ABSTRACT

These tables represent an analysis of enrollment in Oklahoma higher Education for fall semester 1975 in comparison with previous fall semesters, including enrollments in state and private Oklahoma colleges and universities. Enrollments are categorized by geographic origin, graduate and undergraduate status, county, state, and outlying area, full-time-equivalent enrollments, head-count enrollments, student-credit-hours, class, sex, division of students, head-count of first-time entering freshmen, and short-course enrollments. Findings show a total increase in public colleges over the last five years of 32.7 percent. (Author/KE)

AN ANALYSIS OF ENROLLMENTS IN OKLAHOMA HIGHER EDUCATION
SEMESTER 1975 AS COMPARED WITH PREVIOUS FALL SEMESTER

Main and branch campus enrollments in all Oklahoma higher education reached a total of 146,617 for the 1975 fall semester, a head-count increase of 15,368 students and a percentage increase of 11.7 over the enrollment of 131,249 recorded in the 1974 fall semester. In addition to those individuals attending on the main and branch campuses of institutions, another 4,628 students are enrolled in degree-credit courses at off-campus centers, making a grand total of 151,245 students in Oklahoma higher education for the 1975 fall semester.

Of the 146,617 students enrolled on-campus this fall, 124,751 (85.1%) are attending public institutions, while 21,866 (14.9%) attend private institutions. Enrollment in public institutions increased by 12.8 percent over one year ago, as compared with an increase of 5.8 percent in the private colleges and universities. By type of institution in the State System, the universities increased this year by 6.6 percent, as compared with an increase of 10.8 percent in the four-year colleges and an increase of 24.0 percent in the public junior colleges. The head-count increase for the junior colleges for this year over last year is 6,506 additional students, or approximately 46 percent of the total increase for the State System. The full-time-equivalent enrollment in all public colleges increased 10.8 percent, from a total of 82,210 in the fall of 1974 to 91,127 this year. A total of 29,001 first-time-entering freshmen enrolled in Oklahoma colleges and universities in the fall of 1975 as compared with 26,279 in the fall of 1974. A total of 6,903 (23.8%) entered the state universities, 6,887 (23.7%) the state four-year colleges, and 10,603 (36.6%) the public two-year colleges, while 4,608 (15.9%) enrolled in the private colleges and universities.

Out-of-state students attending Oklahoma colleges and universities in the 1974 fall semester totaled 13,824 as compared with a total of 13,233 last year. Out-of-state enrollments accounted for 5.1 percent

of the total in private institutions.

Of the 124,751 enrolled in public institutions in Oklahoma, 73,793
(59.2%) are men and 50,958 (40.8%) are women. In the private insti-
tutions, with an enrollment of 21,866, 12,110 (55.4%) are men and
9,756 (44.6%) are women.

The University of Oklahoma enrolled the greatest number of students,
this fall, 21,316, followed by Oklahoma State University with 20,247;
Central State University, 12,736; Oscar Rose Junior College, 7,766;
University of Tulsa, 6,540; and Tulsa Junior College, 6,169. Insti-
tutions which showed the greatest absolute increase were Oscar Rose
Junior College with 1,513; the University of Oklahoma, 1,384; Cameron
University, 1,217; and Oklahoma State University, 1,197. The Uni-
versity of Tulsa registered the largest increase among the private
institutions with 448, followed by Southwestern College with 238.

Following is a comparison of growth by level in the public colleges
over the past five years, 1970-1975. The greatest increases by class
have come at the Freshman, Graduate and Sophomore levels respectively;
with these classes showing five-year percent gains of 61.9, 58.9 and
16.3. There was a total increase over the last five years of 32.7
percent.
