and Technical Education has developed a comprehensive career education matrix that identifies eight broad elements, each stated in terms of student activities and student outcomes, which, taken together, serve as one operational description of career education. In short it is as follows:

### CAREER EDUCATION ELEMENTS

1. CAREER AWARENESS--knowledge of the total spectrum of careers.

2. SELF-AWARENESS--knowledge of the components that make up self.

3. APPRECIATIONS, ATTITUDES--life roles; feelings towards self and others in respect to society and economics.

4. DECISION-MAKING SKILLS--applying information to rational processes to reach decisions.

### ELEMENT OUTCOMES

1. CAREER IDENTITY--personalized future role or roles within the world of work; options remain open for the individual to move among occupations.

2. SELF-IDENTITY--know himself; consistent value system; ability to make decisions based on values held by individual.

3. SELF-SOCIAL FULFILLMENT--active work role; satisfying work role; responsibility beyond self to civic and individual needs.

4. CAREER DECISIONS--career directions; has a plan for career development; bases decisions on information as distinct from fantasy.

CAREER EDUCATION ELEMENTS      ELEMENT OUTCOMES

5. ECONOMIC AWARENESS--perception of processes in production, distribution and consumption.
5. ECONOMIC UNDERSTANDING--solve personal and social problems of an economic environment; relate values to compensation, security, growth and related economic measures.
6. SKILL AWARENESS AND BEGINNING COMPETENCE--skills in ways in which man extends his behavior.
6. EMPLOYMENT SKILLS--competence in performance of job-related tasks; varies from unsophisticated to very sophisticated skills depending upon learner.
7. EMPLOYABILITY SKILLS--social and communication skills appropriate to career placement.
7. CAREER PLACEMENT--employed in line with career development plan; affective behavior such as attitudes, coping, self-discipline, integrity are parallel attributes to the specific skill or skills.
8. EDUCATIONAL AWARENESS--perception of relationship between education and life roles.
8. EDUCATIONAL IDENTITY--ability to select educational avenues to develop career plans; decision-making as to post-secondary options, including immediate work, or further education, or both. Awareness of in-and-out options for continuing education through adulthood.



SEQUENTIAL CAREER MANAGEMENT TASKS OR COMPETENCIES  
FOR KINDERGARTEN THROUGH POST-HIGH

Tasks for the primary years are to: (a) acquire awareness of self, (b) gain a sense of control over one's life, (c) identify with workers, (d) acquire knowledge about workers, (e) acquire interpersonal skills, (f) objectify self before others, and (g) gain respect for other people and the work they do.

Tasks for the intermediate years are to: (a) develop a positive self-concept, (b) acquire the discipline of work, (c) identify with the concept of work as a valued institution, (d) increase knowledge about workers, (e) increase interpersonal skills, (f) increase objectification of self before others, and (g) value human dignity.

Tasks for the junior high years are to: (a) clarify self-concept; (b) assume responsibility for career planning; (c) formulate tentative career goals; (d) acquire knowledge of occupations, work settings, and life styles; (e) acquire knowledge of educational and occupational resources; (f) develop awareness of the decision-making process; and (g) acquire a sense of independence.

Tasks for the senior high years are to: (a) reality test the self-concept; (b) develop awareness of a preferred life style; (c) re-formulate tentative career goals; (d) increase knowledge of and experience in occupations and work settings; (e) acquire knowledge of educational and vocational paths; (f) clarify the decision-making process as related to self; and (g) commit oneself with tentativeness within a changing world.

Tasks for the post high years are to: (a) develop interpersonal skills essential to work; (b) develop information processing skills about self and work; (c) reintegrate the self; (d) acquire a sense of community; (e) commit oneself to the concept of career; (f) acquire the determination to participate in change; and (g) creatively apply management skills to life roles.

PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING RESOURCE PEOPLE

1. Call the Council at 694-2123. Whoever answers your call, give the person the following information and your needs:
  - a) Name
  - b) Name of School
  - c) Address
  - d) Phone number
  - e) Best time of day you can be contacted by phone
  - f) Classroom material being covered
  - g) Type of resource needed
  - h) Number of students in each class
  - i) Number of classes
  - j) Specific time class or classes meet
  - k) Grade level(s) - Freshmen, Sophomores, etc.
  - l) Calendar date resource person is to be with your students
  - m) Can you supply audio-visual equipment if needed by resource person
2. In securing a resource person, our staff personnel attempt to locate people whose work is closely related to the classroom material being covered.
3. We will call and give the name, telephone number of the resource person and the employer's name.
4. You will contact the resource person by telephone and firm up a mutual understanding with the individual.
5. Prior to the resource person's arrival, make sure the class is informed as to how and why the resource person's particular career is related to the classroom material being covered. Give the class the name of the resource person and the institution which he or she represents.
6. Prepare a list of possible questions the class may be interested in asking such as "Where did you go to school?", "What do you do on your job?" or "What are the qualifications for your job?".
7. Have some type of follow-up procedure for the students that will be an indicator of the effectiveness of the speaker's visit to the classroom. Specifically, have the students devise a way to thank the speaker for having spent time with them, e.g., a series of letters or a classroom project relating to the speaker's topic, and send it to him or her.
8. If there is a topic or career you wish to have the students hear about that is not in the "directory", please contact us and we will do our best to locate it for you.
9. We appreciate having a report from the teacher and resource person indicating the effectiveness of the resource person's visit to the classroom. This permits us to improve our services and programs.

PROCEDURE FOR TAKING A FIELD TRIP

1. Select field trip in relation to topics being covered in class and with reference to career information you seek.
  2. Call the Council, 694-2123, a minimum of two weeks in advance of the field trip date and clarify the following:
    - a) date and time limits of trip
    - b) group size
    - c) age of group
    - d) length of trip
  3. Prepare your students:
    - a) Discuss the objectives in taking the field trip in relation to classroom material.
    - b) Try to obtain literature or background information from the institution you will be visiting and discuss this with the students
  4. If there is a field trip resource you would like but cannot locate, please contact us and we will do our best to locate it for you.
- c) Arrange a follow-up procedure by the students, expressing the value they received from the tour.

This may take the form of written expressions of thanks to the institution. (One of the major objections made by many institutions offering field trips and tours is the lack of feed-back from those who have made use of their services).



OTHER SERVICES AVAILABLE FROM  
TRI-COUNTY INDUSTRY-EDUCATION-LABOR COUNCIL

**CAREER EXPLORATION SPEAKERS AND MATERIALS** - Exploration of work clusters recommended for upper elementary and early high school grades.

Conduct symposia on Peoria Statistical Area Manpower needs for the next five years, including occupations that are expanding, standing still or retreating. Recommended for Guidance Departments, Occupational Education Teachers, Geography and Economics Teachers.

**INDIVIDUAL CONFERENCES** - With knowledgeable educators and outside consultants can be arranged by the Council staff.

## THE ARMED SERVICES AND THE WORLD OF WORK

In moving to an All-Volunteer Force the Military Services have greatly improved their traditional role as an important training institution in American life. The Armed Services have placed a renewed emphasis on educational and training opportunities in peacetime.

The Services now emphasize the individual's own choice in his or her selection of training, first job assignment or career field. The Services are prepared to guarantee this choice to an individual prior to enlistment so long as he or she qualifies and performs successfully. Those not yet ready to make an occupational choice may enter under a general enlistment which does not provide specific occupational guarantees. It is, therefore, a matter of interest to the Armed Services to make available occupational information about jobs, training and career opportunities offered by the Services.

It is the policy of the Department of Defense to encourage young men and women to stay in high school and to graduate. After graduation young men and women may wish to consider whether to learn a skill and to try out their initial job or career choice while in military service. High school graduates who enter service will also find opportunities to complete one or more years of college during their off-duty hours. For well-motivated non-graduates, there are opportunities to complete the equivalent of a high school education while in Service. Educational counselors are available to assist military personnel in making such educational and occupational choices and plans.

Most young men and women entering service will serve an initial term and return to civilian life. To some degree their occupational experience while in service is likely to be in part transferable to the civilian sector and to assist them in getting a civilian job.

Some may wish to go to college at this time or to shift careers; others may decide to continue with a full career in military service. In any case, service connected education and training is likely to prove a continuing asset.

In keeping with this role of the Services as an important training institution, the Department of Defense has made these career films on the world of work available to high schools through State Departments of Vocational Education.
